Adkins beats Pritchard with course and event record.

Eddie Adkins (Manchester Wheelers) survived a re-check in the Banbury Star '25' to defeat course record holder John Pritchard, by forty seconds in 52.24.

All the excitement was left to last, with the Express RT man off number 120 chasing Adkins who had started five minutes ahead.

According to amateur timekeepers, the lead sawed and some gave Pritchard the advantage cicee to the finish. Quite properly John requested a re-check.

Jim Randle who must be one of the longest-serving event secretaries, organising this event without a break for some thirty years, said that the timekeeper's finishing sheet showed that Eddie had caught and dropped his five-minute man, Southend's Mike Hennessey. His victory, beating both the Express man's 52.54. course best and Darryl Webster's year old event record 53.17. for good measure, was his second 52-min ride in successive weeks.

In the wake of the two ex-competition record holders, up-and-coming riders vied for third place with Bio RT's Andy Sharpe the fastest of three 56-min men ahead of promising midlander Wayne Elliott, Concorde RC, and Century's Mike Williams.

Les White continued his winning ways on standard, where there were three age groups, his 10th-placed 58.21. being pressed for once by someone of his own age (57) visiting Yorkshireman Vaughan Caswell ending a holiday in the south by taking in the scenic Aylesbury-Bicester course and recording 59.55.

At the other end of the age scale John Pritchard's 14 years young son Ceri continued to impress with 59.36.

VC Slough's Steve Seebby gave notice of returning form after winter spent mountain biking, with 58.36. in his second event of 1992.

VTTA Championship '10'

Welsh invader John McKellow of Cardiff Ajax became a National Champion for the first time when Merseyside Group of the VTTA incorporated the Vets National 10 in their Oscar Dover Memorial event.

John is the brother of the famous Don McKellow and originates from London but his job with Rolls Royce took him to Derby, then overseas and eventually to South Wales where he says he will stay in retirement as he loves riding round the beautiful country there.

John went off number 105 in a field of 107 entrants and at the age of 65 his actual time of 24.15 gave him a winning plus of 6m.45s.

Some people were saying John had the best of conditions as a late starter. Runner-up Don Hacking of Birkenhead North End CC was off number 40, just as the rain was abating. Still he did an excellent 23.27 for a plus of 6m.21s. and had the consolation of leading the winning team from BNE with support from his club President Gordon Thompson (69) and Bill Davidson (60). Actual fastest was young 43 year old Phil Guy of Mid Shropshire Wheelers who did 22.15.

A special mention must go to the super vets ie: those seventy or over who took part, led by Harry Aspden, at 80 (81 in June), the oldest man in the field and 'youngsters' like H. Greenhalgh Vegetarian C & AC (77) event secretary Leo Madden (77) Harry Hill Middleton CC (76) Harry Harding Walton C & AC (74) and Gill Taylor Rhos on Sea (71).

The course which is a figure nine circuit uses approximately 6.5 miles of main road, the last 3.5. miles being on winding country lanes. Gethin rides the 10's as a second claim member of the Wheelers.

Andy Corbett's Weekend double

This was the first promotion of hopefully many Teesdale mountain time trials, on a very tough course from Barnard Castle to Stanhope and back, crossing Bollilhope Common in each direction. there were forty eight entries with only six non-starters and only one DNF. Hot favourite Chris Newton, Middridge CRT could not start after being in an accident in the Stockton Wheelers 10, the previous day.

Andrew Corbett's 1.50.23. was a brilliant winning ride and will certainly give riders in coming years something to beat.

The general consensus after the event was that Dave Robinson should stick with the event, and that it will hopefully build from here. The course while very tough could become a classic.

The changing and post race facilities were excellent and much appreciated as were the event sweat shirts which went down like a proverbial 'lead balloon'

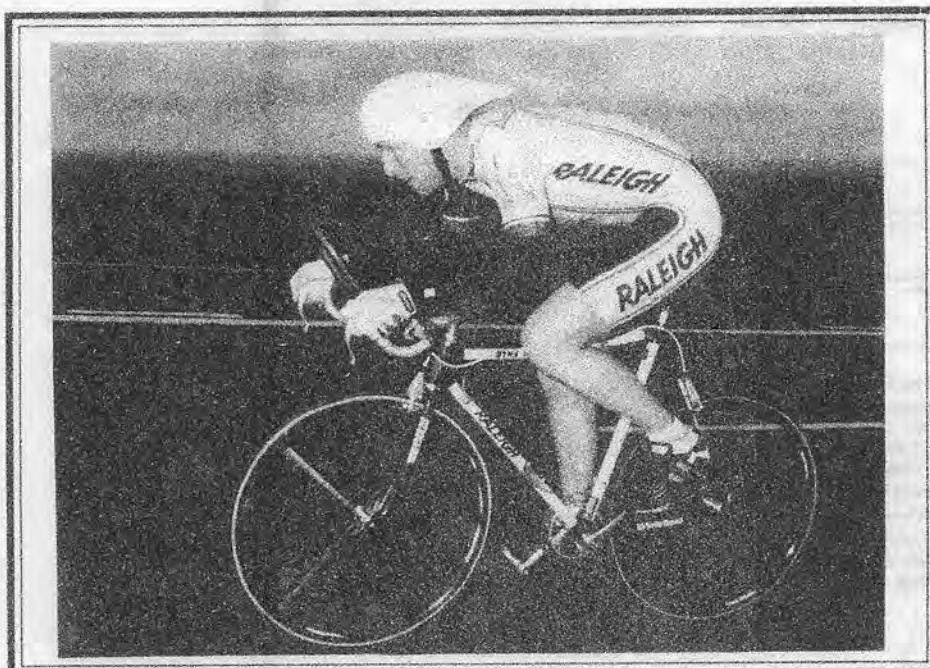
