Dinner/Dance 1991: The Chairman provisionally booked both the venue and the band for 26th January 1991 and these have since been confirmed in writing by Esther Carpenter.

An announcement is to be made during the meal about the underground car park being closed at 11-15pm.

Financial: There had been no Bank Book transactions since the last Meeting and the Chairman has received a total of £55 in donations, £5 of which was from the guest speaker.

One badge has been sold at £1.50 and there is also the £18.06 profit from the dinner/dance.

All stamps have been used and it was agreed that £5 of the above be put to petty cash for the purchase of stamps.

This leaves a total of £69.56 to be banked.

The Bank and Receipt Books were checked and approved.

Summer/Autumn Meet 1990: The Chairman is to approach the landlord of the Royal Albion to see if last year's function can be repeated.

Christmas Tea 1990: The provisional for December 16th at the Ash Tree Inn is to be confirmed. Transport arrangements are to be left for future meetings.

Any other business: The Chairman pointed out that it will be necessary to appoint a new President prior to the next dinner and suggestions for this are to be discussed at the next Committee Meeting.

A discussion took place on possible future members for the Committee should the need arise but no firm conclusions were agreed.

Next Committee Meeting: The next Meeting was arranged for 8pm on Tuesday, 1st May, 1990, at 16 Brading Close, Hastings.

There being no further business to discuss the Chairman thanked all for their attendance and a vote of thanks was expressed to the Chairman and Secretary.
