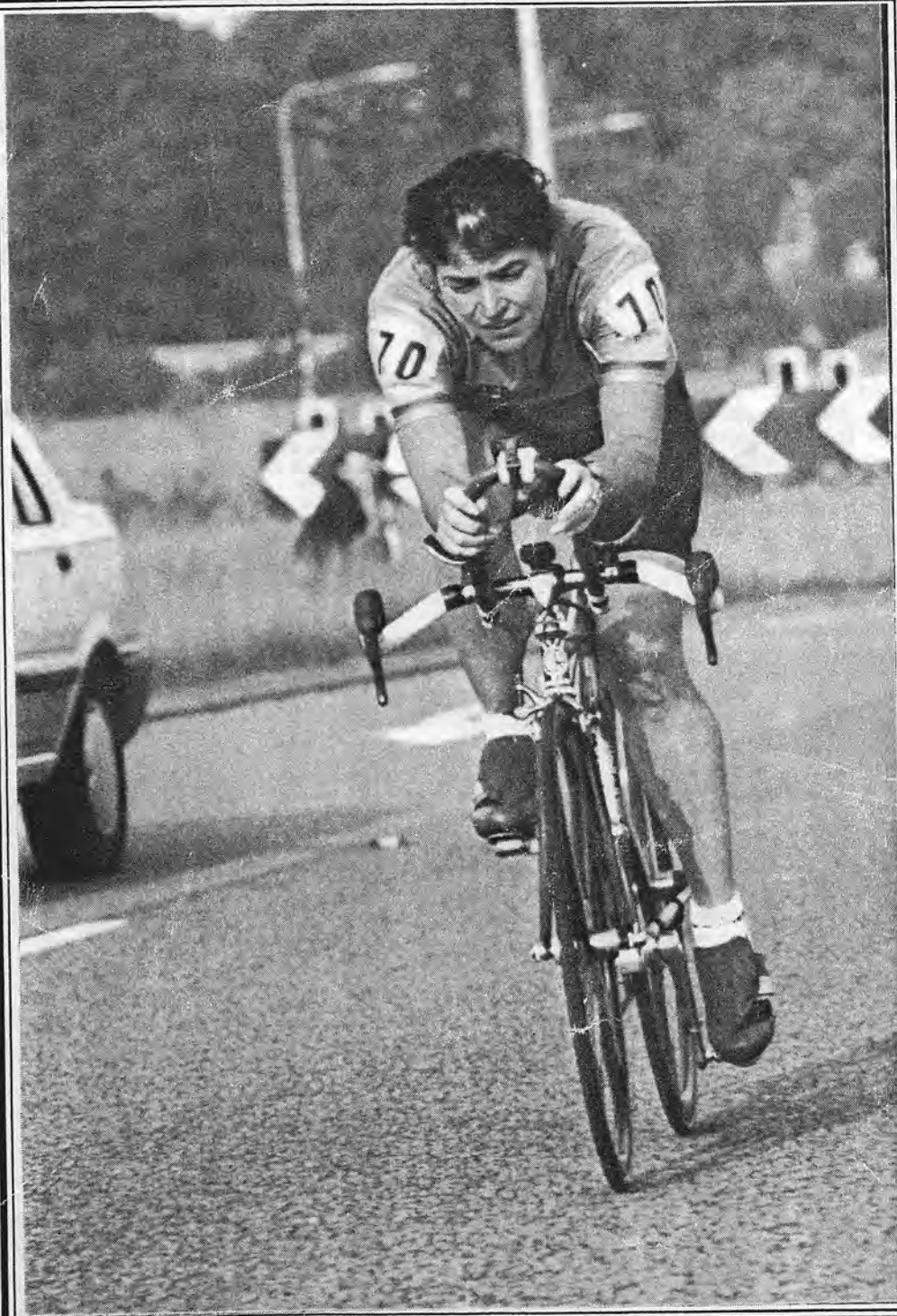

Gethin Butler and Sue Wright 100 mile Champions.

