G.H.S. (Yorkshire DC Final)

The City Road Club (Hull) claimed a new juvenile team competition record on Saturday, when three of their under-16s beat their own existing record, set in last year's GHS '10' final, by 32 seconds.

With two of last year's winning team still eligible, it was plain that a new record could be set, for the Yorkshire District Final, promoted by the Yorkshire Ladies Cycling Association on a course which has great speed potential, was blessed with perfect conditions.

Based on the A63, a dual-carriageway between the end of the M62 and the approaches to Hull, the course produced a string of personals in the juvenile event, and the open '10' which followed.

Adam Hardy and Adam Jordan, two of last year's winning team from the South Hunsley School in Hull, were in a class of their own, and could be on their way to becoming only the second school to successfully defend this championship. They'll be aided in the final by Jonathan Clayton, who helped the South Hunsley School to easily beat the challenge from Prince Henry's Grammar School and Queensbury Upper School.

But the competition record was set up by the two Adams and a different third member... James Scott. These three all first claim members of the City Road Club (Hull), but as there is no precedent for this particular circumstance, they'll have to wait to see whether or not their claim is accepted.

The other qualifiers from the Yorkshire final were Steven Jackson, Queensbury Upper, who's a member of the East Bradford CC and recorded a satisfying personal, and fastest girl Rusine Airstone, from Headlands School in Bridlington.

Rob Krygsman (Goole Vermuyden) stormed home in 20.39 to win the Event, with 2nd place going to **Chris Giles** (Huddersfield Start Wheelers), fresh from his ride in the National Championship, just 4 seconds down with 20.43 which was almost an incredible 3 minute improvement on his previous "personal". These were the only riders inside 21 minutes.

Only just outside, in 21.01, was **Kevin Macklam** (Leeds St Christophers) who showed the sort of speed usual associated with his brother, Vince. Not that father, **Jack Macklam**, was far behind. His time of 22.09 helped to secure the team award for Leeds St Christophers by supporting team-mate **K.Richards** who produced a rapid 21.46.

**Gethin Butler wins
Finsbury 50 again**

Once again the Finsbury Park 50 produced its crop of super fast rides with sixty one riders beating two hours.

Ten trikes started the event off at 5.01pm. with a strong Antelope RT presence, something special was on the cards, sure enough at 6.40pm. the first rider to pass the finish area with nine miles to go was Glen Longland off No. 10 and storming to an under two hour target, little did he realise that the individual trike record was in his grasp until after this point, his thoughts were on beating the team record, at three minutes past seven he passed the timekeeper and notched up another competition record by beating the old record, held by Dave Pitt, by over four minutes in 1.53.13.

Glen soon changed into other clothing and was back up the road to spur on his team mates who were backing him for a new team record, their aggregate time, (R.Dadswell 2.04.51/N.Stroud 2.17.39.) reduced the old figures by almost twenty two minutes.

In the main event some of the first riders to finish reported the evening too hot and sticky and found the last ten miles hard in these conditions, although the temperature dropped over the next two hours making for a more comfortable ride by the later starters.

One of the early finishers Colin Roshier No. 30. reported having suffered badly over the last few miles and finished in 1.45.35. for 5th place. Roshier held the lead for fifty five minutes until Bill Moore finished in 1.45.05. only to be beaten thirteen minutes later by Kevin Dawson's third place of 1.43.11. a personal best.

Stuart Dangerfield's second place ride came just less than five minutes later with a 1.42.54. a personal improvement of exactly six minutes.

Last man on the card was Gethin Butler last years winner and level with Dangerfield at forty one miles, his winning time of 1.42.05. shows the power over the last nine miles that a long distance rider has with short distance speed, the good training in the Milk Race now showing its worth.

Several other riders achieved personal bests, Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) improved four minutes to 1.47.11. for seventh place, John French (Manchester Whs) a two minutes improvement to 1.47.07. for sixth place. J.Dunn (Ratae RC) raced under two hours for the first time with a 1.52.08.

Although Leo RC team time was 5.18.53. it was still four minutes short of the Manchester Wheelers record set last year.

Marie Purvis Champion 25 miler. Scottish runner-up again

A warm calm, morning saw ninety three ladies despatched from the timekeeper in the National Championship 25 at Worksop, Nottinghamshire.

As expected, with no clear favourite, all the seeded riders put up excellent times on this revised O25/7 course which included single lanes, cones on the A1 at a point just before the second turn, due to road inspections.

The half way times began to show that the seeded riders were well justified in their place setting by all beating the thirty minute barrier, first of these was Kim Staff No 10 in 29.13. followed by No. 20 Maria Lawrence in 28.56.

Sarah Phillips the Scottish visitor stormed by in 28.05. which was to remain the fastest half way time, only the eventual winner Maria Purvis could get within seconds of this in 28.07, and only two other ladies Yvonne McGregor 28.41 and Louise Jones 28.40. managed to beat the twenty nine minute barrier.

