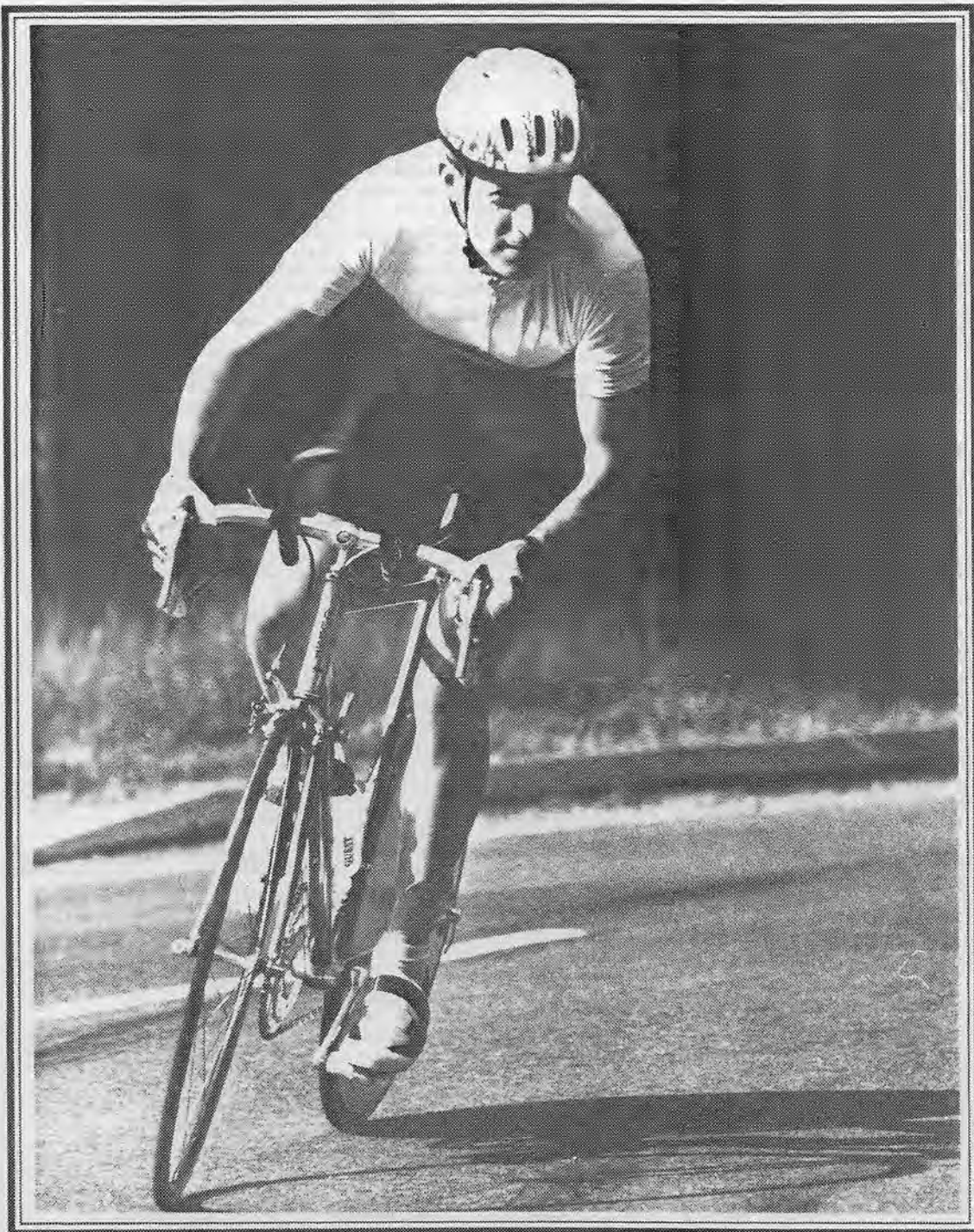

Boardman's 4th National Championship '25'

Chris Boardman, GS Strada, duly won his fourth consecutive 25-mile championship in Cumbria, with yet another storming ride which put almost every other competitor in the shade. His winning margin of 1m 24s. over Scotland's Graham O'Bree may not have been the widest such margin in the history of the championship, but it certainly was enough to emphasise that there is no-one around to touch the Wirral man at the moment.

And even though Boardman was unable to beat his championship best of 49.15. set last year, he did lead the Strada, even without Scott O'Brien, to a new championship record team aggregate.

The day dawned fine and dry at Cockermouth, on the northern fringe of the Lake District, and with only a slight East wind blowing along the more exposed stretches of the A66, early spectators with local knowledge predicted fast times.