Held on a new course the C100/3, the 1992 Championship was run by Ellis Smith of the Lincoln Wheelers on behalf of the Lincolnshire DC and as I have come to expect, the organisation was first class.

The weather-man got it about right too - broken cloud, south-west wind and not particularly warm and these conditions virtually ensured that whatever else happened, no competition records were going to go!

First the Ladies; off at 6.01, Jill Postlethwaite (VC Lincoln), a new recruit from a Triathlon, Randonnee and CTC background led a field of 35 (3 non-starters) north up the first leg along the A15 and by the time the riders had returned having covered 41 miles the pattern of the whole championship (ladies and men) was set. All the riders took about 10 minutes longer to cover the second 25 miles than the first and most rode the second fifty miles faster, or nearly as fast as the first.

Fastest at 25 miles, Christine Roberts (Crewe Carion), with 59.45, led Mararet Allen (Askern CC) whose 59.52 just beat eventual championship winner Sue Wright (Chelmer CC) who went through in 59.59. However, Sue Wright led the field from 50 miles onward with times of 2.08.38 and 3.13.38 respectively at the 50 and 75 mile checks. Remarkably she covered her final 25 miles faster than her first to take the title in 4.14.29. Runner-up, Charlotteville's Leigh Lamont rode consistently - 1.03.05; 2.11.22; 3.16.19 to return 4.18.47 thus pushing Christine Roberts, who returned 4.19.01, into third place. Forth and fifth places went to Anne Plant (Lakes RC) 4.27.33 and Mararet Allen (Askern CC), who pushed herself to the limit, 4.29.30.

The Team Championship title went to Scarborough Paragon CC - Elaine Ward (4.43.10), Jackie White (4.54.31) and Rebecca Charles (5.00.36) - 14.38.17.

The men's championship in the end produced little in the way of surprises, with the duel between Gethin Butler and Matthew Postle following what appears to be a pattern. Matthew Postle led by almost 2 minutes at 75 miles only to have this lead turned into a 18 second defeat at the end. But earlier, and unseeded, starter Paul Holdsworth who ended up Hounslow & Dist Whs second team counter, arrived with a 4.00.54 which led for some considerable time.

In all only the first five riders beat four hours with Gethin Butler taking the Title with 3.47.19 (51.43, 1.52.09, 2.50.49); Matthew Postle 3.47.37 (51.02, 1.50.27, 2.48.50) - second; and Kevin Dawson 3.50.16 (51.38, 1.52.46, 2.52.45) - third. Forth place was taken by John French, Manchester Wheelers Club with 3.58.23 and fifth placed Colin Roshier led the winning Championship Team with 3.59.03. Rob Richardson in ninth place, completed the Hounslow team with 4.05.15 to give them a total of 12.05.12.

Of the three trike riders on the start card, Brian Moore (VC Cumbria produced a creditable 4.48.49; and local rider Martin Purser (Charlotteville CC) returned 5.35.36.

Of the 102 men on the start sheet only nine failed to start, but only, four of those were five minute seeded riders; and of those who started, only eleven did not finish, a statistic which says a lot for the riders who continued, many of whom I suspect returned rides not far short of their personal worsts - the wind, though not apparently that strong, did indeed take its toll!

The presentations after the event were made by Gordon Ian the 1959/60 25 mile RTTC Champion, who won his title in the first RTTC Championship to be held on Lincolnshire Roads.

Surprise of the day was Neil Archibald, aged 29, in his second year of serious cycling. His tactics were to go to the turn as hard as possible and hang on for the return leg. At the 28.5 mile turn he had a half minute lead on eventual winner Ian Cammish but lost the return into the wind to finish one minute behind. A road man as well, the previous week he won an afternoon road race after racing a time trial in the morning.

M.Scalon and W.Jones (Rhos-on-Sea) both came down from north Wales with the objective of beating the club record, both did so, both did the same time! (1.55.23)

Gordon Irons from the promoting club made a surprise appearance at the finish. The week before he had suffered a heart attack shortly after retiring in the Goodmayes '100' and had spent four days in hospital.

