Choughs 25 for Polkinhorne: Parker's misfortune

In a dress rehearsal for the 1993 Men's National 25 Mile Championship 17 year old Nigel Polkinhorne set a course record for the rolling and exposed S18/25 mile course.

the 'T' shaped course starts within sight of the Atlantic Ocean and close to St. Agnes. It gradually descends to the outskirts of Truro, climbs back to the A30 and then runs along the Redruth and Camborne by-passes past the ruins on many tin mine engine houses. Much of this road is either on elevated bankings or through cuttings. All of this would make it very hard on a windy day. Fortunately for these promotions the Choughs were blessed with light breezes. Many personal best's resulted for local riders.

Polkinhorne's winning margin of 1min.16secs. was extended due to an untimely puncture for runner up Andrew Parker. Parker, recently returned from the Tour of Guadeloupe, had the misfortune to puncture at the 18 mile turn as he descended the slip road. He had to run back up the road and was able to borrow a front wheel from a marshal who had cycled to his position.

With 20 year old Jon Butt in third spot it was Dave Barnes who was the first of the older generation and the only other Sub-hour ride. His plus was over 1min.15. seconds too good for any other veteran.

I was interested to see your account of the 300,000 Mile Club Members, as I was the originator of the Club, when I sent a letter to the Editor of "Cycling" in 1962. Within a few weeks of that letter being printed in "Cycling" I had letters from about a dozen claiming that they had done at least 300,000 miles, properly recorded.

We soon organised our first Weekend, at Stratton Audley, Bucks, on September 22nd,1962, when six founder members met to officially form the club. The six were Tommy Chambers. (Glasgow), Jock Austin. (Oxford),Lawrie Plummer.(Hitchin), Harry Keates. (Reading), Bert Houghton. (Beckenham) and myself, then living at Weybridge.

Our numbers soon rose to about twenty, later to thirty, where we stayed for quite a few years, until a recent influx of new members has brought the total up to fifty.

Apart from Harry Keates article I do not think we have ever had an account of the early days of the 300,000 Club, so I would be pleased if you could find space to print this letter.

Brooks scenic win

Clive Brooks (Polytechnic CC) winner of the New Forest CC "Around the Forest" 36 mile time trial is a tiger on the bike, but a relaxed cat off it.

At 34 he says "I don't worry about going fast. I know the form will come".

Not that he has much to worry about, having won four events this year. He agrees, "I have done one or two goos rides, getting a few scalps."

With the South DC wanting all events off the roads by 9.00.am. Aircraft fitter Clive, had to get up at 3.30.am. to start, after being up till midnight at a disco the night before.

One unable to face the early start, was potential winner Jeremy Short (Antelope RT) who would have had to catch the Ferry from the Isle of Wight at 2.00.am, because of a change of time tables. With the ferry port at Lymington only seven miles from the start, it would have been almost a local event for him.

Also missing, on international duty was Richard Prebble (Wembley RC).

A few were happy to ride around the course to look at the New Forest scenery, and second placed Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) found it difficult to judge his form after riding fast courses. He thought he was not going so well until he counted that he had passed thirteen.

With racing over at 9.00.am. most riders were wondering what to do with themselves, but Lee had it planned, he was off to work for the rest of the day.

Third place Glen Pickford was another one thinking about improving. His principal ambitions are for road racing, but he uses time trials to build up his form and his speed. For him a hard ride in a time trial is the best mental preparation for a road race.

He is in the middle of a heavy training programme, which involves a hard racing or training session every day.

Fourth placed Terry Icke (Poole Wheelers) led his team to victory and took the veteran prize saying significantly "getting a bit close", the gap is not so big this week" At 48 he finds it takes a bit longer to get fit.

Obituary

Well-known time triallist John Nickolls, Verulam CC, has died at the age of 52 after a long fight against cancer.

So dependable was he as a team-mate that he was known as 'Mr 59'. John had personal bests of a short 56 and a 1-56 '50' dating back to the mid-60s, and had raced in many parts of the country.

He joined the St.Albans-based club after touring with CTC Herts DA. and Lampard RC. After spells with clubs including Welwyn Wheelers, Letchworth Velo, Edgware RC and St Ives CC, he had rejoined in recent seasons, and was racing in its colours until the middle of last season.

His much appreciated, wry sense of fun and good humour in the face of adversity was never more apparent than during his last illness. Ironically, he died in a hospice at Mogerhanger, Beds., near the turn of one version of the F1 '25' course, scene of many of his best rides.

John Nickolls will be greatly missed by a wide circle of friends. He leaves his wife, Kathy, to whom he was married only last year, and a son, Martin, from an earlier marriage.

Moreys Isle of Wight Cycling Festival.

Times were of secondary importance in Moreys three day time trialling Grand Prix in the Isle of Wight and the biggest loser under this formula was the defending champion, Glenn Longland.

A year ago he won all three stages but things began to go wrong for him within an hour of the start this time when he stripped the thread of his gear lever boss while warming up for the opening hill climb at Shanklin. Though he overcame that problem well before his starting time his chances of repeating last year's runaway victory were dashed when he punctured just after catching his minute man, Colin Wheeler (Regent RC) who sportingly offered to change cycles.

Longland preferred to continue for the remaining mainly level mile to the finish; a decision which nearly brought him down when his flat tyre skidded beneath him just short of the line, and it took him twenty two seconds longer than the Bath C.C. pair, Phil Marshall and Rob Pears, who tied for first place.

Numbered 10 and 40 in a field of 82, they had enjoyed warm sunshine for their 2.3 mile rush up Cowleaze Hill, but the temperature dropped quickly for the later starters as thick cloud suddenly appeared and the last half-dozen were drenched by cold, stinging rain.

The British Best All-Rounder wasted no time making amends on Sunday morning by winning the second stage, round a new 25 mile circuit in the western half of the island, by over 3.30. minutes from his clubmate Peter Pickers, and he extended that advantage to more than five minutes on a much hillier 52.5 mile circuit on the final day, but those margins might just as well have been measured in

seconds so far as overall classification was concerned.

Having gained a lead on the first stage, the Bath duo had no intention of giving up their positions without a fight, and Pears even increased his two point lead to four after the 25, in which he was edged out of third place by Chris Salter (Vectis Roads CC) - a member of the promoting club making a welcome return to racing after a long absence but his position did not affect the overall classification as he only entered this one event.

This situation also applied to the third man, Jeremy Short (Antelope RT) in stage three, but he might have made second place if he had not punctured three miles from the finish as he was fighting to hold the pace of Longland, who had caught him for five minutes after 44 miles.

Pears slipped to sixth place on this stage, but Short was one of two who finished faster but were ineligible for the final classification, and that left the Bath C.C. man the outright winner by two points from Yorkshire visitor, Phil Barlow (Kiveton Park CC) with the 1990 winner, Pickers, another point away in third spot.

All three, plus Longland and his club's veteran winner Alan Dawson, are no strangers to this popular cycling festival, and others who have become regular supporters of this annual event were members of Farnborough & Camberley CC. (who provided the best veteran on standard in Martyn Winter) Farnham R.C. (17 year old Barry Robinson was top junior) Hitchen Nomads CC. Guernsey Velo, Mid-Oxon CRT. and Peterborough CC. and at least one newcomer, Welsh Commonwealth Games girl, Clare Greenwood (Byways RCC) promised she will return, after winning the women's category on all three days.
