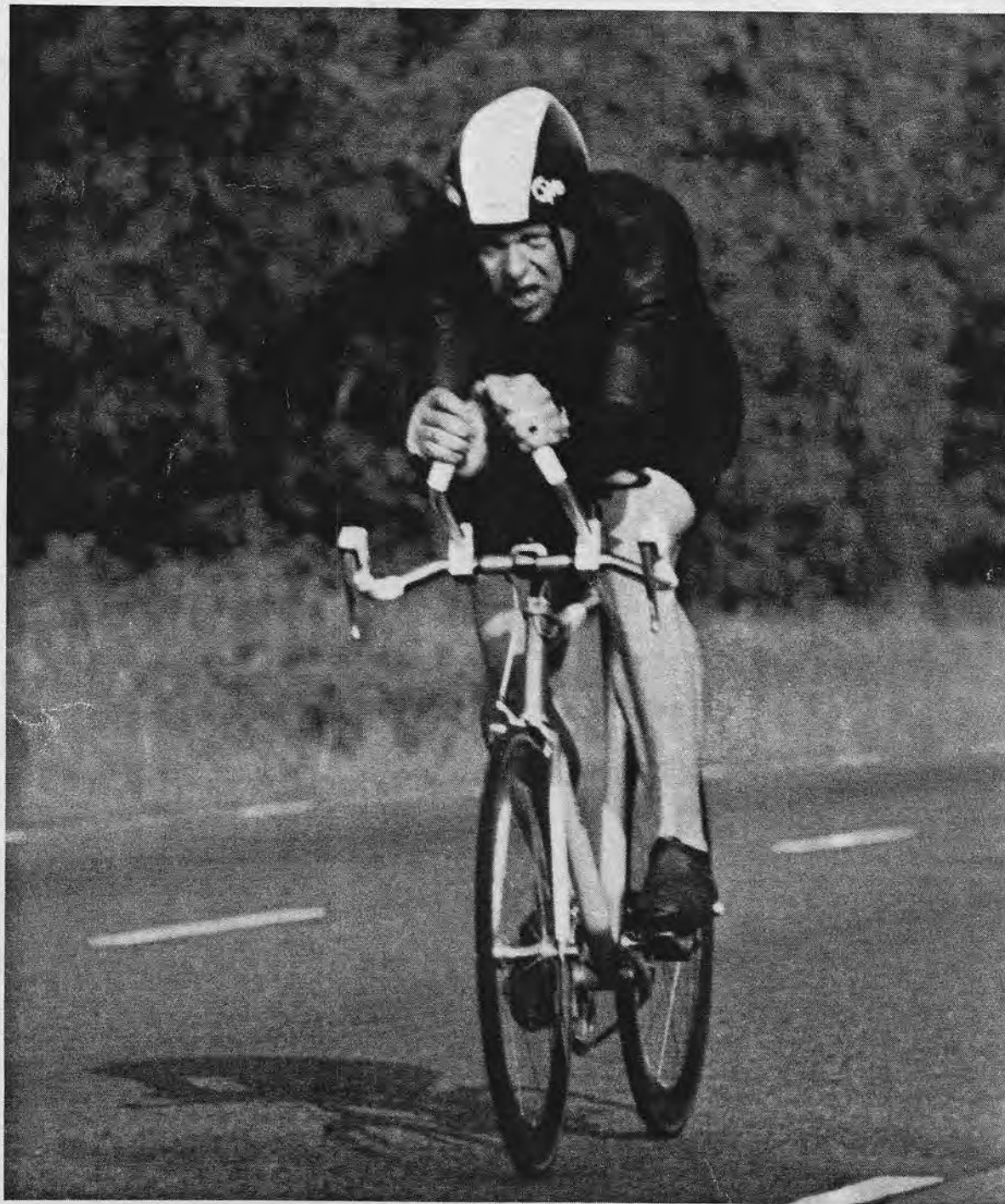

Boardman's Supremacy

A champagne ride by Chris Boardman saw him retain his 50 mile Championship and outclass every other competitor on a sunny Devon morning. His 10 mile times were 20.48; 19.57; 19.33; 23.32 and finally 20.11, Truly remarkable splits considering the far from flat terrain and the strength of the South Easterly breeze which blow throughout the event at the Plymouth end of the course and spread progressively towards the event finish as the day progressed.

All Boardman's rivals made fleeting attempts to match his standard but soon faded back into their own battles with each other for the minor placings. From the fast downhill start at Liverton the riders were soon on the A38 dual carriageway devoid of traffic for early starters and only with light bunched traffic by the time the last rider was safely back to the timekeeper, Boardman made little of the three mile drag up to Bickington to reach the first time check. Matthew Postle was closest to him in 21.15, already twenty seven seconds down, Another Matthew-illingworth was at a further three seconds, Gary Dighton another fourteen seconds down with Pete Longbottom and Gethin Butler, Norwood Paragon CC. in close attendance.