Sunday 26th July - Course V383 (Revised)

It was an overcast day which started calm enough but it was not long before a fresh SW wind appeared which was to harass the riders all day.

The threat of rain did not materialise apart from a few spots and the temperature was perhaps just about right for a long distance event, being not too hot but warm enough.

The Course, based on York, although revised was essentially the same as previously used except that the Start and Finishing circuit were moved a few miles North due to the non-availability of the Shipton Village Hall.

The Event HQ this year was at Tollereton.

Of the 75 entrants only 4 failed to start on the York to Thirsk and back first leg of the Event.

Then it was out towards Market Weighton on the A1079 with the wind beginning to make it's effect felt.

At this stage Gareth Metcalfe(Otley CC) was ahead of Julian Read(Goole Vermuden) and a battle was developing between James Charles(Goole Vermuyden) and Derek Roe(Morley CC) who had been caught. Don Hacking (Birkenhead NE) was also well up with the leaders and it looked as if the winner would come from one of this group.

The tough leg out to Selby saw the 100 mile passed and Gareth in the lead.

Riders heaved a sigh of relief as they rounded the Barlby traffic island and escaped the relentless head wind. (Some uttered unprintable words!)

The course then took the riders back to York and then out to Tadcaster. They then repeated the A1079 section and returned via the Selby leg once more. The mileage at Barlby, for those who had not omitted any legs, was 176.5.

As can be seen it was pretty tight among the leaders and it was to stay that way right to the end as the riders returned to Tadcaster for the second time before heading towards the A19 north of York and on to the Finishing Circuit. There was never any real doubt that Julian Read would win the Event as he began to open up a gap. His final total of 264.972 gave him a winning margin of 9 miles.

But less than a mile was to separate the next three placings.

What a great ride by 20 year old James Charles. His pace over the early stages and his determination and courage later, earned him second place in the Event with a distance of 255.852 miles - almost the same as what his father, Ray, did to take 2nd place in the 1989 Event.

Don Hacking was only half a mile behind to finish with a total of 255.249 and take third place overall and the fastest Veteran on Standard award with a +61.709.

Early leader, Gareth Metcalfe, finished in fourth position a mere quarter of a mile adrift with 254.962.

Some other notable rides were achieved on a far from easy day but by any standards the ride by 18 year old Richard Towe(East Bradford CC) is impressive. Not only riding his first '12' but also in his first season, he broke his Club's Junior 12 hour record with his 235 mile total - and being the youngest rider to finish he won the Time Trial Weekly £10 Voucher.

Mary Dawson(Teesside RC) again proved that she is hard to beat in the distance events when she took the Ladies award with a total of 221.616 but Lyn Hanson (Seacroft Wheelers) was not far behind to finish second in 218.549.

Brian Haskell(Huddersfield RC) rode a good race to finish with 242.527 giving him a +53.307 and second place in the V.T.T.A. Event.

Long distance specialist John Baines finished with 240.661 miles to ensure that Goole Vermuyden took the Team Award. Spare a thought for Cliff Ralphs(Otley CC) who finished just 1.9 miles short of the 1000 mile total(in consecutive events) he needed to earn his medal!

Paxton's 8min margin

"I am getting used to these hard courses" said Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) after beating Steve House (Clarence Wheelers) by eight minutes, in the Bournemouth Jubilee Wheelers 100. "Quite punishing that second 50 miles."

Lee was happy to have got in a fast time in spite of the bad conditions, beating Steve House for the second week in succession, and setting up his BAR aspirations for this year.

His plans include riding the Wessex 100 in a fortnight, and if that is not good enough, at least one more. A glutton for the longer distances, he also intends riding in two 12s before the end of the season. He was as pleased with having beaten his own club's 25 record during the week 53.57, as winning. The only club record that he did not hold, and he has been under more pressure from his club mates over beating this, than his BAR hopes.

Terry Icke summed up the performance. "That's the first time I have been caught for 10 years, Lee went past me like a train." Like everyone else he was saying how hard it had been against the West wind.

