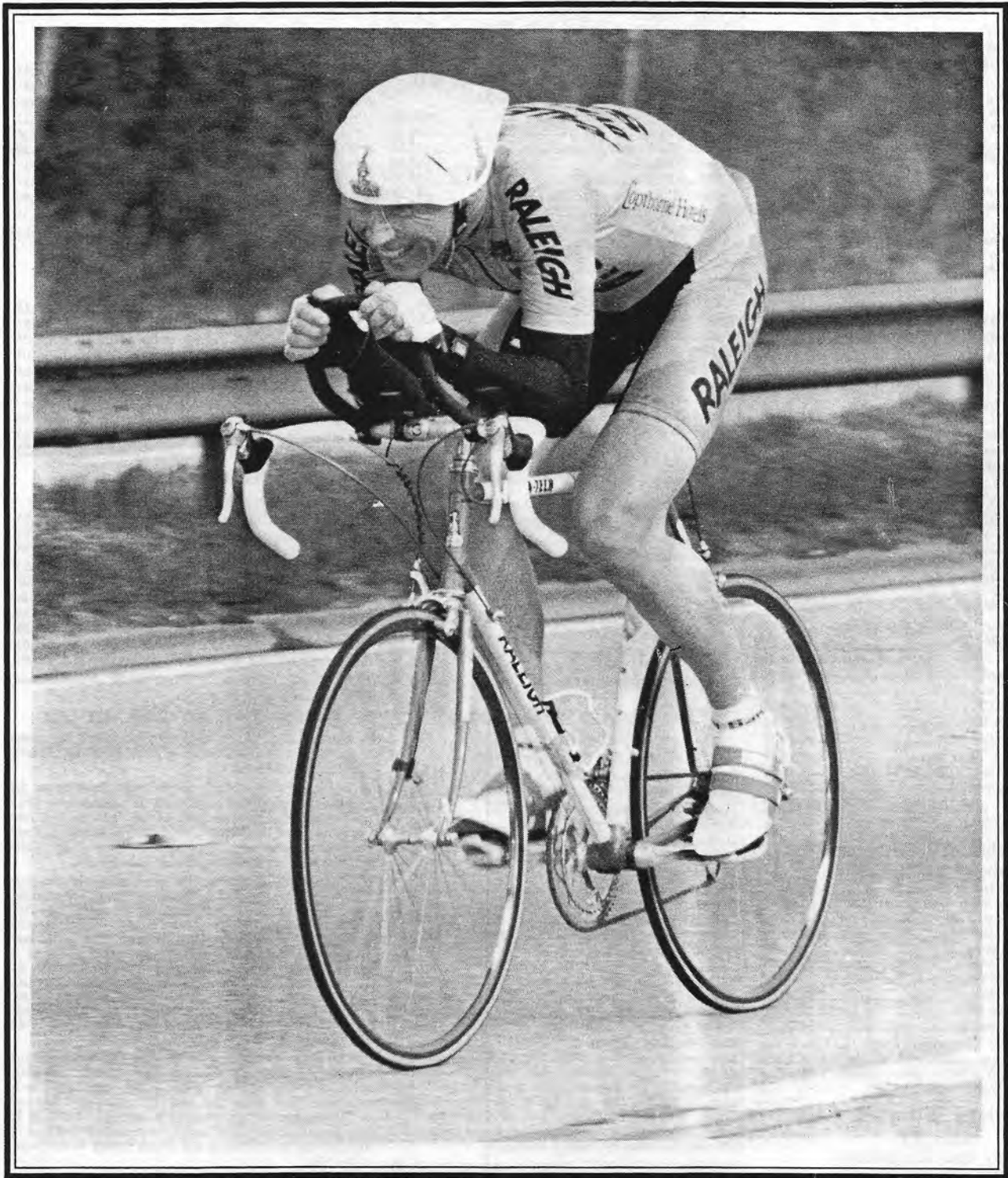

## New Forest win for Brooks

"It's a really bad day" said Clive Brooks (Polytechnic CC) after winning the New Forest 50 mile TT at Ringwood near Bournemouth.

He looked happy enough saying "I haven't won anything since the middle of May". He is just getting back into form after having had the flu, and was regretting having to miss the national 50.

Second placed Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) revelled in the conditions, where the strong west wind, had been at times coming from all directions, on this South Coast course. "I quite like events like this, they are good preparation for the 100" he said.