Already missing was Mick Bradshaw, GS.Metro, one of the many surprising puncture victims on a course of smooth roads and little visible grit. Bradshaw may have damaged his tyres when he got the line wrong on the second fast corner and rattled over the cats eyes a 1/3 of the way across the road. Also gone was one of the favourites for best placed local-Andrew McClean, Heron RC.

Boardman got inside 30 mph. for the next ten which included a four mile running road down to the River Dart and then the 600 foot climb to Drybridge. Ilingworth had moved into second spot at two minutes, ten seconds, a position he was to hold till the chequered flag. Dighton was in third place seven seconds down. Stuart Dangerfield had also improved his lot taking over fourth place and was three seconds behind the BBAR, Postle had dropped one second behind Longbottom.

With the long drop to Ivybridge it was no surprise that Boardman maintained his speed of over 30 mph. going through 25 miles in 50mins.20 seconds en route to the far turn at 28 miles. It was at this point that Boardman knew he was well in control and indulged in a little experimentation with his gearing. Ilingworth closed the gap by twenty seconds but this was his only gain. Dangerfield moved into third place ahead of Dighton, Postle, Longbottom and Roshier who had moved steadily through the field, Gary Empson had retired having punctured, Butler and Eddie Adkins gave it best after sickness.

The next ten miles were the hardest with not only the headwind but the climbs out of the Erme and Avon Valleys to contend with, it was here that Boardman made his biggest gain jumping his advantage over Ilingworth to four minutes, seven seconds. Dangerfield was clinging on to the bronze medal place with a change of challenger with early starter Longbottom sixteen seconds behind him and the others slipping away.

Crossing the river Dart the course swung more to the North and the conditions eased with only the climb of the Ashburton by-pass to impede smooth progress before the finish.

With three in the first four there was no challenge to the team supremacy of the GS Strada team and their aggregate time of 5hours, 20 mins. 41 secs.

There was an interesting battle to be the best Channel Islander with Michael Harris from the Jersey based Caesarean CC eventually beating Ian Brown of Guernsey Velo by 21 seconds.

Best local rider was Andrew Lyons of the promoting club. He was five minutes, thirteen seconds down on his course record due to in some part to a troublesome rear gear mechanism and to the harder conditions. He was well clear of team mate Malcolm Steer who nevertheless surprised many with the strength of his ride in what for him has been an indifferent season.

The promoting Plymouth Corinthian CC. must be well pleased with their centre piece of their centenary celebrations which went as smoothly as any well planned event should go with all the members turning out, to all was well.

BEYOND THE HORIZON OF 507 MILES.

One of the surprising things in the present day time trialling world is the fact that Roy Cromack's Competition Record ride of 507 miles in the 1969 Mersey Roads 24 hour has survived for 23 years.

Recently, in the North Road 24 hour of 1992, it seemed to many that the record would be beaten by Glen Longland, but as it turned out it was not to be. Some years ago it seemed that John Woodburn would do it. Indeed he got to within two miles of it after a dour battle with Pete Wells. Wells packed, and Woodburn, on his own admission to me, said that, in the end he was literally hanging on.

Stuart Jackson and Ian Dow always seemed likely contenders but never quite made it, in spite of their friendly rivalry to urge each other on. Dow did eventually beat 500 miles, and Jackson almost certainly did although his off course miles were never revealed to confirm this.

Ian Butcher was thought to be the man in the frame, but in his one attempt he faded at the end. I always thought he was a good bet had he tried again but as yet he has not done so.

So what is this hoodoo if I may call it that?

Frankly I don't think there is any hoodoo, and that in due course the record will be beaten. However, before I dwell on that let me make some observations about Cromack's ride. It was done in a competitive field of whom the late Eric Matthews and Nim Carline were also contenders for the prize of being the first to beat 500 miles. Added to which was the presence of Beryl Burton whose avowed intention was to beat the men.

The wisest move that Cromack made was to ride his own race which he did with mathematical precision. When he found he was leading he did not change his plan although at Wem it was not too obvious that he would top 500 miles. Riders, as the readers will appreciate, do find it difficult to increase speed at the end of a 24. Now the Mersey course had always been designed in a way that the 27 miles from Wem to the finishing circuit would take advantage of the following wind. On the day there was a following wind.

