

Additional Awards and Qualifications

This is a qualifying event for

ESCA points compelition - 30 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 30th place for riders from East Sussex CA affiliated clubs. The individual points earned by each rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club.

ESCA Trophies – counts towards the Junior and Ladies BAR. Counts towards the fastest Junior, fastest Lady and the fastest team of three from an East Sussex CA affiliated club over 10 miles – the best performance at either this, or the September 10, will be eligible for the award at the annual prize presentation in January 2010.

Course Details - G10/87

- Start in South Street, East Hoathly, at red arrow at drain 28 yards before T junction with East Hoathly by-pass
- Left and follow A22 through Whitesmith and Golden Cross to Boship Roundabout where TURN (4.9 miles)
- 4th exit to retrace on A22 through Golden Cross and Whitesmith to <u>FINISH</u> at red arrow at second drain
 past field gate on East Hoathly by-pass just before first footpath crossing and 334 yards past right turn
 (South Street) for East Hoathly (10 miles).

Safety Information for Start Sheets

- HELMETS: CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of
 your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a
 hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.
- COMPETITORS' MACHINES: It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is
 fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is
 in use.
- COMPETITORS' VEHICLES: No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish.
- Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first competitor has started.
- Details of any additional hazards, not listed on the start sheet, will be displayed or advised at the signing
 on point. All competitors must take note of these details when they sign on.
- No times will be given out at the finish.
- Competitors must exercise extra care when turning left just after the start and at Boship Roundabout.
- After finishing, competitors MUST continue to the Shaw roundabout and take second exit (Right) to return to event HQ at East Hoathly. No 'U' turns after finishing or competitors will be disqualified.