He was scathing about the twenty none starters, who he felt had not turned up because it was a bad day, "it's disgraceful, they are nearly all the big boys in the second half of the field."

Andy Cook (Leo RC) felt "a bit better" with his third place. He has missed some of his early training this year, and to make up, he had just ridden two 50s four 25s. and a 100 in eight days.

"The form is coming" he said. He is one who believes in plenty of hard work as part of his preparation. He was concerned that after having held a first category road licence for 10 years, he only had three points this season. "It is going to be difficult to qualify this time and ride for the BAR."

Newcomer Ivan Prince (Bournemouth Jubilee Wheelers) came in at sixth place, after being down with a "bug" during the week.

Pauline Strong (Team Raleigh) preparing for another attempt at the End to End was second lady. Still stiff after her fall in the last attempt, but looking fit and ready to go.

The winding course for the series of 100 mile events organised by CC Breckland, brought into use by road works on the original course, proved something of a blessing in view of the windy conditions.

The Tricycle Association "Fliss Beard memorial" Championship saw young Ben Elliott, son of one of CC Breckland's founder members, ride to a superb win in his first attempt at the distance, while in the British Students Sports Federation Championship which followed Simon Walton, Sheffield University, beat an under par Geoff Frost, Loughborough Students, who started racing with CCB, into 2nd place by nearly 8 minutes.

Nigel Edwards, R.A.F.C.C, scored a runaway win in the Inter-Services Championship beating the Army's P.Dean by over 7 minutes while Gordon Irons, Essex Roads CC, at the age of 61, was fastest vet on standard with a massive plus 60.24 in the East Anglian VTTA event which was incorporated in the main CC Breckland open.

Although not as fast as his recent win in the Ipswich BC 100, Breckland's Richard Boudry turned in a superb ride to win in 4.07.32 and lead clubmate Tony Reynolds 4.49.16 and novice Phil Harvey 4.52.01 to a well deserved team win.

Although threatened by the Welland Valley pair Barlow and Scampton, Ms Sue Wright Chelmer CC and husband Mick Gray Crest CC won the tandem event in 4.21.40.

#### YORKSHIRE ROAD CLUB 1891-1991.

A history compiled by members and edited by Frank Beckwith: pub. W.R.Kilching: softback £7.00. 14, Granby Park, Harrogate. HG1 4AE.

As the course of cycling history rolls onward, so the classic older established clubs reach their centenaries. They are a select band these children of the Victorian age, who have weathered the vagaries of a hundred summers. Some continue to thrive with undiminished vigour whilst others languish amongst their dreams of bygone glories.

Glories aplenty abound in this excellently-produced little book very ably compiled by Frank Beckwith. Taken in the main from first-hand reminiscences recorded by YRC members themselves, the text is liberally salted with anecdote and observation. The roll-call of past and present members is graced by many of the greatest names in British cycling. From early pioneers who roamed the northern roads on high-wheelers, through the hungry 20s and 30s when scarcely a week passed without a YRC member hitting the headlines somewhere, to those heady post-war days when the club's riders spearheaded our entry into the world of continental racing.

Special mention should be made of the YRC's contribution to women's cycling. In an age of predominantly male-only clubs, not only did the YRC actively encourage lady members, they were the first to award medals and certificates for their participation in competitive events. In later times this early faith was to be rewarded by a host of national and local records and events falling to the ladies of the YRC.

The YRC's Centenary Dinner celebration was held on the evening of the York Rally in the banqueting suite on the Knaveamire. So many top YRC riders came from the ranks of the northern CTC 'hardriders' that, to quote Frank Beckwith, "...racing must have seemed like a relief after being with these people.

There is much to savour in this comparatively modest publication, not least the many well-presented photographs of the YRC at work and play during their long and illustrious career.



# Magnificent Marie Warms Up for Olympics with National '10' win.

Magnificent Marie Purvis won Saturday's national 10-mile championship in clear-cut fashion, rounding off her racing preparation for Barcelona by adding the shortest RTTC title event to her earlier "25", and road race 1992 triumphs.

And her winning margins are getting bigger-a one-second advantage in the "25" had grown to nine seconds in the road race, and, after a successful racing trip to the Tour of Finistere stage race in France, to twenty two seconds over Saturday's shorter distance.

