Butler's stamina, again.

Gethin Butler once again proved his staying power as he wins the Goodmayes 100 in the last 25 miles, and creating a new course record.

Butler was leading at 25 miles in 52.52, with Matthew Postle at 23 seconds, Kevin Dawson was third 2.29secs.in arrears, With John French on 56.54, and Ray Hughes 56.58, then came the next 25 miles with the helping Sth West wind, although Butler recorded 49.58, he was lying second at fifty miles to Postle's 1.42.11. Butler 1.42.50., Dawson 1.46.05.

The third 25 miles brought Butler back on top, with a ride of 59.40, to Postle's 1.01.30., showed Gethin in command once again at 75 miles with 2.42.30., Matthew Postle 2.43.41., only John French could match Butler on this section recording the same time of 59.40.

In the final 25 miles Postle faded with a 1.02.46., compared to Butler's 58.33, and Dawson 59.21. Butler's final winning margin of 5m.24s. proves that there is still plenty of room for improvement on this the fastest 100 of the year so far.

Sue Wright, Chelmer CC had a convincing win over Sue Goody, Shaftesbury CC. an 18mins margin with a ride of 4.17.06.

Edwards 7 minute win

A re-arranged course to avoid the dualling of a single carriage now under construction between Arundel and Worthing provided the 54 entrants with over twenty roundabouts to cope with on a damp morning, but these potential hazards failed to stop Ben Edwards (Clarence Wheelers) taking over seven minutes out of the 1988 winner, John Woodburn (Manchester Wheelers) and nearly three minutes off the event record set by Peter Pickers (Antelope RT) last year.

This was Edwards' second 50 on southern roads this season, and though he could not quite beat his 1.53.06 achieved at Ringwood last month his 1.54.46 put him in a class of his own on a day when most went back several minutes on their personal bests. Both he and Woodburn chose disc wheels but the latter wondered if his low profile frame was the best choice on a course with so many changes of direction.

Another worried by his equipment was Chris Shepherd of the promoting club who was alarmed to discover shortly after starting that his front brake was malfunctioning, causing him to approach the many roundabouts at reduced speed and thankful to finish without mishap, even though this probably cost him third place.

That went to Murray Quiney (VC St Raphael) who surprised several more fancied time trialists including his own clubmate, Ted Reddick, in making his first attempt at the distance.

Although the course used is unlikely to be ridden again-potentially faster courses are anticipated once improvements to the A27 trunk road in West Sussex are completed-the extra four miles imposed on riders between the finish and event headquarters did find favour with one of them. This route took Trevor Rush past his own front door in Boxgrove, enabling him to stop off for a shower and change into dry clothes before joining others round the result board-afterwards.

Silver wins. F1

Mid-afternoon conditions looked perfect for the F1; warm, moist, cloudy and a light, falling Southerly, Anyhow, that's what the organiser and 90% of a full field thought-a float dat to rival the infamous Southend event last year!

Then at 4.30pm. the clouds vanished, leaving the sun to hurry some dry air up the course. An early ride by second seed Les Pick, more than four minutes slower than his best, confirmed the worst; the generous slices of chocolate fudge cake would definitely win the day.

But even the fudge reckoned without handicapper John Hughes, whose unspectacular ride was well and truly compensated by a superb cluster of handicap times, 95% in the 50's and more than 75% being within five minutes of one another. Any claims to better this for the season?

Ride of the day must go to Woolwich veteran Treby, with a ride of 59.22. just two seconds off his personal best set pre-recession, causing a re-check of the timekeeper's sheet before confirming a clear handicap win by more than a minute.

Phil Silver maintained his stamp on this popular association event, winning with a strong 53.12. Previous champion Paul Bennett, now very close to beating his age in a '25', continued to terrorise this year's Vets BAR contenders as fastest veteran and fourth place overall.

A bike mechanic at Butler's Cycles, the 22 year old has been riding "a few years" working in the right environment for speed.

On a windy day with a warm drizzle, just wet enough to make it dangerous on the many roundabouts, he took the event in his stride, and says he "might try a fifty" later on.

Second placed and best junior D.Price (Westbury Wheelers) was also riding his first 25, and the fourth and third riders A.Dallison (East Surrey) and P.Jones (SW RC) also picked up the best improvement prize, on a day when most were riding well below their best.

Steve Vaughan Wins on "Boro"

On a day remarkably similar to the previous Sunday, a fresh breeze foiled the chance of a fast ride for those hoping to improve on the A1.

The early conditions were overcast with a little drizzle about and this, plus the wind, discouraged well over a quarter of the field from starting.

It was soon apparent that it was to be no flier as the early results came in.