I can remember following Cromack from Whitchurch to the finishing circuit, where on the downhill run to Broxton for example he was doing well over 25 mph. In fact he did the 27 miles from Wem to the circuit in 1.8.00

But that was not all. When he got to the circuit he still continued at a fair pace until he finished. He had then, admittedly, ridden himself out, but even when he knew he had won and had beaten competition record he never relaxed. He once told me that the extra seven miles over the 500 were due to the prevailing wind and in that he was probably right.

Now Cromack had never ridden a 24 hour before but his application and single mindedness were the attributes which ensured his success. Dow and Jackson did not lack experience but, in circumstances when they knew they had won, there seemed little incentive for them to ride harder.

Let it not be forgotten that, as has already been said, to increase one's speed in the last hours of a 24 is very, very difficult. None the less it can be done as Dow proved when he just topped 500 miles. I was at the event, and on the finishing circuit. Each time he came round you could see the effort. He found hidden reserves that day.

Butcher was never likely to do it on the day, for his lead at all times was so great that the incentive had long gone.

Woodburn and Wells tried to ride each others races and paid the price. Andy Wilkinson, with an End to End reputation behind him did what many people expected and topped 500. By all accounts he too was unable to increase his speed at the end. This had the single mindedness of purpose and should he ride another 24 he may well be the man to top 507 miles. How will this competition record get beaten?

It will be done in one of two ways. On the one hand a dedicated rider prepared to become so single minded on the day that all else but the main objective is out of his mind.

On the other hand, two or more riders in the same event, each prepared to ride their own races, always keeping the main objective in their sights, and yet subconsciously benefitting by the competitive spirit on the day.

In each case it will need good weather conditions, experience helpers and no mechanical problems.

It will be done one day but it will not necessarily be, as some were saying, that because Longland had

done 300 miles in 12 hours, then almost as if by mathematical certainty he should do 520 miles or more in 24 hours. For many riders there are unknown factors after 12 hours, a feature that has been evident on occasions in the past.

I have no knowledge of why Longland packed, but I understand it was early on in the event. I am informed, however, that he could make no impression on Wilkinson in the early stages, and one wonders if that may have been a contributory factor.

Whatever it was he must come again, for having finally decided that he would enter a 24, he must now surely, ride to finish in one and make his point.

24 hour riding at the highest level is a discipline of its own and it takes experience and application to be successful. There is the problem of riding fast in the night, and of riding alone for long stretches. There is the need for correct feeding, for an unacceptable diet can bring on unwanted sickness.

There is also the will power to carry on towards the objective, even when it is obvious that the contender may well win by as much as 30 miles.

Regretfully, perhaps, there are no drag strips or float mornings in 24 hour events; riding in one is totally different to the experience of riding in any other kind of time trial.

Due to traffic lights on the course the Cleveland Wheelers '50' used mainly the A19/A168 on Sunday, turning at Dishforth. The course change resulted in some reasonable times but probably the conditions helped, a rising headwind finish proved a little troublesome, with the earlier starters getting little assistance to the turn. This didn't stop former hill climb champion Paul Wildsmith from improving for the third time this season to record 1.49.19, a three minute improvement.

In second place was a surprising ride from unseeded Neville Jackson (Roxby Whs) with a 1.49.54, and with a generous nine and a half minutes handicap this gave him first handicap award.

In third spot was Morley CC rider Steve Vaughan who found the return leg troublesome after producing a 52.38. '25' (PB.) the previous evening.

With close packing from the other Morley riders they went away with the team prize with third counter Martin Overton going inside for the first time.

"There was a time when a veteran could get round the course in a fifty he got a cheer" said one of the spectators looking in amazement at the times of Paul Bennett and Harry Featherstone on the result board, after the VTTA Wessex group 50 mile time trial.

Harry who had won the vets standard, and was second overall, took it as a matter of course. "When you get to my age you can't help winning, I have won most vets events I have ridden in."

Harry suggested that a word with the faster Paul Bennett would be more appropriate than interviewing him, but they were both more interested in talking about the exploits of Boardman and Butler than themselves.

"What will they go like when they are your age I asked. "They don't make them like this now, they won't last. There was something special about those made between 1935 and 1945" said Paul. "Something to do with going in and out of bombed houses that did it" added Harry, going on to tell a tale of his exploits as a youngster during the war. "That's not for publication" he added.

The P132 course based at Castle Malwood near Southampton, cover the roads used by Glen Longland for his BAR rides last year, although the hills look unlikely to produce a fast ride. On the right day and with the right form a rider can roll up them fast on a big gear, and take full advantage of the descents. "I have ridden 25s on this course and my wheels never touched the ground" said Paul. On a warm still morning wheels were still touching the ground but nine vets still got under two hours, compared with last year's winner John Emery who did 1.59.42.