The Manx Viking Wheeler, who, as someone with a long memory pointed out at the finish, bears a striking resemblance to her clubmate Millie Robinson (no stranger to national championship hat-tricks back in the '50s) was well clear of a bevy of middling 23-minute riders, led by Sue Wright, (Chelmer CC).

In an event immaculately promoted for London East DC by Hainault RC, it was pleasing to see Essex girl Wright repeating her silver-medal winning ride in the national "50" a week earlier, and showing a welcome return to form.

This girl with so much all-round talent has now put road racing behind her, but still has ambitions towards the track. As the local hope she was pleased with her ride, but pointed out that the course is some 60 miles from her home! Most approved of the choice of the single carriageway E3/10, with little traffic, but a bit up and down. It is the slower part of a mainly A45-based "25" course, and the majority felt the organisers had chosen well in turning their backs on the dragstrips.

Sharing third place in 23.39, with Louise Jones, (GS Strada) (last year's silver medallist to the other Jones girl-Mandy- not riding this time) was surprise packet Yvonne McGregor, (Bradford Olympic).

Yvonne, one of the revelations of 1992, added a second bronze to the one she took in the "25" championship, her ride compensating for her disappointment in the 50-mile title race, when she saw a possible medal chance slip away after injuring her toe.

Fifth place went to Clare Greenwood, like the winner and Louise Jones just back from Finistere and off to Majorica for final Olympic preparations on the Monday following the race. The Byways RCC rider was followed home by Kim Staff, (ABC Centreville), and a rider whose emergence into the upper echelons had been predicted, Stourbridge CC's Allison Thomas, whose 23.56, was the last of the 25mph-plus rides, but the first of the afternoon, from a starting position of 35.

By the time she finished, the rain that greeted the first starters at 3 pm. from Bottisham on the A1303 road to Newmarket, had been blown away by a rising south-west wind that made conditions harder for the late starters.

The early pace had been set by Margrit Cornillie (Unity CC), with 25.04. off number 5, and the wife of the club sponsor and former junior 25-mile champion John.

New champion Purvis started number 60, her deceptive riding style making the graveyard section of the course with its climb over the A45 look easy.

Ten minutes ahead, Maria Lawrence, (Rockingham Forest Wheelers), had narrowly failed to displace Thomas, producing a precise 25 mph. ride for eighth place.

The team race looked open, but Scarborough Paragon leader Elaine Ward's 24.14, was edged out by Askern's Sally Boyden's 24.10, and with national champion at the distance in 1990, Margaret Allen, recording 24.26., backed by her daughter, junior Katie's 26.17., the seashiders' had to be content with second place.

Former BBAR Allen showed a commendably fast turn of foot on a course that did not seem to suit her, although confirming at the finish that she is not expecting a return of the famous Allen end-of-season super form this year.

Another member of the Finistere stage-race team, Cherie Pridham, Paragon RT, returned 25.12.

Clare Sibun, whose husband Jim had beaten the VITA 100 mile age record for 79 in the Bath Road event the previous weekend-and this following a broken pelvis earlier in the year!-received the plaudits this week for a sterling 28.58.

Fittingly the last starter was the greatest womens time trialist of all time, Beryl Burton OBE, riding to great encouragement all round the course in Morley colours, to 27.28. Beryl, competition record holder at the distance since 1973 with 21.25., made a welcome return to national championship competition in the recent "25" after a spell of ill health.

First starter was 14-year-old Hainault RC rider Michelle Rubiera, riding her first-ever event stylishly, despite the wet conditions which persisted for her.

Farthest-travelled competitor was probably VC Cumbria's Rebecca Bishop, who was hosted by the promoting club

after an epic train journey.

Her verdict on the course and conditions: "Just like Cumbria-a cross wind most of the way and wet."

The junior Championship was a close run thing, going to 15-year-old Georgina Pechar, Shaftesbury CC, by five seconds in 25.34, from Hannah Bean Evesham and District. Georgina took up cycling after seeing the local chain gang riding past her Essex home. She was second in last year's GHS girl's "10", and attends Ingatestone Anglo-European School.

