

Minutes of a Committee Meeting of the
Fellowship of '1066' Longmarkers
held at 16 Brading Close, Hastings
at 8.05 p.m. on Tuesday 10th January, 1995.

Present:

Minutes:

Christmas Meet 1994:

The Chairman reported that, as suggested, at the last Meeting, some Committee members visited the 'Harrow Inn' and thought it a suitable venue. After talking to the staff a booking for the inn's minimum of ten was made. In the event thirteen people assembled with twelve eating.

The evening was a success but nostalgic rumblings about the 'Ash Tree' were heard and as that inn has now reopened with the same landlady in charge we shall have to decide where we are going this year. The decision was deferred until a fuller Committee assembled.

Dinner/Dance 1995:

As instructed at the last Meeting the Chairman had visited the Yelton and met with a Joan White to discuss menus and costs.

The outcome was that the main course would be roast turkey and suitable vegetables with other courses as per the last Minutes at a cost to us of £9.50 per head compared to £12.50 per head stated on the printed menus supplied earlier.

This was approved by the few Committee members meeting at 'The Harrow' (to discuss the Christmas Meet) and it was agreed to price our tickets at £10.50 making them £1.50 cheaper than last year.

Tickets are going at the usual rate with twenty five paid for and between fifty and sixty booked so far.

Complimentary tickets for the Wild Oats and the Dunfords had been issued.

Esther had asked if we could let Ken Griffiths have his ticket for £8.00 and this was agreed in view of his financial situation.

Joyce Marvell has agreed to help with selling raffle tickets with Committee members providing prizes and Esther buying more if required.

The Chairman is to book the Hotel for next year on the night.

A sub-Committee to finalise details was arranged for Monday, 23rd January at 16 Brading Close.

Financial Report:

No transactions have taken place so the Bank balance remains at £463.01p. A donation of £10 has been received from Norman Channon so the Chairman has retrieved the £5.00 owing to him and put the remaining £5.00 into petty cash, which now contains £6.00, a few coppers and some stamps.

The Bank and receipt books were checked and approved.
