The event headquarters is situated at Ashurst Village Hall on the B2135. The Hall will be opened at 3 p.m. until 8 p.m. where the result board and canteen will be located

FOOD will be available at the start and handed up at approximately 139 miles (bottom of Hammerpot Hill)

DRINKS & SPONGES will be available at 28, 47, 72, 92, 104, 125, 134, 148, 154, 175, 198 miles and at two points on the Finishing Circuit.

PEACHES will be handed up at 146 miles

BANANAS will be handed up at 185 miles

NUMBERS will be available at the start. Please return them to the time-keeper at your finishing point or to any official should you retire

PARKING It is an R.T.T.C. District regulation that no vehicle shall be parked on the highway near the start and finishing points. Helpers are requested not to park ~~not to park~~ their cars on the highway during the event so as to pose a nuisance to other road users but to park if possible, on a verge or lay-by. This particularly to be observed on the finishing circuit.

RIDERS must obey the traffic lights on the Chichester By-pass and at West Grinstead Cross Roads. Please remember to keep on the A27 all the way from the turn at Stockbridge Roundabout to Offington Corner Roundabout (junction with the A24) There are approximately 50 marshalls on the course and whilst every effort has been made to ensure that you have no difficulty, the onus of keeping on course rests with each rider. A few moments checking the course would be worthwhile.

The Chief Time-keeper will close detours as appropriate to enable all riders to reach the finishing circuit. On reaching the finishing circuit each rider will continue to the next time-keeper after his time has elapsed; the distance covered in the excess time will be deducted. (See paragraph below)

HELPERS If you are able to help any other riders with drinks and sponges without upsetting your own arrangements the promoter would be grateful.

<u>TURN</u> at mini roundabout at junction with the A29 encircle and retrace via Storrington to <u>WASHINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where left on the A24 via Ashington and Dial Post By-pass to traffic lights at West Grinstead cross roads(which must be obeyed) continue on the A24 to <u>SOUTHWATER ROUNDABOUT</u> at southern end of By-pass where encircle and retrace on the A24 to West Grinstead cross roads where left at traffic lights (which must be obeyed) on to the A272 to Cowfold where right at mini roundabout where right again at second mini roundabout on A281 to Henfield where left at mini roundabout at end of village via Woodmancote to <u>POYNINGS ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace via Woodmancote and Henfield to Cowfold where left on A272 to West Grinstead cross roads where left through filter at traffic lights on to the A24 proceed south via Dial Post By-pass and Ashington to <u>WASHINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where left on A283 via roundabouts at Bramber and Beeding to large roundabout at Shoreham where take 1st exit to mini roundabout by Red Lion Public House where left past Southlands Hospital to roundabout at <u>SOUTHWICK</u> at junction with the A27 where encircle and retrace route via roundabouts at Shoreham , Beeding and Bramber to Washington roundabout where left on the A24 via Findon roundabout to <u>OFFINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where right on the A27 to Patching where left on the A280 to Angmering roundabout where left on the A259 via roundabouts at Roundstone, Goring and East Durrington to <u>EAST DURRINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace to Angmering Roundabout where continue straight on A259 over railway bridge where right at the Windmill Roundabout to <u>TURN</u> at Littlehampton Cemetery where encircle and retrace to Angmering roundabout where left on A280 to junction with the A27 at Patching where left via the Arundel and Fontwell By-passes to <u>WESTHAMPNETT ROUNDABOUT</u> where left on the Chichester By-pass via traffic lights (which must be obeyed) to Bognor Bridge roundabout where left on the A259 to <u>TURN</u> at large roundabout in Bognor and retrace to Bognor Bridge roundabout where left on the A27 proceed westwards via Whyke roundabout to <u>TURN</u> at Cockbridge roundabout where encircle and retrace on the A27 to <u>WESTHAMPNETT ROUNDABOUT</u> where take the third exit and continue on the A27 via the Fontwell and Arundel By-passes to <u>OFFINGTON ROUNDABOUT</u> where left on the A24 via Washington roundabout Ashington and Dial Post By-pass to traffic lights at West Grinstead cross roads (which must be obeyed) continue on A24 via Southwater By-pass and Horsham By-pass to <u>FARTHINGS HILL ROUNDABOUT</u> (formerly called Broadbridge Heath roundabout) where left on the A281 to next roundabout where straight on the A281 to mini roundabout at Roman Gate where left on the A29 to Five Oaks where left on A264 to Farthings roundabout where left on A24 to <u>ROBIN HOOD</u> (formerly called Warnham Court roundabout) where encircle and retrace on A24 via Farthings Hill roundabout, Horsham By-pass and Southwater By-pass to traffic lights (which must be obeyed) at West Grinstead cross roads to <u>JUNCTION WITH B2135</u> where left via Partridge Green and Ashurst to junction with A283 where left via roundabouts at Bramber and Beeding to <u>SHOREHAM ROUNDABOUT</u> where encircle and retrace on A283 to Washington roundabout where encircle to start of <u>FINISHING CIRCUIT</u> (opposite start) continue on A283 to junction with B2135 where left via Ashurst and Partridge Green to junction with the A24 where left via Dial Post By-pass and Ashington to Washington roundabout where left on A283 to complete the	14.117 "	42
