### ROAD TIME TRIALS COUNCIL LONDON WEST DC Open 25 Miles Course Number H25/2

Start on the A404 approximately 0.4 mile south of Handy Cross roundabout, in the first lay-by on the east side of the road, at a point at the southern end of the pathway, where the width of the lay-by starts to decrease.

Go south, going straight across (M1 & M2) at the A308 roundabout to the junction with the A423.

5 miles 833 yards

Turn left (M3) onto the A423 to the Maidenhead Thicket roundabout.

7 miles 21 yards

Turn right (M4, M5 & M6) (Check) to take the 3rd exit onto the A4 going west. Keep straight ahead (M7) at the mini-roundabout at the A404 junction on the north, to go through Knowl Hill and Hare Hatch to the A321 Twyford roundabout, where go straight across (M8 & M9) and take CARE at the pedestrian lights at Charvill crossroads (M10) to the Sonning Junction Roundabout.

13 miles 933 yards

Circle the roundabout (CARE) (Check) (M11, M12 & M13) and retrace, taking CARE at the pedestrian lights at Charvill crossroads (M10) to go straight across (M14 & M15) at the A321 Twyford roundabout, and through Hare Hatch and Knowl Hill to the mini roundabout at the A404 junction on the north, where bear right (M16) to the Maidenhead Thicket roundabout.

20 miles 172 yards

Turn left (M17) (Check) onto the A423 to the A404 roundabout.

21 miles 1079 yards

Turn right (M18, M19 & M20) onto the A404 to go straight ahead (M21 & M22) at the A308 roundabout to a point 4 yards north of and beyond lamp post No. 17 on the west side of the road, 121 yards south and short of the commencement of the slip road leading to the A4155 where Finish.

##### Numbers

Competitors' numbers will be available **AT EVENT HEADQUARTERS**. The number should be fixed centrally so as to be clearly visible from the rear. They should be handed in at the refreshment bar in the garden room at Event Headquarters

##### Event Headquarters

Event Headquarters will be at Marlow Community Association, Liston Hall, Chapel Street, Marlow. There is ample parking space at the Headquarters and the Result Board and Refreshments will be situated there, along with changing and toilet facilities.

##### The Start

The start is on a dual carriageway and can only be reached from a northerly direction (i.e. from the Handy Cross roundabout). **Any rider crossing the central reservation, or causing another person on his or her behalf to cross the central reservation, will not be allowed to start and will be reported to the London West District Committee.** (This is a DC Regulation).

## NOTES TO RIDERS

### Sponsorship

Each rider has been allocated a 'Target Time' which is five minutes slower than the Handicapper has calculated the rider will record. The idea of the sponsorship is that riders seek support for each minute (or even second) that they beat their target time. Funds thus collected should be sent to the Event Secretary as soon as possible after the receipt of the result sheet. It is understood that it takes time to collect sponsorship monies but it would be appreciated if all could be collected before the end of the year so that the final account can be made up.

### Numbers

Riders' numbers will be available at Event Headquarters, not at the start. This Local Regulation has been imposed to try to prevent riders and/or their helpers crossing the central reservation at the start. You are reminded that the organisers are obliged to not allow anyone to start who crosses the central reservation, or even allows someone to cross on their behalf. Please ensure that this unhappy decision does not have to be made.

### Presentation

The prize for the fastest overall and for the fastest and first handicap in each category (veterans on age standard) will be awarded at the Headquarters within 15 minutes of the last rider finishing. Please remain for the presentation.

## The Sue Ryder Home at Nettlebed

This is the fourth promotion of this series which, in addition to providing a morning's sport for so many riders, has enabled time trialists, by their generous response, to contribute much-needed funds to the Sue Ryder Home at Nettlebed. Almost all entrants have donated more than the minimum entry fee of £2.00 and we all hope that the wonderful support from sponsorship will be repeated again this time.

Those who have ridden the events previously will know that the Sue Ryder Home at Nettlebed is a large Edwardian mansion on the outskirts of the village, five miles from Henley-on-Thames and nine miles from Reading. The Home, working in co-operation with the Department of Radiotherapy at the Royal Berkshire Hospital, provides continuing care for patients who need short-term specialised medical care before returning to their families after treatment in hospital: also for some who are being looked after at home and come for short stays to give their families a much needed break.

With a highly-qualified nursing staff, and the necessary medical coverage, the aim of the Home is to improve the condition and quality of life of the patients and to enable them to return to their own homes if practicable.

The Home is run as a home in the real sense of the word, a place where there is an atmosphere of love and compassion, of unhurried care and a real understanding of individual patients' needs.

The cost of maintaining each bed is a great deal less than the comparable cost in a National Health Service Hospital, largely owing to the splendid efforts of voluntary helpers supporting the permanent staff. Nevertheless, the annual expense of running the Home is considerable. Patients and their families are asked to help when they can but their contributions naturally fall very far short of the actual costs. Fund-raising events of all kinds are continually being pursued, both in the Home itself and its grounds and by dedicated supporters in their own areas. The Sue Ryder 25's provide the time trialist with the opportunity of becoming one of those supporters.

The Home meets a need of the Community and it is from the Community that support is required. Any one of us may require the help of such a Home for ourselves or for someone we love.
