

A LITTLE STOCKING FILLER

East Sussex Cycling Association formed November 10th 1946 at the Ash Tree Inn, Ashburnham, which remained the Headquarters of the Association for over 20 years. Founder Clubs were Rye Wheelers, Bexhill Wheelers, Hastings & St Leonards C & AC, Eastbourne Rovers C & AC, & Royal Tunbridge Wells Albion C & AC.

Of the founder clubs Hastings & Eastbourne Rovers are still flourishing clubs in East Sussex.

The Association boundary has been extended over the years and we now have 13 member clubs all based in Sussex.

Of the founder members Bill Collins & Roy Humphrey are still active within the sport. George Jenkins well known for his duels round about 1930 with Frank Southall was a founder member and still follows the sport with much interest and is at times seen at local Cycling Functions. The late Fred Marsh of the Hastings Club was one of our 1st Timekeepers.

At the 1st meeting R Humphrey agreed to act as Secretary/Treasurer on a temporary basis which has seen him remain in office ever since.

Our President is elected every year and clubs take it in turn to nominate the President; 1989 Brighton Excelsior have nominated Dick Jones.

A few years ago the Association elected Bill Collins & Roy Humphrey as Life Vice-Presidents.

1947 saw the Association promote Time Trials at all distances from 15 miles to 100 miles also catering for the ladies. Perhaps the most popular event of the season has been the opening event each year, the Hardriders, which has been run on only 2 different courses since the formation of the Association. Track Championships were promoted from 1949 until the late 1950's, mainly at Rye, Hastings, Eastbourne and Uckfield and Tunbridge Wells.

1950 saw the introduction of the 12 hours Time Trial, which unfortunately had to be discontinued in the 70's due to the ever increasing traffic on East Sussex roads.

The Association has always, especially in its 1st 20 years catered for the Social Side of Cycling and this was one of the reasons why the Association has flourished. We have organised New Years Parties, Summer Rallies, Church Services, Luncheons and Prize Presentation Sign Post Quests, and we always used to have a children's Party early in the New Year. Of recent years our main non racing events have been a Reliability Trial, ably organised by Charlie Robson & Ester Carpenter, and of course the usual Sunday informal Luncheon and Prize Presentation.

Many years ago now, I am not quite sure when, the Association started producing its own Magazine 'Bonk', which still appears 4 times a year. Maurice and Ester Carpenter have produced it now for us and over the years it has enabled the Associations clubs to let each other know what they are doing. It is a wonder that some of the scandal appearing has not led to action in the courts. The editors have produced the magazine without any cost to the Association and the very healthy state of our finances today are in no small measure due to Ester and Maurice

One point: the original affiliation fees for clubs was £2.2 shillings which stayed until decimalisation when it dropped to £2 and has now been increased to £3 for 1989. Entry Fees for Time Trials in 1947 was 2 shillings including the RTTC Levy of 3 pence.

East Sussex Cycling Association Variation of Course G838 Avoiding Budlett's Roundabout

START at red arrow by drain just north of bridge parapet on northbound carriageway of A22 approximately 370 yards south of Boship roundabout. Proceed to Boship roundabout where take first exit (A22). Continue on A22 through East Hoathly and Halland to Little Horsted roundabout on Uckfield by-pass. Take second exit (straight on) to turn at next roundabout — Uckfield roundabout (10.789 mls.). Encircle roundabout and retrace to Little Horsted roundabout. Take second exit (straight on) and continue to Pear Tree Farm crossroads, where LEFT on old A22 to Union Point roundabout (15.184 mls.). Encircle roundabout and retrace to Pear Tree Farm crossroads, where LEFT on A22 through Halland and East Hoathly to Boship roundabout. Take first exit and FINISH at red arrow on curb opposite large 'roundabout' sign, approximately 180 yards north of Boship roundabout.


