COURSE G50/10

START on A272 at raised manhole cover on grass verge approximately 50 yards west of entrance to Little Chef at West Grinstead (TQ182225). Proceed east to twin roundabouts at Cowfold. Take second exit (RIGHT) at first and first exit (LEFT) at second. Continue on A272 to Bolney roundabout just east of A23 flyover (5.49mls) (TQ267224) (CHECK).

Encircle roundabout and retrace to first of twin roundabouts at Cowfold. Take first exit (LEFT) and follow A281 to North Henfield roundabout (12.93mls) (TQ215167) (CHECK).

Encircle roundabout and retrace to twin roundabouts at Cowfold. Take first exit (straight on) at first and first exit (LEFT) at second and proceed to West Grinstead crossroads (20.07mls). Turn LEFT in filter lane to join A24 and proceed south to Washington roundabout (26.76mls). Take first exit (LEFT) and follow A283 to Bramber Castle roundabout. Take second exit (straight on) and proceed to Beeding Court roundabout (32.85mls) (TQ197098) (CHECK).

Encircle roundabout and retrace to Bramber Castle roundabout. Take third exit (straight on) and continue on A283 to Washington roundabout (38.99mls). Take first exit (LEFT) and follow A24 to Findon roundabout (41.94mls) (TQ119089) (CHECK).

Encircle roundabout and retrace to Washington roundabout. Take second exit (straight on) and follow A24 to turn LEFT at southern entrance to Dial Post village. Take next LEFT to FINISH in Swallows Lane at tree on western side of farm gate opposite PP12150 past entrance to Swallows Farm (TQ155202).
