Dinner/Dance 1989: Esther Carpenter and Arthur Coleman have been to the Yelton Hotel to discuss the price and menu and it was agreed that the function be from 6-30pm to 12-30am at no extra cost. Tickets will therefore show 6pm for 6-30pm.

The Hotel asked that we had a break before the speeches in order that their staff could clear the tables and get away and we asked that someone be available in the hotel foyer with a wine list to take orders before the meal. Both requests were agreed.

The charge is to be the same as last year but the menus are slightly different and there is less choice. Esther Carpenter is to be asked to purchase prizes for the raffle as in previous years, with Committee members also making donations if they so wish. It was felt that too many prizes resulted in the raffle taking up an excessive amount of time.

It was suggested that a photograph of the founder members be taken with the plaque before the Dinner.

Esther Carpenter has agreed to print the menus, for which thanks were expressed, and Dave Morris is to be asked to print the tickets.