R.L.Warrington(ABC Centreville) returned a 56.09 which was 15 seconds slower than his ride on the same course last week. It was still fast enough however to make him the fastest rider in the first half of the field where only 10 riders beat the hour.

Dudley Hayton(East Bradford CC) caused a "buzz" around the Result Board when his time of 54.42 was recorded and few thought that it would be beaten on the day. Andy Gates(Pendle Forest CC) impressed with a fine ride of 55.03 which put him in second place at the time but both were displaced by Steve Vaughan(Morley CC) who won the Event with over a minute to spare with a tremendous 53.28 which led his club to the team victory.

Fastest Lady was Karen Morton(City RC Hull) who rode strongly to record a 1.5.03. The same club took the fastest Junior Award when Juvenile Adam Hardy beat the "58" barrier by achieving 57.59.

Phil Hurt(Morley CC), 58.49, was fastest Vet and second man in the Morley team. 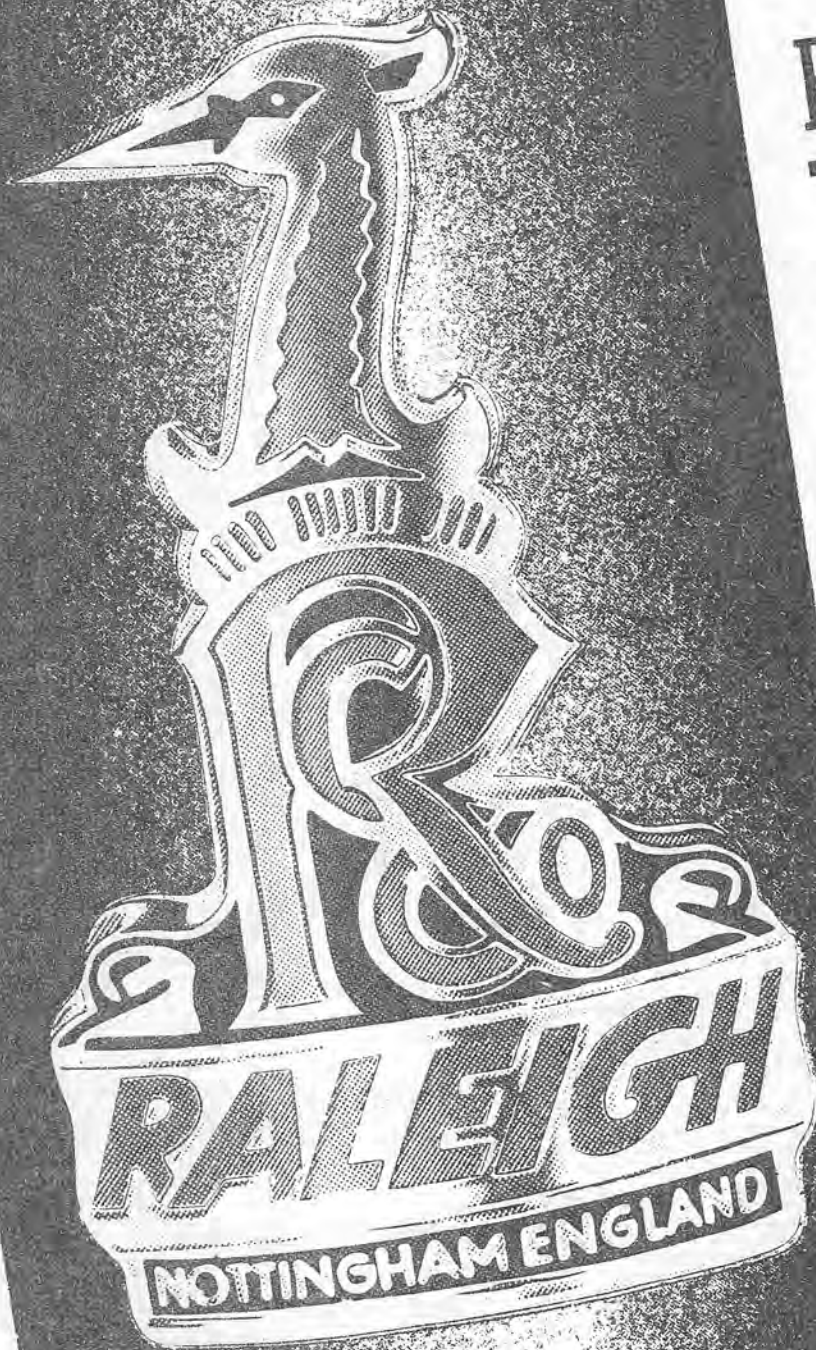
