

IMPORTANT NOTICES

NUMBERS

- (i) These will be available at the START.
- (ii) Riders should exchange their number at the Tea Wagon, located at Event HQ after the race, for free tea or minerals.
- (iii) Riders are requested to call out their number to the timekeeper at the FINISH.

THE COURSE - G.952

- (i) Between the new Chichester West roundabout (Western end of Chichester by-pass) and Warblington RAB, the course follows the now renumbered A.259 (formerly old A.27).
- (ii) THE COURSE CONTAINS MANY ROUNDABOUTS AND RIDERS MUST EXERCISE GREAT CARE AT ALL TIMES, ESPECIALLY AT THE TURN AT LANGSTONE RAB AND, PARTICULARLY, AT CHICHESTER WEST RAB.
- (iii) NOT ALL ROUNDABOUTS WILL BE MARSHALLED, AND RIDERS MUST CONTINUE ON SAME ROAD AT ALL UN-MARSHALLED POINTS.

R.T.T.C. REGULATIONS

- (i) It is a District Regulation that NO vehicles shall be parked on the carriageway within sight of the starting and finishing points.
- (ii) Reg. 49 (Observance of the Law) and Reg. 50 (Paced and Company Riding) will be strictly enforced.
- (iii) Avoid accidents - DO NOT RIDE WITH YOUR HEAD DOWN.

EVENT H.Q.

- (i) This year the S.C.A. 50 will have an Event HQ. This is located at Clapham & Patching Village Hall, which is on the A.280 about 1½ miles from the Start (on A.27).
- (ii) Riders should allow at least 15 minutes to ride from the Hall to the start point and collect/affix their numbers.
- (iii) Food & refreshments will be available after the event from the Tea Wagon located at the Village Hall.

CAR PARKING. Adequate car parking space is available at the Village Hall, and only the Timekeeper's car and Radio car are to be parked at the Finish.

RESULTS. Riders are requested NOT to approach the Timekeeper at the Finish, as all results will be transmitted by radio to the Village Hall and will be on display there.

50 MILE COURSE - G952

START (GR 073057) in Dappers Lane at the 7th kerbstone from the junction with A27 proceed west on A27 via Arundel by-pass, Fontwell and Tangmere roundabouts to Westhampnett roundabout where take the 2nd exit into Chichester via Sainsbury and mini roundabouts to bear left on one way system at Needlemakers to join A259 continue over railway bridge to Bognor Bridge roundabout where take the 4th exit to rejoin A27 where continue west via Whyke and Stockbridge roundabouts to Chichester West roundabout where take the 1st exit on to the A259 via Bosham and Emsworth roundabouts to rejoin A27 at Warblington. Leave the A27 at slip road to TURN at Langstone roundabout (underneath fly-over) Leave via slip road at 4th exit to rejoin A259 retrace via the roundabouts at Emsworth and Bosham to the roundabout at Chichester West (GREAT CARE) take the 3rd exit to rejoin the A27 continue eastwards via roundabouts at Stockbridge and Whyketo Bognor Bridge roundabout where take the 1st exit left on A259 into Chichester following the one way system to Eastgate square bearing right on A286 via mini roundabouts and Sainsburys roundabout to Westhampnett roundabout where take the 2nd exit on the A27 continue east roundabouts at Tangmere and Fontwell and on the Arundel bypass to FINISH (GR 050059) at point marked at end of lay-by west of Dover Lane