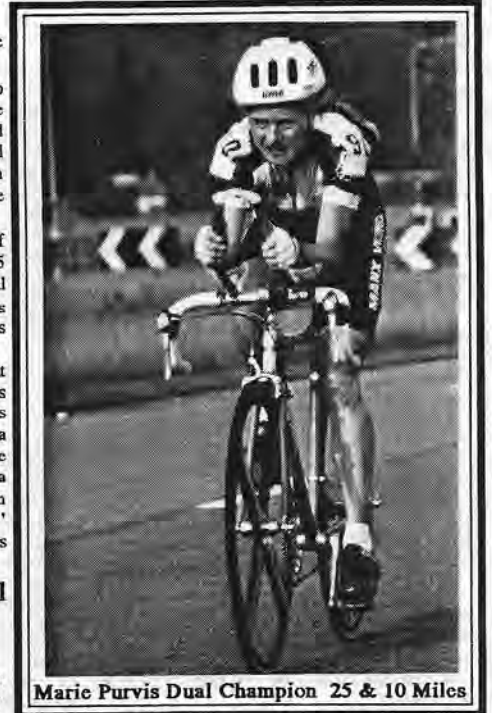
Georgina was riding a pair of 28-spoke wheels, courtesy of Mick Burrow-former competition record holder at 25 miles, of the promoting club-who on Saturday had special satisfaction in putting "first" beside Georgina's name, as he worked on the giant finishing board in the first-class headquarters in Bottisham village.

Other well-known members of the Hainault doing their bit included ex BBAR contender Graham Mann, who was chief marshal. Event organiser was Roland Bright...and it's not every event when one can get a cuppa served up by a distinguished team including the Mum of present 10-mile competition record holder Matthew Illingworth-Anne-a member of the club's comp record 10-mile women's team herself in the early '80s, and a national "25" championship winning team member Roamer CC colours even earlier!

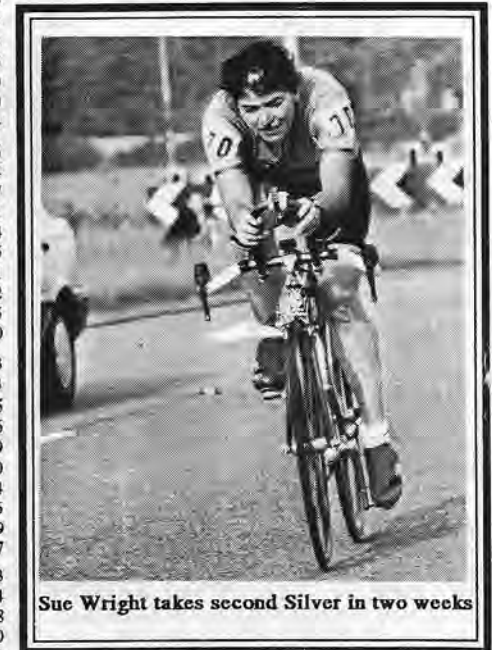

With a strong west wind blowing, most riders would have preferred to use the more sheltered '10' course finish rather than the exposed A45, on Sunday as the girls had done.

With Dave Creese who has been struggling with health problems this season a non-starter, the team race was left wide open, veteran Les White's North Bucks RC team of Jerry Cross and Mark Kalabza having a three second edge over multi-team award winners this year, the Verulam CC.

The St.Albans club was led by Ian Brazier, riding strongly again after a holiday in Cyprus, with 58.27, backed by Warren Marshment (59.30) and Les Newton (59.40) who went away humorously muttering something about the Bidlake system!

It was the club's second promotion and had some unusual introductions. Prizes for fastest time; fastest lady (Kathy Hunter, Herts Wbs); fastest vet (Pete Hamilton on the one-man-one prize rule, Ron Keeble taking second place overall), and fastest junior (Ben Cofield of the promoting club), all won the same prize value: £14.

Explained organiser Parker: "We thought as they had all ridden the same distance they ought to get the same value prize." Even the rain held off until Silver had been allowed his statutory (but not entirely needed) one hour!

Young Cofield was fortunate to win his prize. He broke a spoke on his way to the start and only a last-minute rush by the organiser back to event HQ over a mile away, got him to the line on time with a replacement!