At the finish Sarah Phillips No.30 stormed in with a 58.29. and looked unbeatable as only Yvonne McGregor No.45. 59.26. could match the speed of the Scottish visitor, it was forty four minutes later when the only other sub 60 minute ride appeared, that of the winner Marie Purvis by one second in 58.28.

This winning margin was not the only closest time span as the team was settled by the same margin, Scarborough Paragon took this award with Elaine Ward.1.02.10. Christine Ward.1.06.26. and Jackie White. 1.07.15. with a time of 3.15.51. commiserations must go to the Askern CC. Sally Boyden.1.02.11. Margaret Allen.1.04.31. and Katie Allen.1.09.10. for an aggregate of 3.15.52. but for the misfortunes of Margaret Allen who, whilst changing gear on the climb to the finish, jammed her chain and had to change bikes for the final 200 metres.

A delighted Hannah Bean (Evesham & District) with 1.04.49. became junior champion.

There were no complaints about the weather or the course (which could be called sporting) with it's many undulations.

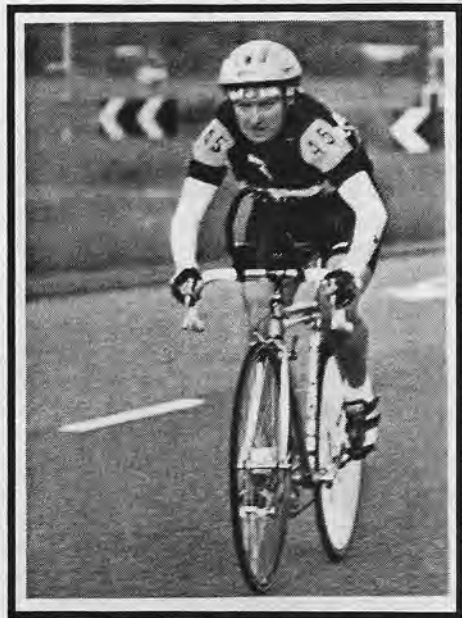
The awards were presented by Mike McNamara the 1967 BBAR winner, who complimented the organisation and smooth running of the event.

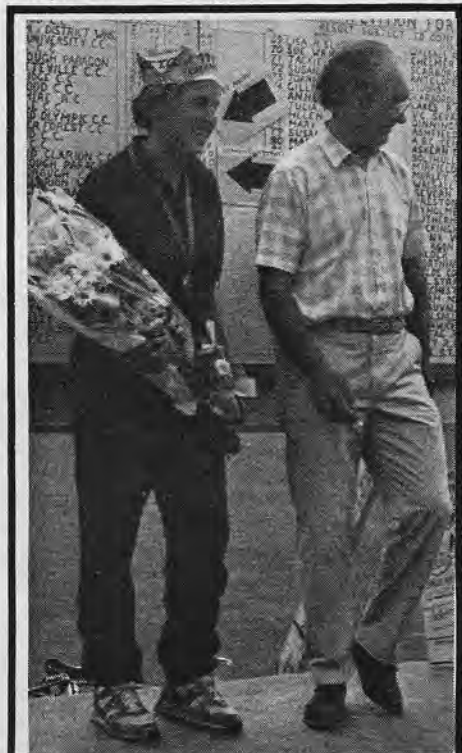

"It is easier than road racing, just like a game of cricket to me" said Mark Fodden (Bournemouth Arrow CC) after beating Paul Rogers (VC Raphael) by 15 seconds in the Salisbury RC Saturday afternoon 10 mile time trial.

The Portland Veteran thinks that 10 miles or 25 miles is not too far to race, and while he has a fiercely hard training schedule it concentrates on quality rather than miles. He finds it relaxing after work during the week as a director of a building firm, carrying out local authority contracts.

His racing is restricted because he does not believe in riding club events, or the 5.30. and 6.00 am. starts that are necessary to avoid holiday traffic in coastal regions.

Mark's training schedule includes running marathons and taking part in biathlons. He claims that some biathlon competitors can beat him by more in the cycle race, than the top time triallists, but that does involve a run before and after the cycle section.

His brother Gary was fourth, at 31 only starting cycle racing in his late twenties after coming out to photograph Mark in cycle races, and thinking he would like to try the sport. A commercial diver, that helps him keep fit.

The camera gear has been sold now and he is concentrating on bike racing.

Paul Rogers was not troubled by his defeat, he had won a bunch sprint of eighty riders at Goodwood the previous Tuesday, been disqualified for an alleged hand sling, then reinstated on appeal. Presumably the judges not believing that anyone could sprint that fast on his own.

He was complaining about stiff legs after a session of motor paced training on Leicester track on Thursday, and is looking forward with a little apprehension to riding the motor paced championship at the national track titles week.

International road man, and former milk race rider, he spent all winter riding in cyclo cross events on a mountain bike, here is another one who takes everything in his stride.

"Come on, that one's ancient. Nobody'd want to buy it."