It was cold for the early starters, but the day soon warmed, and hundreds turned out to see the cream of the country's short-distance man contest a title-race that closed inside 55 minutes.

First finisher was Dominic Sweeney, Invicta RC., who was perhaps unlucky to have a start number of 5. His 54.32. was a fine ride at that stage of the event, and was all but matched by two other early starters, Graham Waddington, Pendle Forest, and Phil Silver, VC Slough, numbers 10 and 11 respectively. The growing crowds were impressed, and predictions were quickly buzzing around as to the eventual winning time. RTTC Chairman Graham Morris predicted a '52', but others reckoned that wouldn't even get a place on the podium. How right they were proved.

BAR runner-up of 1991 Kevin Dawson, now in the GS Strada, added to the list of 54's at number 35, and ten minutes later, North East super-vet Mick Bradshaw, winner of the '50' title in 1988 came in with yet another, but Stuart Dangerfield had been seen flying out to the 12-mile turn, and he took the lead with a great 52.41. But it only kept him in the lead for a scant nine minutes, because Greenock RC's O'Bree, riding the latest version of his unorthodox machines, and receiving terrific support from English and Scottish onlookers alike, was next home with 51.25. Yet within minutes of finishing, he was expressing disappointment. 'It's not enough', he reasoned. 'Boardman will beat that, for sure.' What he modestly forgot to say was that he's recently moved house, and has a young baby giving him and his wife sleepless nights. Not exactly conducive to winning a championship, but it certainly puts his ride into perspective.

By now the sun was well and truly up, every lay-by along the scenic A66 between Cockermouth and Keswick was crammed with eager onlookers, and there was an almost continental flavour about the event. Every rider received constant encouragement, as they all strived to master the undulations which some, inevitably, managed better than others. Not all of them appreciated the urgings of the onlookers, though. 'You're putting me off!', yelled East Bradford's Dudley Hayton, to your well-meaning scribe, as he tried to 'lift' his club-mate. Put off or not, the pro's short '54' was good enough for 11th place two places better than last year.

Talking of last year, the 1991 junior champion, Chris Sanders, Port Sunlight Wheelers, impressed everyone with his 54.24.....gaining ground rapidly on Leo's Glen Taylor, who subsequently became one of 8 DNF's, together with team-mate Antony Stapleton, who was being treated with similar disrespect by Dinnington's former junior champion Julian Ramsbottom.

New 10-mile record-holder Matt Illingworth, GS Strada, was next to enliven the proceedings, with a 51.52, which he thought might just get him a place. But ten minutes later, it was his own team-mate Pete Longbottom, amazingly riding the 25-mile title race

for the first time, who snatched that out of his grasp by 14 seconds. 'My first, and my last', said Pete, who missed out on the Milk Race this year, but wants desperately to ride it again next year. 'What a bummer!', exclaimed Matt with a smile, when he realised that he wouldn't make the top three. But he was happy enough with his ride, and a place in the winning team.

As all eyes were on Boardman, who was now flying out to the turn into the light head wind, few noticed the 53.05 from Wembley's Richard Prebble, the 53.08 from former BBAR Gary Dighton, Manchester Wheelers or even the 52.47. from Leo's Bill Moore. There were, however, a few comments about Gethin Butler's 52.16. The Norwood Paragon all-rounder had come straight from finishing the Milk Race, and, under those circumstances, it was a fine ride. However, Pete Longbottom, still smarting at missing out this year, put it another way entirely. 'If he can do a ride like that', opined the ever-forthright International, 'How hard did he really try in the Milk Race?'

Meanwhile, Boardman had reached the turn at Keswick in 26.07, some 47 seconds up on O'Bree at that stage, and was now powering back alongside Bassenthwaite Lake. It was already clear that, baring disaster, he was going to make it four in a row. Yet disaster there very nearly was! He'd coped superbly with the long drag Westwards along the line of the old railway which years ago took passengers to the West coast towns of Workington, Whitehaven and Maryport, and a sub-50 minute ride look on. Through the start with a mile to go, and he was doing 40 mph down a short drop just before the final quarter mile climb to the time-keeper. Right at the foot of the climb, in front of a massive crowd making a noise seldom heard in these rural parts, he unshipped his chain. He free-wheeled, lost momentum as he reached down to sort things out, changed gear, and then lunged out of the saddle to tackle the final climb. It might have been the '49' that everyone wanted, but a 50.04 was still a superb ride on a course which plays tricks on you with its several changes of direction and subtle gradients, and not to forget the somewhat indifferent road surface on many stretches.

