In spite of the tremendous difficulties engendered by the postal dispute, the events took place with fewer non-starters than one could have imagined, bearing in mind that no start sheets were able to be distributed beforehand. In addition there was the added complication of the Event Secretary's change of address. An advertisement was placed in *Cycling* but the majority sent their entries to the old address. Unfortunately the Post Office, although not then on strike, were very lax with the forwarding of the mail, some of it taking ages to be re-directed and some being delivered to the old address. Naturally this did not please the new occupant too much who eventually tired of having to continually forward the mail herself and returned much of it to the sender. In addition, she had the inconvenience of people calling to deliver entries by hand. As a result of all this, some entries arrived too late for inclusion, even though closure was held until Sunday the 4th of September — apologies are extended to those thus affected. One can imagine the event secretary's reaction when he received advice from one entrant to 'try the Post Office's very efficient forwarding service'!

Further difficulties followed when riders, anxious to know if they were in and, if so when (and where) to start, tried to obtain the telephone number of the old address from directory enquiries. They were told that the telephone was no longer in service, which it wasn't. Had they known the number and rung it they would have got the British Telecom interception service who would have told them the change of number - but they couldn't do that if they didn't know the original number! This meant that many of the event secretary's friends were telephoned for details of the new number, and they must be thanked for playing their part in helping to ensure that the events took place with so many riders.

All of this indicated that the raising of money from sponsorship might well be a non-starter for how could anyone ask people to sponsor them after the event? Even under normal circumstances there is little time between the receipt of the start sheet and the day of the event. Be that as it may, sponsorship monies are beginning to arrive and it seems likely that the riders will, in spite of all the efforts of the Post Office workers (who really didn't mean any harm to the Sue Ryder Home) demonstrate once again their munificence. The amount given in entry fees was amazing, totalling £648.00, an average of £3.62. The extravagance of those at the refreshment counter brought in over fifty pounds and various donations have been made, including a much-appreciated cheque from a veteran in Chester who didn't even enter. Then there was the spending at the Sue Ryder stall — as Eileen Slack's letter indicates, that was no small contribution.

So thank you, everyone; your support makes the promotion of the event a pleasure and we look forward to it continuing in 1989. The date has been moved to an earlier spot in the year, Sunday the 30th of July.
