IMPORTANT NOTICES

NUMBERS

- (i) These will be available at the START.
- (ii) Riders should exchange their number at the Tea Wagon, located at Event HQ after the race, for free tea or minerals.
- (iii) Riders are requested to call out their number to the timekeeper at the FINISH.

THE COURSE - G.952

- (i) Between the new Chichester West roundabout (Western end of Chichester by-pass) and Warblington RAB, the course follows the now renumbered A.259 (formerly old A.27).
- (ii) THE COURSE CONTAINS MANY ROUNDABOUTS AND RIDERS MUST EXERCISE GREAT CARE AT ALL TIMES, ESPECIALLY AT THE TURN AT LANGSTONE RAB AND, PARTICULARLY, AT CHICHESTER WEST RAB.
- (iii) NOT ALL ROUNDABOUTS WILL BE MARSHALLED, AND RIDERS MUST CONTINUE ON SAME ROAD AT ALL UN-MARSHALLED POINTS.

R.T.T.C. REGULATIONS

- (i) It is a District Regulation that NO vehicles shall be parked on the carriage-way within sight of the starting and finishing points.
- (ii) Reg. 49 (Observance of the Law) and Reg. 50 (Paced and Company Riding) will be strictly enforced.
- (iii) Avoid accidents - DO NOT RIDE WITH YOUR HEAD DOWN.

EVENT H.Q.

- (i) This year the S.C.A. 50 will have an Event HQ. This is located at Clapham & Patching Village Hall, which is on the A.280 about 1½ miles from the Start (on A.27).
- (ii) Riders should allow at least 15 minutes to ride from the Hall to the start point and collect/affix their numbers.
- (iii) Food & refreshments will be available after the event from the Tea Wagon located at the Village Hall.

CAR PARKING. Adequate car parking space is available at the Village Hall, and only the Timekeeper's car and Radio car are to be parked at the Finish.

RESULTS. Riders are requested NOT to approach the Timekeeper at the Finish, as all results will be transmitted by radio to the Village Hall and will be on display there.

50 MILES COURSE G.952

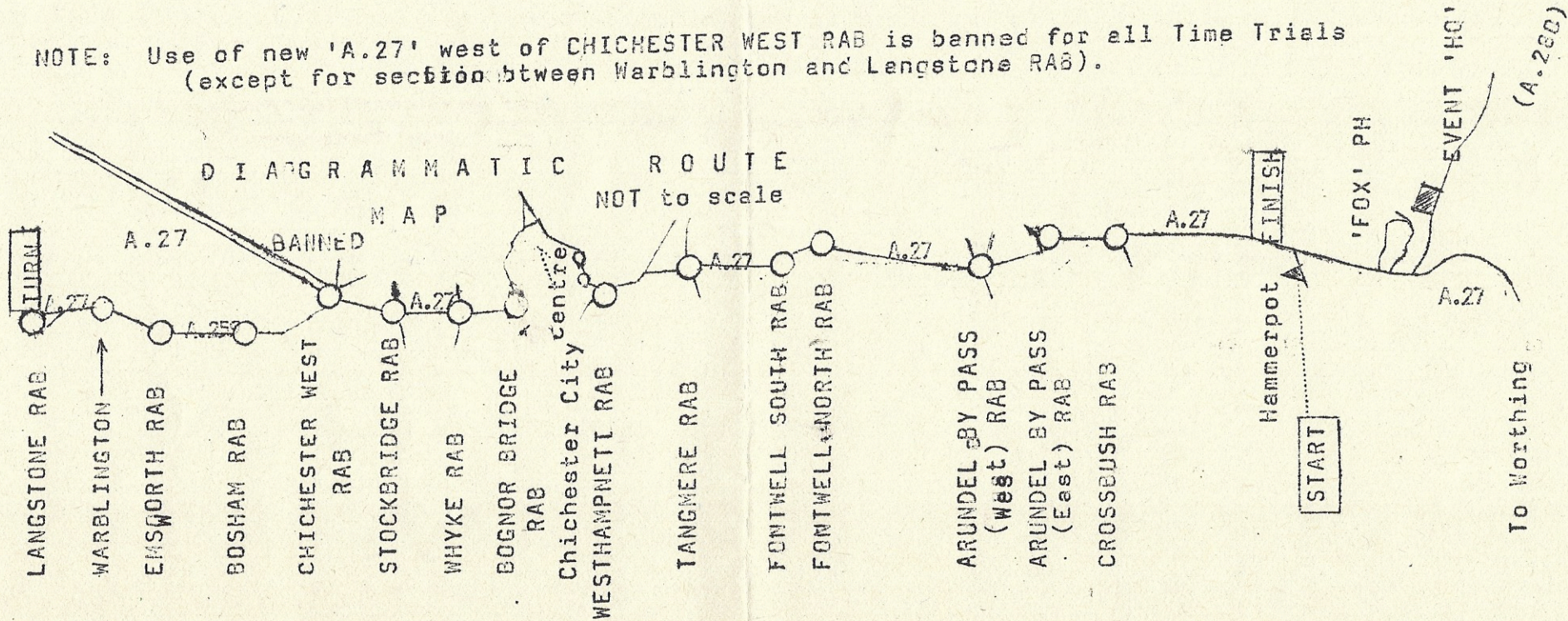
START (GR 073057) in Dappers Lane, at the 7th kerbstone from the junction with A.27. Proceed West on A.27 via Arundel by-pass, Fontwell, and Tangmere roundabouts to WESTHAMPNETT roundabout. (12.884m)

Take 2nd exit into Chichester via Sainsbury and mini roundabout to BEAR LEFT on one way system at Needlemakers to join A.259, continue over railway bridge to BOGNOR BRIDGE roundabout, to take 4th exit on A.27. Continue on A.27 via Whyke and Stockbridge roundabouts to CHICHESTER WEST roundabout, where take 1st exit on A.259 via Bosham and Emsworth roundabouts to rejoin the A.27 at WARBLINGTON. Leave the A.27 at slip road to TURN at LANGSTONE roundabout. (25.416 m)

Leave via slip road to rejoin A.27. Leave A.27 at slip road signed to EMSWORTH at WARBLINGTON to rejoin A.259, retrace via Emsworth and Bosham to CHICHESTER WEST roundabout (GREAT CARE), to leave by 3rd exit on A.27. Continue on A.27 via Whyke and Stockbridge roundabouts to BOGNOR BRIDGE roundabout (36.107 m)

Take 1st exit on A.259 into Chichester, following one way system to EASTGATE. KEEP RIGHT on A.266 via mini roundabouts to WESTHAMPNETT roundabout, take 2nd exit on A.27 east via Tangmere, Fontwell and Arundel roundabouts to FINISH (GR050059) at point opposite end of middle pavement on lay-by on South side of road, West of lane to Dover House. (50.000 m).

NOTE: Use of new 'A.27' west of CHICHESTER WEST RAB is banned for all Time Trials (except for section between Warblington and Langstone RAB).