Third placed Ivan Prince managed his target, a 14 minute improvement in spite of the conditions, which were harder than he expected. Also having trouble with the holiday traffic over the final miles. "I was hoping to finish fast as it went over the club 10 course, but there were lots of caravans, and I kept getting stuck in them."

Ladies handicap winner Anne Wallace, mother of professional record breaker Shaun, showed where he got it from, taking the Wessex veterans standard for her age, as well as doing a personal best. "I am so pleased that I don't have to ride another 100 this year" she added. Anne's daughter Claire Newman not to be outdone took the first women's prize.

Lady's prize went to Gwen Shillaker, Chippenham & District, her usual bright and breezy self before and after a steady and stylish ride.

One or two happy faces at the result board, evidence of 'PBs' despite the day. These included this correspondent, who managed a 3-minute beating of an 11-year PB, albeit at a very modest level compared with most.

Full credit to Steve Harvey and company for a well organised-well marshalled event that deserved a fuller turn-out than the 70 riders on the sheet.

ENTRIES IN TWENTY FOUR HOUR EVENTS.

In referring to the entry of the Mersey Roads 24 in the What's on column in issue 23, it was suggested that the entry of 92 must be record for a non championship event.

I have researched my records and find that this is not so. In 1950 the championship was incorporated into the Western T.T.A. event and there were 82 entries. The North Road 24 of the same year had the then maximum of 100 entries.

The following year the championship was incorporated into the Catford event which had 93 entries, and the North Road event had 100 entries.

I have delved further into my records and I find that there have only ever been four occasions when the entry in a 24 hour event reached the maximum of 100 -the North Road of 1950, 1951 and 1952, and the Catford of 1955. The greatest entry in the Mersey is the 95 of 1991. The Wessex event had a maximum of 73 in 1958.

Many people have assumed that the Championship would always receive the greatest entry but, curiously, this is not so. The chart below gives the details.

It has always been a feature of 24 hour events that the number of entries assume great importance. Perhaps this is because there are so few of these events and therefore good entries are the life blood of their survival. It may also be as a result of natural interest, for the followers of these type of events are enthusiasts to say the least.

Be that as it may, it is heartening to see entries rising again. There are only two events left now and no one wants to see them disappear from the calendar. I used to reckon that below 30 entries in an event there were financial problems, and below 20 entries there was a total lack of interest. I remember being at the last Anfield 24 in 1936 where, if my memory serves me right, there were 9 entries.

I can also recall in the following year, when the first Mersey Roads event produced 19 entries, the sigh of relief was noticeable.

For those with a statistical bent, some interesting facts about entries are worthy of note.

The most number of events in one year was five in 1956..North Road, Mersey,Catford, Wessex and Ealing Paragon. The total combined entries was 239. This is not the greatest however, for in 1950 from four events..North Road, Mersey,Catford and Western TTA there was a total combined entry of 287.

The last time that 200 total entries were recorded was in 1960, when four events produced 203 entries. Therefore the totals declined to the all time post war low of 96 entries from two events (North Road and Mersey) in 1988. 1992 has produced 164 entries from the two remaining events.

It is too early to talk of revival, and even too early to talk of additional events. The wish to see more promotions has been the desire of many people, indeed I would welcome it myself. However, I feel that it will need regular totals of over 200 entries before it will be possible to consider another event.

There were additional events in 1979, 1983,1986 and 1987 when RTTC inspired events were promoted. They received good entries of 56,74,82 and 66 respectively, but the established events suffered. In 1979 the North Road had only 22 entries and the Wessex 16 entries. In 1983 the North Road had only 26 entries, in a year when the Wessex disappeared from the calendar. There was an upturn in 1986 when the Mersey only got 47 entries, but it went down again the following year when the North Road only got 31 entries.

These RTTC inspired events seem now to have disappeared from the calendar. Indeed, in the 1990 Annual Report, the National Committee advocated to discontinue of a Championship 24, but the idea foundered due to unexpected pressure from the delegates at the meeting.

Finally, the maximum entry now permitted is 120; will that be attained one day?
