COURSE G866

START at yellow hydrant just past Arlington Transfer Station and near the speedway stadium in Arlington Road West on western outskirts of Hailsham (TQ572089). Forward to A22, where LEFT to Boship roundabout (2.29 miles). Take first exit and continue on A22 to B2124 at Golden Cross. LEFT via Laughton on B2124 to TURN at Kennel Comer roundabout, Ringmer (9.68).

RETRACE to A22 at Golden Cross (14.56), where LEFT with great care and stay on A22 straight across all roundabouts until the Blackdown roundabout at the start of the Maresfield bypass (23.26). Go LEFT (still on A22) to Batts Bridge roundabout at junction with A272 (24.06), where LEFT on A272 through Newick to take first LEFT past the Old Heritage (29.72). LEFT again at immediate T-junction with B2183 and continue to junction with A275 (30.52), where LEFT to rejoin A272 at the Kings Head, North Chailey (30.93). TURN RIGHT WITH GREAT CARE and retrace on A272 to Batts Bridge roundabout (35.86), where LEFT up Maresfield bypass to TURN at Lampool roundabout (36.91).

RETRACE to Batts Bridge roundabout, where STRAIGHT ON to Blackdown roundabout, where RIGHT and retrace on A22 to Boship roundabout (50.03). Take third exit (RIGHT) and continue on A22 to junction with A27 at Polegate (53.76). LEFT on A27, through Polegate and along Pevensey bypass, where STRAIGHT ON at roundabout (58.54) and follow A259 to TURN at Little Common roundabout (63.57).

RETRACE to Pevensey roundabout, where take FOURTH exit (CARE) and continue via Wartling to join A271 at Windmill Hill (73.11). LEFT on A271 via Herstmonceux and Magham Down to Boship roundabout (79.13), where take second exit (STRAIGHT ON) to rejoin A22. Stay on A22 to TURN at Copwood roundabout on the Uckfield bypass (89.13).

RETRACE to Boship roundabout (99.11), where TURN (taking fourth exit) and RETRACE to the Goldpine shop - junction with B2108 (99.55), where LEFT to **FINISH** at red arrow at drain 168 yards past TP12 opposite Robin Nurseries (TQ 561107).

INFORMATION FOR RIDERS

- 1. Event headquarters: Upper Dicker Village Hall, on the B2108,1¾ miles from the start, 600 yards from the finish. The hall will be open from about 5.15am and will be CLOSED for two hours from 7.15, when the key will be with a marshal at the Boship roundabout. Please, please, keep noise down at this ungodly hour, and don't wear shoeplates in the hall.
- 2. **Numbers** will be AT THE START. To get there, turn left at the crossroads in the village above the hall and follow signposts to Hailsham. Allow at least ten minutes.
- 3. Parking space in front of the hall is limited, but there is plenty more in the field at the side and rear. The entrance to the field is through a gate below the hall. Please park well away from the cricket/football pitches! A District Council regulation says no vehicles shall be parked on the road within sight of the start or finish.
