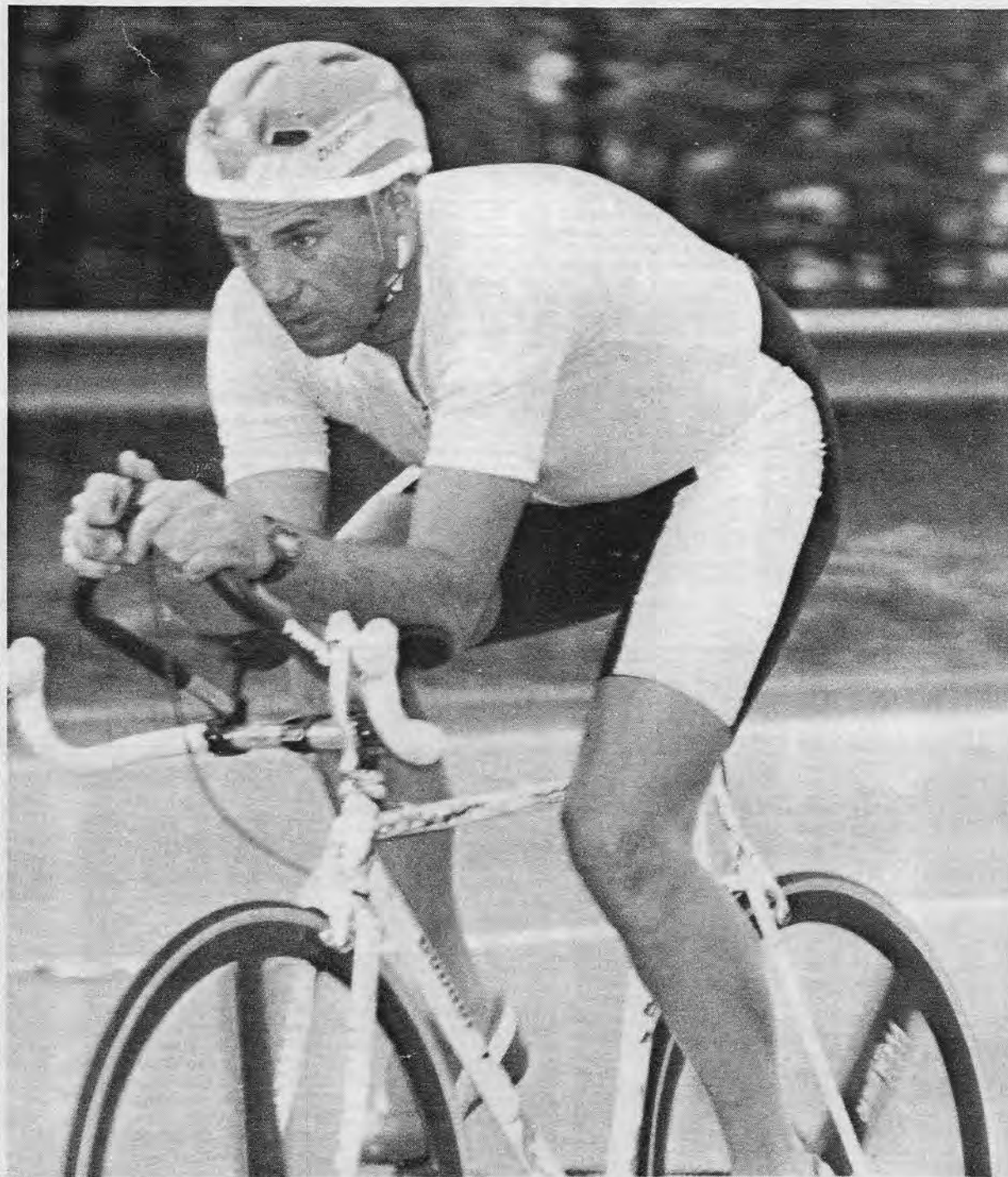

With a course and event record 4.03.02. ride to win the Mid-Devon Road Club 100, Andrew Lyons virtually assured himself of retaining the South West Best All Rounder title for the third year in succession.

The 25 year old Plymouth Corinthian rider put his disappointment of the previous weeks National 50 behind him, with seven miles to go in the Championship his rear gear fell apart with a jockey wheel dropping out and he lost almost a minute per mile-he rode the 100 strongly throughout leaving all others in his wake. After 38 miles covered in 1.34.59. he had almost 6m.30s. on eventual runner-up Dave Moulden and seven minutes on Danny Deakin, Choughs R.C. riding his first 100. Within the next minute were Nick Cleave, Gareth Enticott and Mick Potter.

Despite the strong North East to North West breeze buffeting the riders as they went out and back to the Plymouth and of the course Lyons went through the 51.5. mile turn in 2.03.30. Moulden was now at 8m.18s. with Deakin at a further eleven seconds.

Passing the start point, 83 miles, Lyons advantage had grown to 10m.30s. over the Exeter Post Office worker. Deakin, shortly to go off course and retire, was 30 seconds down on Moulden.

The final miles proved no problem to Lyons as he set a fine new record. Moulden easily took second place with Deakin's demise but there was a battle royal for the minor placings. Potter suffered from lack of miles due to his six month sojourn on Ascension Island letting in Didier Lebatteux. Ken Robertson came in fourth ahead of his teenage mate Nick Cleave.

