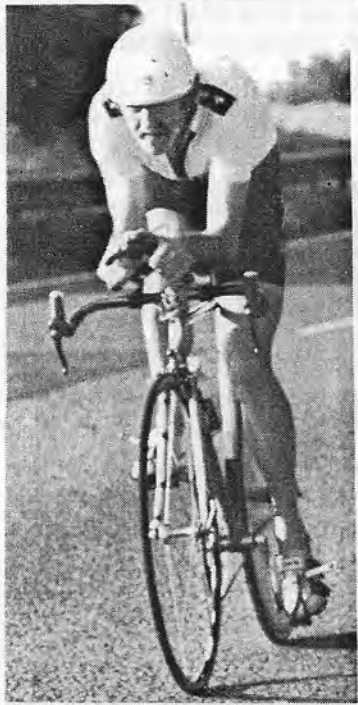

**Mark Jones wins Sussex 12**

Sussex CA Best All-Rounder, Mark Jones (GS Stella) clinched his third title in four years with this winning ride which, for many hours, looked like beating the record of 259 miles set by Matthew Rabbetts (Lewes Wanderers) last year, until a persistent wind from the south-west slowed him on his way back from Horsham after 140 miles.

The first 100 miles was completed with 12 hour debutant, Greg. Knight (Regent RC) trailing Jones by only twenty seconds, the winner having passed this point in 4.29.44., with George Taylor (Eastbourne Rovers) holding third place in 4.33.59. He moved into second place after Knight paid for his efforts and dropped out in the early afternoon, but he was made to fight all the way to hold that position as another novice 12 hour man, Shaun Kennedy (Bec CC) pursued him all the way round the finishing circuit. Delayed by a puncture in the morning which left him over four minutes down on Taylor at 100 miles, Kennedy, the last of thirty entrants in this thirtieth anniversary event, was judged to have taken a few seconds longer to "run out his time", but race organiser, Ray Douglass, in charge of his eleventh "12", promised a full check of all intermediate times before confirming what at present is only a provisional result.

There was no doubting the preference for the new finishing circuit, hastily arranged when temporary traffic lights were erected on the longer and hillier one used in recent years. Though only 11.5 miles long, it carried less traffic and is better surfaced than the one it replaced, and though this involved a change of race headquarters the village hall in Dial Post (now by-passed by the A.24) proved a most suitable refuge for the twenty-two finishers. The event was sponsored by The Bike Store of Worthing whose support included an energy drink and bidon for all riders.

Open 100 Mile Time Trial  
Sunday 9th August - Course V372**

Thunder, lightning and heavy rain greeted the riders as they assembled on the A19 north of York. The Start was delayed by 20 minutes. The Organiser had received exactly 120 entries but the field was decimated as 52 riders decided the conditions were too bad for them and failed to start. Many must have regretted opting out because it was to be a "float" day in more ways than one and PB's abounded.

The rain did ease off and the road surface dried out. There was very little wind and it was soon obvious that fast times would be achieved on this hurriedly designed course which was in use for the first time.

Using the A19/A168/A1/A59/A1237 and the A64, most competitors found the course to their liking.

The 50 mile point was at Tadcaster on the A64. Brian Sunter (Condor RC) was through in 1.53.20 to lead Alan Roberts (Crewe Clarion Wheelers), 1.54.35, by over a minute. In third place at the half way stage was S.Beech (Denny RC) who went through in 1.54.59. Other riders inside 2 hours were J.Lewis (VC Nouveau), 1.56.12, Julian Read (Goole Vermuyden CC), 1.56.26, B.Chafer (Glossop RC), 1.59.26, and D.W.Robinson (Rockingham CC), 1.59.31.

61 riders out of the original full field made it to the turn.

Riding a remarkably even paced race Alan Roberts bettered his first 50 time by a few seconds to record 1.54.13 on the return leg and win the event in 3.48.48.

Brian Sunter was second with a Personal Best ride of 3.50.29 which we think is one of the fastest ever 100's by a 49 year old.

First of the Ladies was Ann Plant (Lakes RC) with a time of 4.24.36 with 2nd position going to Lucy Debenham (Wetherby Wheelers) who did 4.53.25 in her first 100 and gained a place in the winning team.

## Keeble's Express 25

Enthusiasts were looking forward to the battle between the old masters multi champion John Pritchard BEM (Express RT), Ron Keeble (Express RT) Olympic medallist and former track squad manager, and the new junior 25 mile champion Chris Ball (Antelope RT) in the Bournemouth Jubilee Wheelers 25 mile time trial on the P201 at Ringwood.

On the day the formidable John Pritchard and his son had to call it off with a cold that had been lingering for over a week. What virus has the impudence to lay low the normally unbeatable Pritchard?

Ron Keeble settled the matter with an over the minute beating of the ambitious youngster who had to settle for an equal third place with Bob Thorne (Polytechnic CC) Neil Archibald (Gemini BC) slipping in between, not happy with his seventh second place in his second racing season.