## HOW SETS THE WIND TO JOHN O'GROATS?

It must have been very disappointing for Pauline Strong to have to abandon her End to End attempt after nearly 300 miles. Seemingly the fall she had suffered earlier on in the attempt had proved physically more serious than had been first thought. However, several reports have reached me suggesting that, because of unfavourable weather conditions, she should not have started. It would be difficult to comment on this unless I knew how the organisers reached their decision. This whole question of suitable weather conditions opens up the inevitable situation a potential record breaker faces in modern times when the standard of the record to be beaten is high.

Were the weather conditions suitable enough to have made a start? From my own observations I deduced that she would have to face an easterly component in the wind from Lands End to probably Exeter, where the direction of the route changes a little before it changes yet again at Tewkesbury from where a southerly component is needed. I could not see much hope of a favourable wind even from Tewkesbury, although it would have almost certainly been calm in the night. The general situation was of anticyclonic conditions, and, in the circumstances of this event, that meant a wind from several different quarters, some of these not wholly favourable. It also seemed possible that the wind in Scotland, from the Forth-Clyde valley northwards would be west, or even a little north of west.

Clearly their organisation had its source of meteorological information, and upon this based the decision to start. That it turned out to be unfavourable was unfortunate, and the added misfortune of an accident did not help. I know the feeling when a record attempt has to be abandoned, it brings upon the group a silence and a loss for words.

However, how does one determine the correct weather situation for a record attempt? Not only an End to End, but any attempt.

Meteorology is a complex subject, but as a record breaker is primarily concerned with the direction of the wind, its complexities can be reduced in more simpler terms. The key is the position of the weather systems in the North Atlantic, and most importantly, the direction in which they are moving. The winds circulate around these systems in an anticlockwise or clockwise direction, and change direction over specific areas as they, and their accompanying fronts pass through. The speed of the wind is determined by the pressure gradient, i.e. the proximity of isobars to one another.

People have sometimes said to me that it should not be difficult the weather for a record attempt for the charts appear regularly on television. That is so, but I have discovered that many people, assess the situation as if the chart is static and so will remain. A weather system is quite often very active and can move at speeds of 25 knots or even more. Thus the whole system can change rapidly in only a few hours. If you take into account that a chart on television has probably been prepared hours earlier, it is easy to realise that a weather system will have travelled many hundreds of miles and may have changed direction in the process.

I always found it necessary to watch and consider the developing situation at least 72 hours before the start of an attempt. Most times the situation was reasonably straight forward, but there were times when things began to change and this led to problems.

I can recall one instance where it did become complicated. John Arnold had scheduled to attempt the York-Edinburgh tricycle record and provision was made to prepare a reverse schedule thus enabling him to start from either end and according to weather conditions.

These turned out to be complicated, and it all depended on the track of a depression that was moving generally northwards over England. Its true direction was uncertain and that suggested that, on the day of the attempt, it could be either SE or NW. A decision upon which place to start from had to be made not later than the Saturday noon for the attempt to start the following morning. I had good connections with the Manchester weather centre in those days and I can remember being there waiting for the next synoptic chart to see which way the depression was going. In the event the successful

attempt started from York, but the memory that remains in my mind was that, had the depression been no more than ten degrees to the east of the line York-Edinburgh, the attempt would have started from Edinburgh. Having to wait until the very last minute was nerve wracking to say the least.

And what of a weather situation for an End to End attempt? The situation has to be judged in the context of assessing the position as it will be over two days and eight hundred miles of the country. Ideally a developing depression emanating in Labrador and tracking eastwards to a position off sea areas Shannon and Rockall at about the time the attempt is due to start. The depression would have to be identified 72 hours in advance and its progress across the Atlantic monitored at regular intervals. That is in a perfect world and that does not always happen.

Usually the rider has to accept a compromise, and it is important that the compromise does not give too much away. Cyclonic conditions are usually better than anticyclonic ones. A favourable wind from Lands End is a distinct advantage, but this has sometimes to be balanced by winds north of west in Scotland. Once having started it is as well to ignore local conditions; these can be misleading and sap morale. Local conditions can change wind directions as, for example on the climb up Shap from Kendal, or the climb over the Devil's Beef Tub. The effect of the Solway estuary often turns as wind from south of west slightly north of west until the route reaches the lee of the mountains. In the later stages a wind off the North Sea can play havoc in the early morning until it settles down. It does not do either to look at every flagpole or chimney. I have seen flagpoles that are fixed and point in the wrong direction.

Let us hope that if Pauline Strong does go again that she will have a successful weather forecast.
