

Helmets: CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

Competitors Machines: It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

Competitors Vehicles: No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish.


Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first competitor has started.

Course Details for G100/86E [2009 variation; due to developments in the Uckfield area].

WARNING The Start is Four and a Half miles from the HQ. Allow at least 20 minutes. The route will be signposted.

START Arlington Road West by Give Way sign just before junction with A22 Northbound. LEFT and follow A22 via Boship RBT to junction with B2124. LEFT on B2124 to TURN at Kennel Corner RBT, Ringmer. RETRACE to A22 at Golden Cross. LEFT and follow A22 to TURN at Lampool RBT. RETRACE A22 to Boship RBT. RIGHT on A22 to Cophall RBT. LEFT on A27 to Pevensey RBT. STRAIGHT ON, now A259, to TURN at Little Common RBT. RETRACE to Pevensey RBT. RIGHT on unclassified road via Wartling to junction with A271 at Windmill Hill. LEFT on A271 to [Drinks station just before] Boship RBT. STRAIGHT ON, now on A22, to junction with B2124. LEFT on B2124 to TURN at Kennel Corner RBT. RETRACE to A22 at Golden Cross. LEFT and follow A22 to TURN at Black Down RBT. RETRACE on A22 to Boship RBT. RETRACE on A22 to Coldharbour Road. LEFT to FINISH.

Headquarters

Berwick Village Hall [BN26 6TF]. Car Parking in field at back of Hall. Directions to HQ:

- From A27: follow Berwick Station signs at Alfriston roundabout. Hall is on Left 400 yards after Level Crossing.
- From A22 Uckfield: take Camberlot Road South (opposite Willow Café), then right in 1 mile. Hall is on right after 2
 miles; 100 yards beyond village and '30' signs.
- From Boship roundabout: take A22 towards Uckfield for 600 yards, then first Left into Coldharbour Lane. Hall is on right after 3 miles; 100 yards beyond village and '30' signs.

Hall will be Open for changing from 0500.

Numbers to be collected and late information consulted when you sign on.

Drinks Station at 65 miles. You can leave your drink at HQ when signing-on; water will be handed-up. Numbers to be returned for a free tea.
