Dave Morris has again agreed to print the tickets and Esther Carpenter will print the menus. Tickets are to show 6pm for 6-30pm.

As usual Committee members agreed to supply raffle prizes and Esther Carpenter will buy more from the funds if required and also flowers for the guest speaker. Arrangements are in hand for the presentation of the Ladies Plaque to Joyce Marvell.

Financial Report: There have been no banking transactions since the previous Meeting so the balance remains at £453.01p. A donation of £15 has been received from Ron Longley, of which £5 went to Petty Cash for purchase of stamps and £10 is to be banked.

The Bank and Receipt Books were checked and approved.

New President: The Chairman had sent a note with the previous Minutes reminding members that it was time for a new president to be installed at the 1994 Dinner. He had had one reply by return and three more in the last few days. The Chairman asked for nominations and Sid Powell and Ernie Spray were put forward, with Ernie Spray winning the resultant vote.

The retiring President, Barbara Powell, will introduce the new President at the end of the Dinner.

New Member: Ron Taylor had suggested to the Chairman that David Heighway of C.C. Bexley and National Secretary of the Tricycle Association could be a suitable candidate for Associate Membership of the Fellowship. The Chairman had spoken to Mr. Heighway on this matter who said he would be most honoured to be considered for such membership.

After some debate the Committee agreed to offer him Associate Membership and the Chairman is to proceed with this matter.
