Car Parking

The village hall car park shares a common entrance with the car park for the White Horse Inn. Please park only in the village hall spaces which are marked in white. The White Horse parking spaces are marked in yellow and are not to be used under any circumstances. When the hall car park is full please park sensibly in the road – village hall side only.

Race Numbers

Numbers will be available at the event HQ. Please collect your number when you sign on. Notice of any additional hazards to be aware of on the course will be displayed next to the signing on sheet. After the event please return your race number to the event HQ in exchange for a cup of tea or coffee.

Warming Up

Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the event has started, and to show courtesy towards the churchgoers at the Church of St John the Evangelist just before the start, and at the Ebenezer Chapel before the finish.

Start

Proceed out of the car park and turn right. The start is located approx 300 yards south of the village hall.

Please pay attention to the following CTT regulations and recommendations

- **HELMETS:** CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.
- **COMPETITORS' MACHINES:** It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.
- **COMPETITORS' VEHICLES:** No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish.

This is a qualifying event for

- ESCA points competition – 30 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 30th place for first claim riders from East Sussex CA affiliated clubs. The individual points earned by each rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club.
- ESCA Trophies – The fastest rider from an East Sussex CA affiliated club will be awarded the Page Tankard at the annual prize presentation in January 2011.
- SCA SPOCO – 120 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 120th place for first claim riders from Sussex CA affiliated clubs.

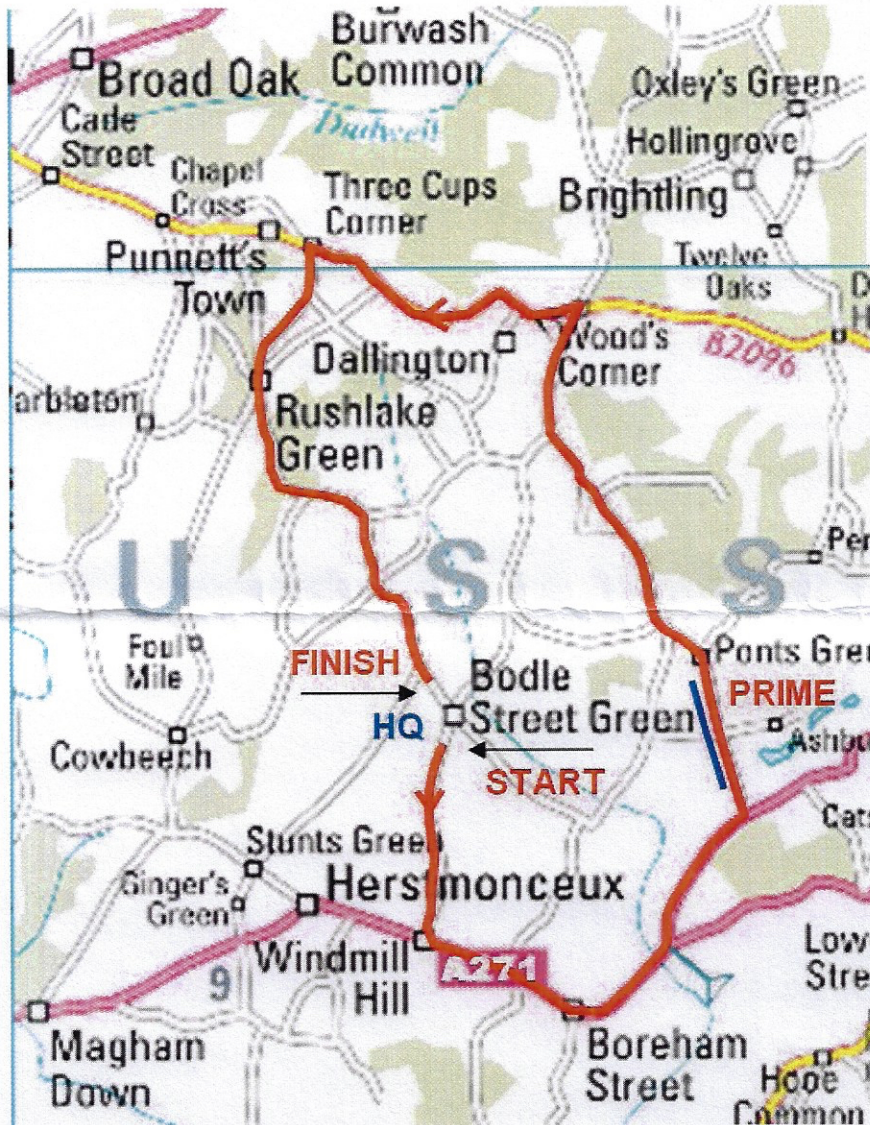

Course Details GS/895: Bodle Street Green / Windmill Hill / Ashburnham / Woods Corner / Three Cups Corner / Rushlake Green / Bodle Street Green – A271 / B2096.



Start at southern end of metal field gate on unclassified road 95 yards south of Toll Lane and Church of St. John the Baptist at Bodle Street Green and 27 yards south of derestriction sign (TQ6501142).

Proceed south to Windmill Hill, where fork left into Joe's Lane (M). Follow Joe's Lane to junction with A271 by Windmill Hill Garage where left (M) (CARE) on A271 through Boreham Street and downhill to turn left still on A271 (M). **3.49 miles**

Continue on A271 uphill past Kitchenham Farm to next junction signposted Ponto Green and Woods Corner (M). **4.58 miles**

Left on unclassified road via the 'hill prime' Agony Hill and Ponto Green to T-junction with B2096 at Woods Corner (M). **8.75 miles**

Left on B2096 (CARE) down Carricks Hill, through Earls Down to Three Cups Corner (M). **10.79 miles**

Left and proceed for 57 yards past telephone box to junction with Middle Lane (M) (CARE). Bear left and follow Middle Lane through Turners Green to junction at Rushlake Green (M). **11.99 miles**

Left and at corner of the green (M), continue straight on via Great Iwood and past Sandhills Farm and Tiles Farm to the finish at red arrow on drain 150 yards past Chilsham Lane (and Ebenezer Chapel) and 53 yards south of entrance to South Cottage (TQ650148). **15.06 miles**

Competitors must exercise care when joining the A271 at Windmill Hill, when joining the B2096 at Woods Corner, and when joining Middle Lane (just after turning left at Three Cups Corner).

Hill Prime

This is on the unclassified road between the left turn from the A271 and Ponto Green. It is approx 1 mile in length and includes Agony Hill – a well known spectator point in the original ESCA Hardriders event of the 1940/60s. The start of the hill prime will be indicated by a blue flag and finish by a white flag. This is what you've got to look forward to! →
