

Minutes of a Committee Meeting of the Fellowship of 1066 Longmarkers held at 16 Brading Close on February 26th, 2002, commencing at 7.40 p.m.

It was suggested that Sylvia Burgess should receive the Ladies Salver and the Chairman is to contact Mick Burgess, Lewes Wanderers, about this.

A.O.B.: Esther reported that she had issued the last of the Ladies Salver stocks and thought it best in future to buy one at a time and it was agreed that she should do this.

There being no further items the Chairman thanked all for their attendance and a vote of thanks was expressed to the Chair and approved by all.