'I'm pleased to win it again, of course', said Chris. 'But my main aim is the pursuit in Barcelona. Now I get down to serious track work, and I honestly feel there's more to come yet. I'm right on schedule now, despite early season frustrations such as illness, punctures, and that crash in France, and I have to be optimistic about the Olympics. In fact, I haven't even considered the possibility of losing'.

And so ended a perfect morning in the Lake District, with many seemingly reluctant to leave. Gilbert Scott and his VC Cumbria club did an efficient job of promoting this championship on a course which, if perhaps unfashionable, if only because of its geographical position, might well attract more interest in the future. But Gilbert surely deserved better than the 15 non-starters on such a perfect morning. He did receive five apologies, but that leaves a lot unaccounted for, including the disgruntled Scott O'Brien, who wrote complaining about his start position of number 21 prior to the event. Despite being reported as not feeling well earlier in the week, there had been no contact between him and the organiser up to the day of the event on that score.

However, it would be churlish to dwell too much on that, for it would be to spoil the memory of a great title race, held in perfect weather, on a fair and challenging course, and watched by one of the largest 'galleries' I've seen outside of the hill-climb for many a year. Perhaps we should have championships in the delightful Lake District more often!

"Is that all?" said Colin Roshier (Hounslow & District) when told he had beaten Clive Brooks by 1m.43secs. in the Wessex RC 50 mile TT on the P209 on Sunday.

He had to think hard when asked how many events he had won this year, eight road races, and two time trials as it happens.

The ambitions of the 28 year old systems accountant were to ride in the Milk Race, and the Olympic team time trial, "but others have decided that for me" he said.

"All my good wins have been down South, and when I won a Star Trophy event, everyone was away."

On the other hand Clive Brooks was "really happy, I have not been going that well." Now looking forward to next weeks Finsbury Park 50.

Clive felt his time was about right for early June, on a good morning, but is looking for another three minutes improvement on his 1.47.48. by the end of the season. He had taken a time check on Colin as he went past the start, and when he lost half a minute to him. He knew that he was going to be hard to beat.

Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) in third place, was happy with another personal best. He has put the work in this season, and the form is coming.

Neville Stroud (Antelope RT) took the best improvement award on his tricycle. If he improves another fifteen minutes next week in the Finsbury Park 50, the Antelope will not have any trouble in taking the tricycle competition record.

There were 21 who did not report to the time keeper either the finish or 5.30.am. start. Terry Icke and Ray Hughes with colds. Glenn Longland believed to have a cold and taking care before the 24 hour championship. Jeremy Short punctured, and two riders turned at the roundabout before the turn. Eighth placed Peter Pickers (Antelope RT), had not

got over his effort breaking the 25 mile tandem trike competition record (or was it the celebrations?) mid week, but claims to have done everything in preparation for the 24 hour championship, including 7,000 miles this year.

Pickers and Pitt Break Tandem Trike Competition Record.

Joking after breaking the tandem tricycle competition record for 25 miles in the Antelope tandem event on the P201 at Ringwood, it was hard to believe that Dave Pitt (Charlotteville CC) and Pete Pickers (Antelope RT) took it seriously.

Dave Pitt has eleven competition records to his name, and he knows what he is doing, Pete Pickers had been quietly confident of breaking the record the week before.

"I have never failed to beat a record when I have ridden this machine" said Dave.

They said that the first time they had ridden the machine together was the mile they put in before they set off for the start.

"I have had a bad knee all year, and I need a decent stoker" joked Dave afterwards. Not to be beaten Pete added. "My shoe plate came loose with ten miles to go, I wondered what was happening".

The excitement over the record took the interest away from the main battle between the winners Clarence Wheelers' Ray Hughes and B.Edwards, and Antelope's Glenn Longland and Neville Stroud.

"Not bad for a couple of old men" said Longland afterwards. Glenn's current preoccupation is the "24" and he had put in a 100 miles the day before. Though he claims not to be doing a lot of extra miles, just following his normal programme.

Neville Stroud's preparation had been winning the 10 at Poole Park track league the night before.

These tandem riders leave you with the feeling they will ride on anything provided it can be called a bike race.

Many personal bests were posted in the event headquarters afterwards, and hard working organiser, Ray Douglas, was as pleased as his winning team clubmates, Paul Toppin, Richard Shipton and Jeremy Wootton (Worthing Excelsior) when their combined efforts beat the club's old team record by a handsome margin.

Jan Scotchford added to their pleasure by winning the lady's award in a personal best time, and Don Lock look like bringing the vets. on standard prize to the century old club until Charles Robson (Eastbourne Rovers Phoenix Cycles) upstaged him by 35 seconds when he finished nearly an hour later.

