This gave him a margin of 37 seconds over club-mate **Laurie Holmes** and 1 minute 31 seconds advantage over **Mark Blagden** (Manchester Wheelers)

Jack Macklam took the Fastest Vet Award with a credible 59.54 which also ensured that Leeds St Christophers won the Team Prize.

Most riders found the going tough, with only 12 beating the hour as compared with 46 being "inside" in the recent Huddersfield RC event on this same uncompromising course.

Dudley Hayton (East Bradford) notched up a notable win in the Yorkshire Cycling Federation Association 25 when he recorded 55.48 on the V135 (Knaresborough - York)

Competitors, helpers and on-lookers all enjoyed the warm Spring sun-shine but riders had to contend with difficult traffic conditions on the York Ring Road. This stretch was brought in to use when the Course was modified due to road works at Knaresborough and must have adversely affected the times of most, if not all, the riders. However, there would have been no event at all had it not been for the prompt actions of the Organiser and RTTC Officials who adjusted the course at short notice.

Second place in the Event went to in form **Brian Sunter** (Condor RC) who was just 17 seconds adrift with 56.05 which, in turn, was 17 seconds faster than 3rd placed **Steve Vaughan** (Morley CC) on 56.22.

Scratchman Derek Roe (Morley CC) returned in 57.05 and with team-mate **Malcolm Davidson** achieving 57.16 the Morley CC were assured of the Team Award.

The Morley CC also scored by taking the fastest Junior Prize thanks to a fine effort from **A.S.Robinson**, who was the fastest rider in the first half of the field, with 58.56.

The Ladies Prize went to **Yvonne McGregor** (who, in this Association Event, was riding for her second claim club - Huddersfield Star Wheelers) with a fine 1.1.14

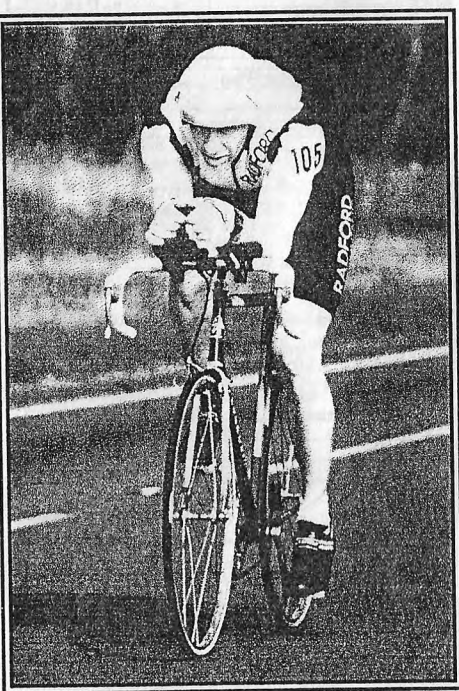

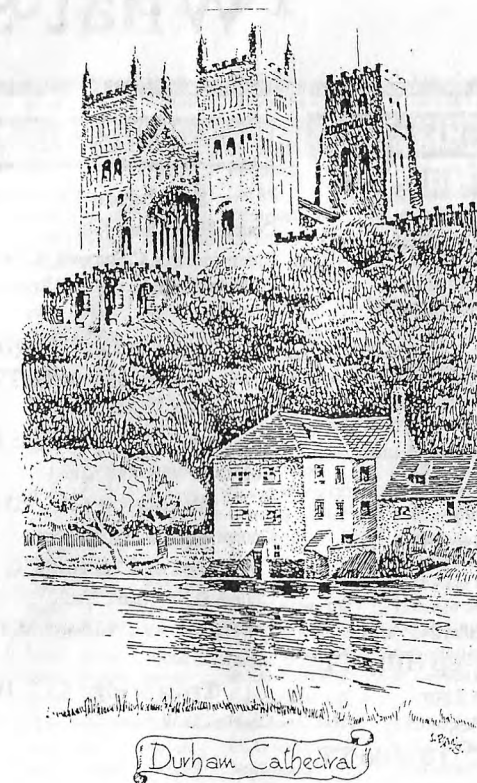

1992 Men's NATIONAL 50 MILE TIME TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Roadworks on the A38 have meant that the course for the 1992 Men's National 50 Mile Time Trial Championship has had to be changed.

The road improvements, which include contra-flow work, in the Plympton area not scheduled to be completed till the weekend after the Championship.

The District Committee have, with the promoting Plymouth Corinthian Cycling Club, moved the event headquarters from South Brent to Liverton, near Newton Abbot.

Despite the shortness of the notice of change Frank Spry, the Event Secretary, has now completed all the amended arrangements such that the potential competitors will not notice any difference when the event is run on Sunday 28th June.

The revised course has a course record of 1 hour. 54mins.18secs. set by Simon Knight of the Mid-Devon Road Club on one of the few really good days that the exposed A38 has seen.

From a 'gift' downhill start on the old A38 some 15 miles South West of Exeter the riders reach the A38 dual carriageway in 1 mile. They continue towards Exeter till reaching Chudleigh Bridge where they turn via the overbridge at 3.9.miles. There is a 24 mile stretch to Lee Mill about 9 miles East of Plymouth and riders turn through the underpass to repeat the outward route to Drumbridges interchange where they return to the old A38 and the finish in 0.75 mile.

As to be expected the course has its fair share of Devonshire hills.
