Result Sheet

With across the board entries down this season and a number of cancellations on grounds of not enough entries or not enough marshals, or a combination of both, the Association is pleased to have put this event on and seen some excellent times. Many thanks to the efforts of members of ESCA affiliated clubs for stepping up and making sure the event went ahead, and of course many thanks to the riders that entered.

Roadworks on the A22 meant that an emergency course had to be ready for use. Very many thanks to Peter Moon of Eastbourne Rovers, and current ESCA President, for dusting off a course provisionally designed a few years ago and getting it set up. Riders were consulted and were OK with the backup option which would have meant four legs between the Black Down and Shaw roundabouts. The roadworks were completed early so we were able to use the G50/89 course after all. The handbook had the course down as the G50/90 which had been used for the last 10 or so years but could not be used this year due to the HQ not being available.

There was a delay in uploading the start sheet to the CTT web site until the Thursday morning so apologies to those that checkout the Spindata tab which did not have the Predicted Times since the upload had missed the Wednesday deadline to be included in the data crunch prior to the event. It was only earlier this year that I checked out what the Spindata tab is about. Have a look at the post event data for the April ESCA 25 at:

If the start sheet is uploaded in time to be in the data crunch Spindata predicts the time for every rider, based on past performances. After the event the Predicted Time and actual Time are listed as in the example link above. Those that are making good improvements are flagged with the "on fire" logo, two logos if making very good progress. Spindata also gives vets "plus" (and "minus".....) based on Veterans Standard times provided by the VTTA.

Results were emailed directly to riders on the day of the event and to Snowdon Sports who produced an excellent report that is well worth a read on the CTT web site and available at: https://www.cyclingtimetrials.org.uk/race-report/23939#anchor

The results were uploaded to the CTT web site on the Monday morning after the event and the basic pdf result sheet was available to download that day and until this full result sheet was uploaded as the "Cover Sheet" a month later.

Times for the top 6 placed riders and top 3 women were in Cycling Weekly 16 June 2022, page 54.

This result sheet includes a table for "Riders times in order of placings at 25 miles". Very many thanks to timekeepers Richard and Su for marshalling the turn at 25 miles and recording the split times.