The professional category had attracted 43 riders and the winner was Dave Orford, recent winner of category 'F' in the World Cup TT. Runner up was Bob Drinkwater all the way from Canada, with ex Viking Cycles Brian Haskell in third spot.

Cat 'B' saw Ron Longstaff (Hammer) winner of the 1987 veterans championship of Flanders, taking the trophy and sash from Knutsford Ron (Nodder) Johnson, with Mike Eastwood, Southampton third.

Cat 'C' the young 'lads' 59 and under, saw Vic Stark set the course record with also the best 'plus' of the day.

Ron Kitching, who finished 32nd in category 'A' presented the awards, and was thanked for his support of the independant category by helping with equipment.

The village again made an excellent profit for their playing field fund.

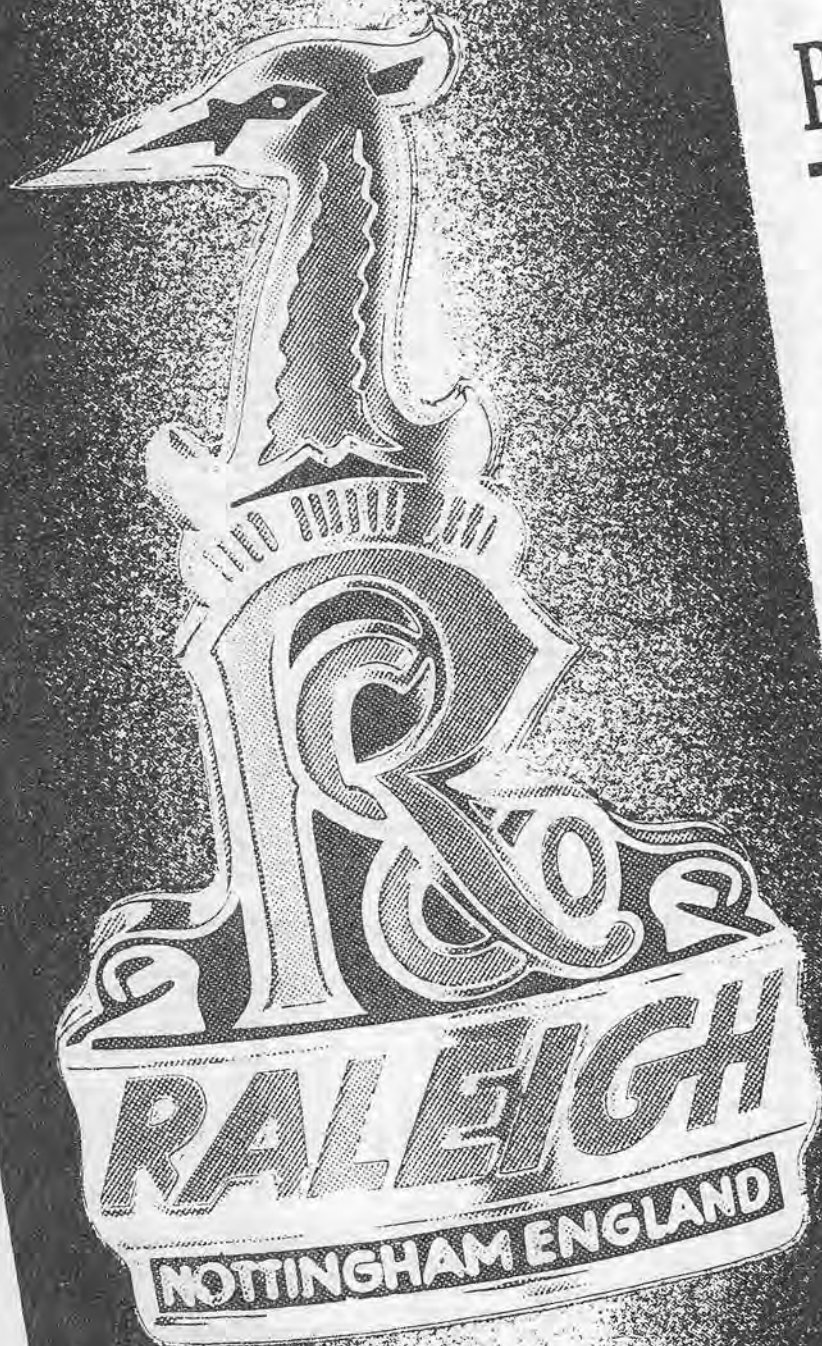