Keeble unable to explain his success this year, said he felt rough all the way round. Staying the night before with niece Monique Gibson (Bournemouth Arrow CC), he had not been able to do his usual quarter of an hour warm up on a turbo. He seemed astonished that any cycling household should be without one.

This year he "has been training less, like Boardman" having decided that he was only going to do 25 mile events. The formula works for him as well.

Junior Chris Ball on the other hand was tired. He had not recovered from last week, which included winning the junior championship and a session with the national track squad. "They really put me through it" he said. Also he had broken his tri bars the night before, and had to borrow a pair from a friend, giving "a position not right."

The young champion is delighted that he has been approached to join the track squad. Something Time Trial Weekly recommended some time ago. He would like to do well in the kilometre and the pursuit, and get to the junior world championships this year. Looking to Boardman as a model.

This enthusiastic youngster doesn't say that he is going to do something, but those that know him translate "like to do" into "going to do". He talks of trying himself out against established riders "to see how he would go against them." That should set alarm bells ringing if they hear it.

Riding gears on the low side, using the 13 sprocket is a big event for Chris, where others talk of putting it in the 12 and leaving it there. He says he is not ready to race abroad with the road squad in longer races. Mentioning that he was training with Harry Lodge who has been advising him. Another point in his favour, not frightened to ask at the top for advice, he listens to it.

The race attracted a full field of 90, 51 entries being returned. The same number as last year when 120 were allowed. Possibly because 30 riders had decided that they would not get in, but why were there 21 nonstarters on a good morning?

A second pair failed to start, leaving the way clear for Simon Birnsting and Julian Stewart-Long (Brighton Excelsior) to win this category in 1.08.32.

**TWENTY FOUR HOUR TALES.**  
**"DISCOVERING RIBENA"**

It was my first 24 hour-the 1949 Mersey R.C. event and National Championship. I had been conned into riding it to make up the Club team by Bernard Knight and George Juggins. Now I was fearful but had promised that I'd finish, come what may-falling back on the thought that if Bernard could recover from four years as a Prisoner of War in Germany after Dunkirk, having sunk to 7 stones from 14 stones and come third in the 1948 event, I should be able to finish somehow!

So a slow start, just touring round until about 12 hours when the thought, "IT'S halfway so only got to get back!" struck me-which thought may be fine for 25s;50s;or 100s, yet it worked and I got down to really trying.

The weather was dry and sunny and a group of clubmates had cycled up to near Chester to give encouragement. I'd got through the night and it was so warm I needed drinks every ten miles or so which clubmates handed up at various points and informed me that I was doing well, confirmed by my catching rider after rider until it sank-in that I was up to tenth. So telling myself that with only about four hours to go and it being so warm I must take care not to dehydrate-calling for more drinks, especially glucose and water, the latter which I poured over my head, to feel the refreshing trickles down my back.

Excitement was mounting as I sped from Whitchurch to Wem, then towards Waverton and the start of the finishing circuit. A young lad caught me-not racing-on his new bike, full of enthusiasm on his first ride.

"Have you ridden far mate?"

"About 360 miles!" I replied and he slipped away to the rear for now I had the bit-between-my-teeth in top gear, trying as hard as I could go, thinking irrationally, the faster I go the quicker it will be over!

Swinging right to Waverton Corner what a surprise awaited! crowds lined the road like in the Tour De France, all wildly welcoming every rider who had made it so far. It certainly raised my speed as round and round the finishing circuit I went, noticing the sharp right bend over Hooley Bridge three times.

Doug or was it Sandy? handed up a bottle and said, "Stan Harvey is leading and you are sixth, thrilled at this information-I might even win? so tipped the contents over my head and put everything I'd got into going faster. Becoming aware of stickiness on my legs-looked down-horror of horrors-BLOOD everywhere!

Gosh, had I burst a blood vessel? It wasn't my nose. Where could it be? Still going strongly thought I must finish first and worry about it later, so I completed the final circuit before being directed off along an emergency route as the first four riders were exceeding the measured course.

Passing the Black Dog at Waverton I noticed Stan Harvey off his bike with Charlie Davey urging him to carry on as I had still got to go up to the turn and back.

Wondering how long before loss of blood would sap my energy, Benny Hudson (Rutland CC) and TW.Read (East Mids Clarion) came past from the turn on their way to the finish so I was now fourth which spurred me on to even greater efforts. Passing a timekeeper who called out "carry on"-and I'd so been expecting to stop by my own watch I nearly stopped before realising I had to go on to the next timekeeper so sprinted out of the saddle, past the Black Dog-Harvey and Davey had gone-until called to stop and I almost fell off to lie on the grass in the still warm sunshine to await clubmates. After about an hour the timekeeper cycled off saying, "I'll tell them at H.Q. where you are!"

No luxury of personal following cars then.

Awakened by clubmates; sore toes and aching wrists-surprisingly no saddle soreness or backache, I noticed the blood!

"How did you like the Ribena?" asked Doug

Relief flooded through me and joy as I was told the Solihull CC had won the team championship.
