## CLUB EVENTS – this week's H&StL CC TT is at Ninfield:

Wed. 29 May Ninfield circuit (14) GS/883 Sign in 18.30 first rider off 19.00

Sign on for the Ninfield event this week is the normal 18:30 for first off at 19:00

Next week for Hastings-Rye-Hastings it will be the later time of 19:00 first off at 19:30 There is then a three week break with someof us riding 10 mile TTs over at Goodwood.

Ninfield Circuit TTs - Sign on in Downs View off Church Lane (TN33 9LF).

New from 2021: The start is at the junction of Church Road and the main road

Start at the junction of Church Road and the main road, go through Ninfield and down Standard Hill, through Boreham Street then about 150 yards after Boreham Mill Nurseries (BN27 4SF) turn left on to Wartling Road TAKING GREAT CARE SINCE CARS COMING FROM HAILSAM AND TURNING HAVE RIGHT OF WAY.

**TAKE GREAT CARE** about 800 yards after the turn on the fast descent into the left hand bend where the road surface is rough in places. If you have not practised taking the corner at speed it is strongly advised that you back off on your speed.

Continue across the marsh to Pevensey roundabout. Left on to the main A279, **GIVE WAY TO TRAFFIC**.

Take first left signed Battle and after 100 yards **TAKE CARE** joining the road from the Lamb on the marsh to Hooe and finish at the Ninfield village sign.

Results are announced about 600 yards after the finish line by the bus shelter opposite the village shop and then we go to the Red Lion, Hooe for refreshments.
