

Minutes of a Committee Meeting of the Fellowship of the '1066'

Warwick Dunford gave £5 as payment for two badges at a cost of £1-50 each and a £2 donation. This amount was placed in petty cash for stamps, etc. Further stamps at the reduced rate have been purchased and the petty cash now owes the chairman £3 which he will retrieve when further cash is received.

The Bank and Receipt Books were checked and approved.

Summer Meeting: The evening at the Albion Hotel was a success with ample food. Entertainment was provided by Denis Neaves and a good time seems to have been had by all.

The Chairman has since thanked the landlord for his efforts. 31, including 1 complimentary for Denis Neaves, were booked for and a profit of £12-50 was made.

Christmas Tea 1989: This has been booked at the Ash Tree Inn, Ashburnham, for 4-30pm on Sunday, 17th December, 1989. Prices have yet to be agreed.

It was decided that the mini-bus should be used again and Colin Sinden has agreed to make arrangements for this.

New Members: Soon after the last Committee Meeting Graham and Jane Lade expressed a wish to become Associate Members. To avoid calling a further Meeting the Chairman telephoned all Committee members and approval for this was obtained.

They have since verbally accepted their invitation and confirmation in writing is awaited.
