ESSENTIAL INFORMATION.

- 1. Event HQ is Upper Dicker Village Hall, on the B2108, just over a mile from the start. The B2108 is a turning off the A22 alongside the Jolly Chef Cafe, half-a-mile west of the Boship roundabout (junctions of the A22/A267/A271.) The hall will be open from 5.30 a.m. and CLOSED for about two hours from 7.00 a.m., when the key will be with a marshal at the Boship roundabout.
- 2. Numbers will be AT THE START, which is just over a mile from the hall. To get there, go LEFT at the crossroads south of the hall (signposted 'Hailsham and Arlington').
- 3. It is a District Council regulation that no vehicle shall be parked on the carriageway within sight of the start or finish. There is limited parking space in front of the hall and PLENTY more in the field at the side and rear the entrance is through a gate a few yards down the road.
- 4. Food will be available at the start (Kendal mint cake and bananas). Sponges and drink (good quality orange squash) will be handed up at about 50 and 75 miles.
- 5. Distance boards will be at 25, 50, 75, 90 and 95 miles and time checks at 50 and 75 miles.
- 6. Do not stop at the finish but continue on same road to the village hall another 330 yards.
- 7. Refreshments and the result board will be in the hall. We're hoping the showers will be working.

CC JRSE G865 (Revised May 1991)

START at red arrow opposite northernmost of four-bridge parapet posts in Arlington Road West on western outskirts of Hailsham (TQ562087). Proceed to junction with A22, where LEFT to Boship roundabout (2.86 miles). Take first exit and continue on A22 via East Hoathly and Halland and two roundabouts on the Uckfield bypass to Blackdown roundabout at the start of the Maresfield bypass (14.78). Go LEFT (A22) to Battswood roundabout at junction with A272 (15.52), where LEFT on A272 through Newick to take first LEFT past the Old Heritage (21.18). LEFT again at immediate T-junction with B2183 and continue to junction with A275 (21.98), where LEFT to rejoin A272 at the Kings Head, North Chailey (22.39). TURN RIGHT WITH GREAT CARE and retrace on A272 to Battswood roundabout (27.32) where LEFT up Maresfield bypass to TURN at the Lampool roundabout (28.38).

RETRACE to Battswood roundabout, where take second exit (STRAIGHT ON) and continue to Blackdown roundabout, where take second exit (RIGHT) and continue on A22 to Boship roundabout (42.13). Take third exit (RIGHT) and continue on A22 to junction with A27 at Polegate (45.85). LEFT on A27, through Polegate and along new Pevensey bypass, where STRAIGHT ON at roundabout (50.62) and follow A259 to TURN at Little Common roundabout (55.66).

RETRACE to Pevensey roundabout, where take fourth exit (CARE) and proceed via Wartling to join A271 at Windmill Hill (65.20). LEFT on A271 via Herstmonceux and Magham Down to Boship roundabout (71.22), where take second exit (STRAIGHT ON) to rejoin A22. Then via East Hoathly and Uckfield bypass to Blackdown roundabout (83.24) where LEFT and straight over Battswood roundabout to TURN at Lampool roundabout (85.05).

RETRACE to Boship roundabout (98.85), where TURN and RETRACE to B2108 (Jolly Chef - 99.30) and LEFT on B2108 to FINISH at red arrow by telegraph pole TP5(J8C), 98 yards beyond first 40mph sign on left (TQ555102).
