

Veteran Cyclist and Clock-Maker MR. F. MARCH

Mr. Frederick March, the well-known Kent and Sussex veteran cyclist, of 62, Mount Road, Hastings, died on Thursday last week. He was aged 77.

Mr. March was a former active member of Kent and Sussex Cycling Fellowship. He was a clock-maker by trade.

Old cycling friends and representatives of Hastings and St. Leonards and other cycling clubs, timekeepers and other cycling interests were among those attending the funeral at the Borough Cemetery on Wednesday.

The Rev. C. Champneys Burnham officiated.

The mourners were Mr. H. March, Miss E. March, Miss C. March, Mr. P. Bliss, Mr. T. Harrison (representing Kent and Sussex Cycling Fellowship), members of Hastings British Legion branch and many other friends.
