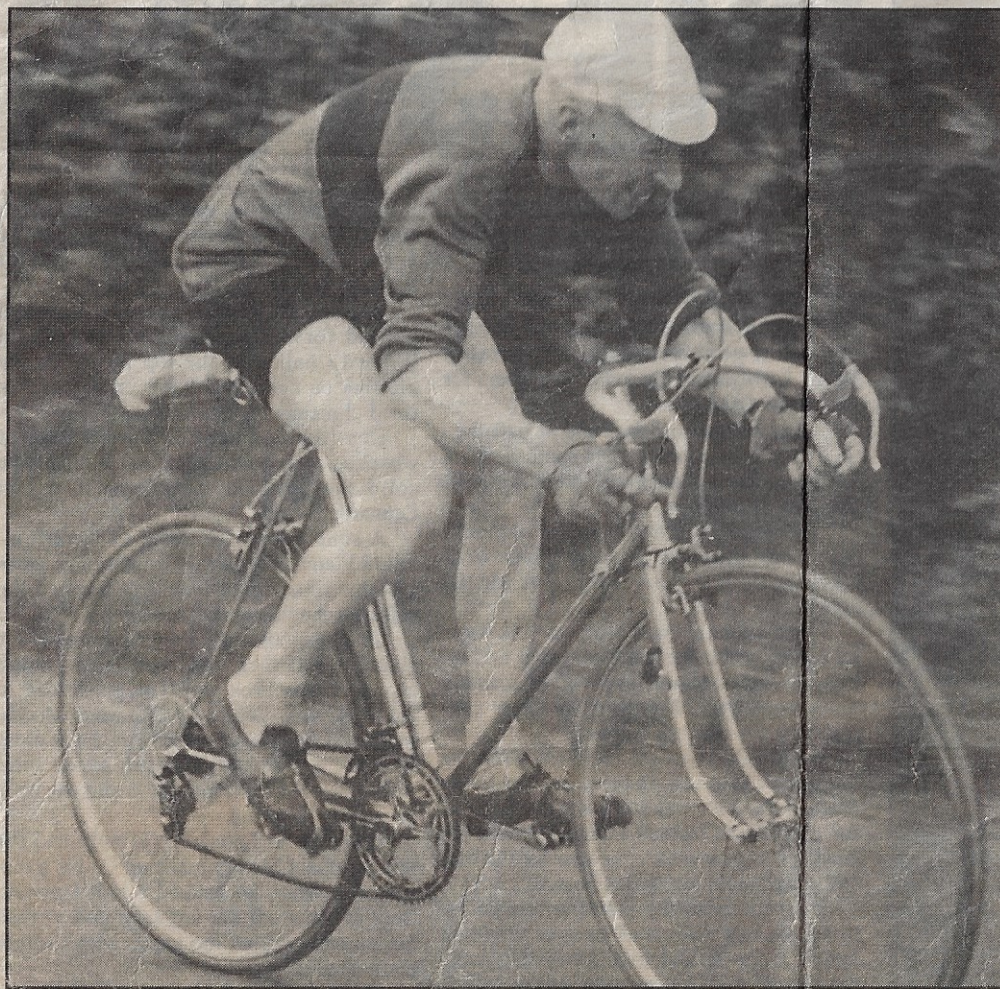

FANATICAL cyclist Jack Southerden, who clocked up an incredible 500,000 miles since 1949, died on January 13 following a heart attack. He was 85.

Southerden was born in Hastings on November 5, 1915, and although cycling was to dominate his adult life, amazingly he never learned to ride until he was 15.

He spent a brief spell with Hastings Wheelers before switching to the Hastings & St Leonards Cycling Club in 1934, and he remained with them ever since, holding various official positions including chairman in the 50s and president in the 90s until his death.

He also wrote the club's history from 1876 to 1956 and had it published as 'Eighty Years Awheel'.

His love affair with cycling was interrupted by World War II, during which he was among those who

landed on the Normandy beaches in the first hour of D-Day, and in 1949 he began to keep a detailed record of his pedalling history.

Southerden covered 11,640 miles that year, which increased to a high of 22,380 in 1953 — an amazing 61 miles a day — before joining the prestigious 300,000 club in 1975.

He didn't stop there. Following his retirement in 1977 he covered almost 20,000 miles for three years running and although a series of eye operations later slowed him down, he finally passed the half a million mark in 1997.

He also landed the East Sussex CA BAR (Best All Rounder) title in 1950 for recording the highest average speed for a 25, 50 and 100 mile race as well as a 12 hour event.

His funeral on Monday was well-attended by the cycling community, which has lost a truly inspirational figure.