Andover win for Pro. Lodge

Belgian based professional, Harry Lodge (Tulip Computers) given a fortnight's holiday by his employers while the rest of his team lined up in San Sebastian for the start of the Tour de France, returned to his cycling roots when he lined up for the Andover Wheelers annual 50, on a course which passed within five miles of his Wiltshire home.

Since winning this race a year ago, Lodge has enhanced his cycling career at international level and the promoting club was hoping amendments to its 50 mile course on the A 303 would result in faster times, but the weather dictated otherwise and Lodge was the only entrant to achieve a respectable time. Last to start in a field of 63 on a windy morning which produced a disappointing 21 non-starters, he raced past fifteen lesser mortals including the redoubtable John Woodburn (Manchester Wheelers) who started thirteen minutes before him and finished fifth, and completed the distance within a minute of last year's time, in 1.50.25.

The quality of Lodge's ride became apparent when compared with other times on the result board. Runner-up, Peter Pickers (Antelope RT) commented he had never taken so long to ride a 50 and third placed Harry Featherstone (Norwood Paragon) one of many drawn to the event in anticipation of recording a season's best, echoed the views of most by expressing satisfaction in finishing- something six failed to accomplish.

Apart from Lodge, the only rider to derive any satisfaction from the event was the promoting club's handicapper, Bob Smith. Thirty seconds covered the top three in this category, and scratch man, Lodge, missed adding the 10 prize for this category to his 20 for first place by just twenty eight seconds.

Ronnie Bailey.

The death of Ronnie Bailey which occurred whilst riding in the recent Veterans' 25 mile time trial in the Isle of Man, whilst attempting to win the Douglas Corporation Shield for the tenth time, has taken an outstandingly successful senior veteran from the Yorkshire time trialling scene.

Despite being only a few weeks short of his eightieth birthday and having a deceptive upright riding position, he was a most difficult rider to beat "on standard".

He seemed to improve as he got older, winning the Yorkshire Veterans BAR in 1984 at the age of 72, and in 1991 he had a vintage year when amongst many victories he took second place in the National Veterans Championship over 30 and 100 miles and third place over 25 miles.

In his seventies he took up tandem racing, and with the late Ken Hartley set age records at 10, 25, 30, 50 and 100 miles.

He started cycling at sixteen and joined the Holme Valley Wheelers in 1929. His clubmate took his racing triumphs for granted and knew him best as an unassuming complete clubman who had toured extensively throughout England and Europe. He could always be relied upon to undertake any task, from preparing food for club social evenings to handicapping and promoting events.

I never heard him utter a harsh or critical word about anyone nor complain about the bad luck we all encounter at times in a racing career, but passed it all off with a quiet sense of humour.

To many of us his passing signifies the end of an era.

Vet Fodden in form

With a restricted field of 45 riders chosen on standard times, in the Poole Wheelers evening 25 mile TT on the P201 course at Ringwood twenty of them got under the hour.

New veteran Mark Fodden (Bournemouth Arrow CC) provided "his personal best for some time" to win by over two minutes, and his fourth open win in a row. All since his fortieth birthday a few weeks ago.

At 56 Mike is not a born again vet. Only starting cycling when in his forties. A driving school instructor, he asked one of his pupils what he did for a hobby. When he heard about time trials he thought that was something he would like to do as relaxation from the hassle of his job.

Mike has now become a regular feature of the Bournemouth cycling scene, with the ability to pop up and do a good ride when he feels that this is the "big one".

507 Miles Reply

I felt that Peter Barlow's "informative" letter deserved a reply putting a more reasoned and logical point of view.

Surely one of the reasons why the record has stood so long is due to, until the last few years, the declining interest, and opportunities, in all day rides by top time triallists. Peter Barlow writes about the incentive of a competitive field and then indicates that Cromack rode his own race, ignoring the other competitors efforts, a contradiction?

By definition time-triallists have to be self motivated and leading 24 hour men highly self-motivated. On Peter Barlow's theory I do not see how Glenn Longland beat his own 12 hour record by such a distance. I do not recall Glenn's winning margin except that it was fairly large for a 12 hour event. In any event some of us want to win by the biggest margin possible. Who wants to win on points if you can knock-out the other fellow?

Peter Barlow appears to completely ignore the factor of the weather in assessing the likelihood of the record being broken on at least two occasions in recent years. Cromack was "blessed with ideal conditions for the Mersey course" I quote from an article by one of Cromack's helpers, John Lewis.

Peter Barlow's dismissal of Ian Butcher's effort of 493.530, in the Mersey Roads 24 in 1989 is a bit of an insult, I recall reading that Ian rode through wind and rain for 16 of the 24 hours and according to the cognoscenti present except for the bad weather Ian could well have broken the record.

Peter Barlow was obviously not at the North Road event this year. On most of the Saturday there was a pretty strong wind, even by Fenland standards, blowing, and there was probably no one there who was not convinced that had the weather been kinder, Andy Wilkinson would comfortably have beaten 507 miles. Andy did in fact speed up a bit round the circuit. In the first 12 hours he did as I recall just under 267 miles which means that he did less than 236 for the second; on the circuit who was doing "evens" or more. Personally I consider that if Andy had the weather conditions which prevailed on Monday 22nd June, when the writer, who is off work through ill health and unable to train for time trials, rode just under 50 miles through the fens at 18/19 mph with little effort, he would probably have ridden something like 520 miles.

It would be interesting to see if Glenn Longland has another try on the Mersey Roads course, a faster one, I would suggest, than the Ely course, should he do so and gets reasonable weather and ride sensibly there is no reason why he should not get the record.
