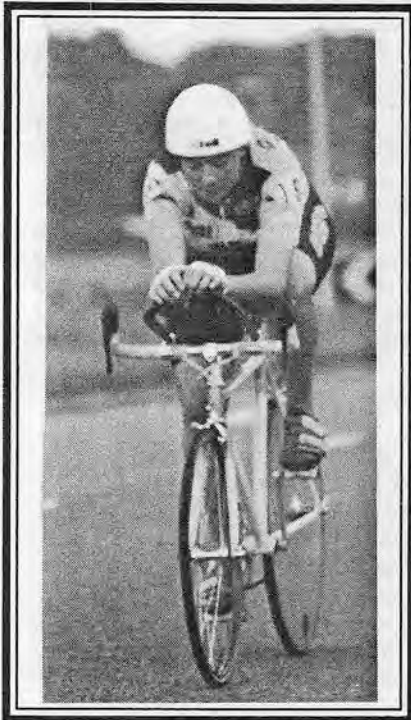

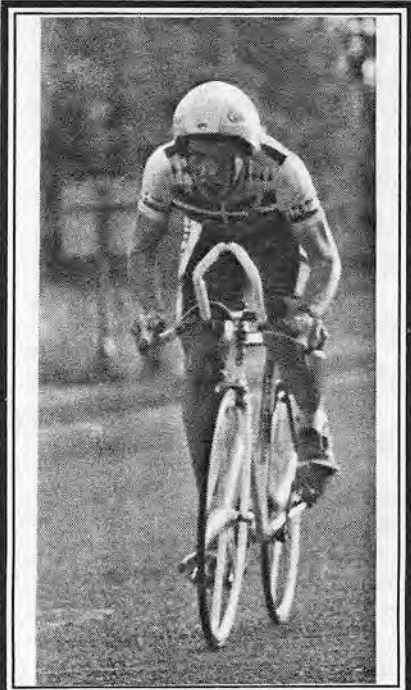

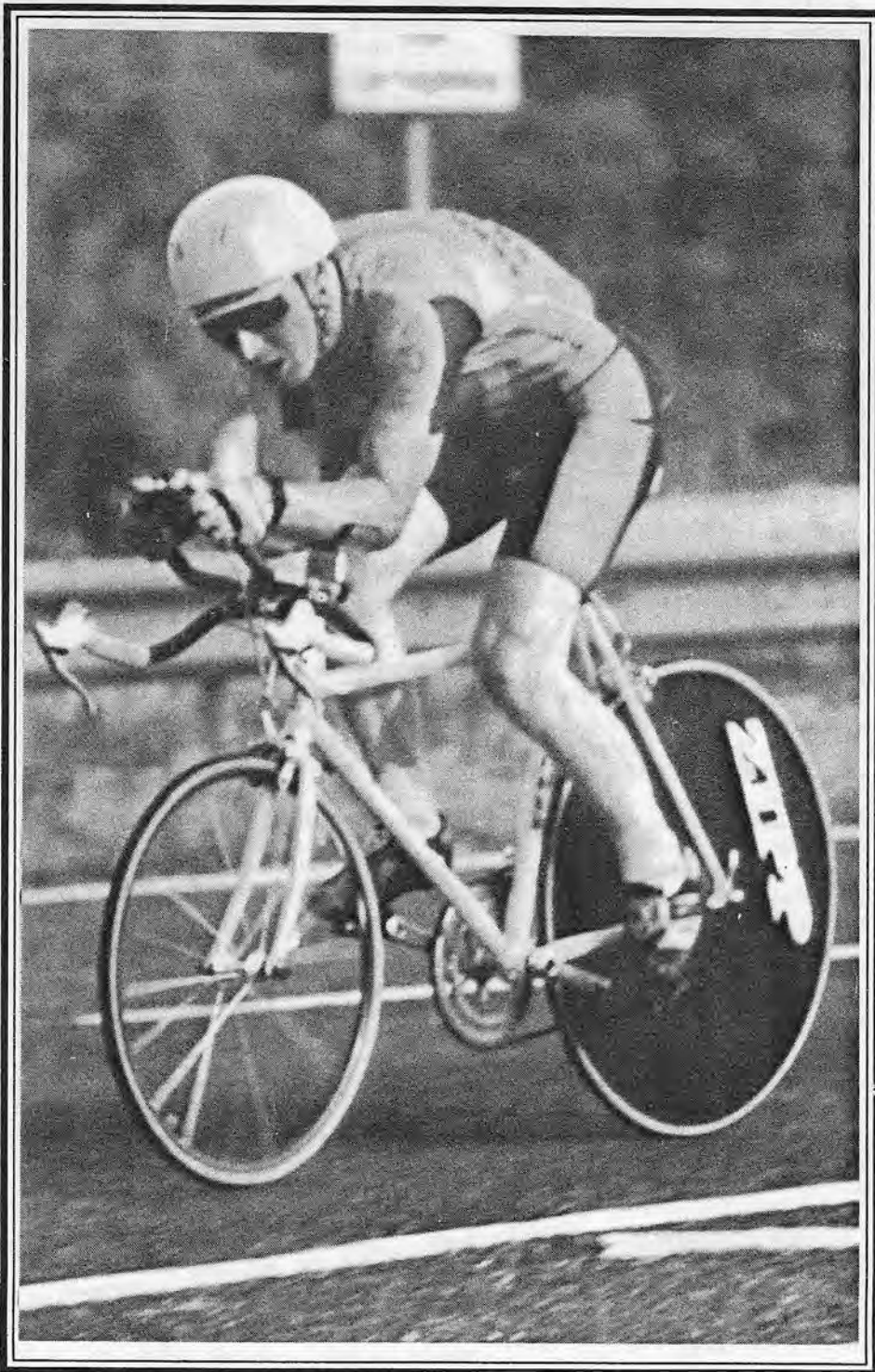

GOODFELLOW WINS ALONE!

Peter Goodfellow, Sheffield University CC., won the combined Liverpool and West Cheshire open 12 hour event with a provisional total of 261.06. miles. He also collected the prize for a first 12. even though he has previously ridden a couple with his dad Rod plus a 24, but on the back of a tandem. Peter was in good spirits around the course, raising a smile to the helpers. He said at the finish "I took it bad on the final lap of the circuit and it is true I have ridden a 12 before but this time I had to steer!"

Second was Richard Johnson of North Shropshire Whs. in 258.25. Third place, with a PB improvement of a few yards over last year's 12, was Christine Roberts, Crewe Clarion Whs, with 253.95, beating Keith Sylvester, Mid Shropshire Whs., 253.20. Sylvester is likely to take the West Cheshire BAR but Christine came close to making history as runner-up with one 25 mile event to go. If Keith failed to start and Christine did a 59 minute ride she could take the title, according to husband Alan Roberts who was sidelined for the 12 with a serious back complaint. Liverpool Century's Mike Loughran did well to do 232.92. at his first attempt and awaits the working out of the figures to see if he has won the Liverpool TTCA championship. Kelvin Prince, Birkenhead Victoria CC, was close with 231.67. miles. Dave Voller, North Wirral Velo, improved ten miles for fifth spot in 250.35. miles.

Only 40 entries were received by organiser Bob McNamee who did a great job. In addition to marshalling throughout the day he stood in the rain to operate the result board at the end, assisted ably by the computer operated by Mersey Roder John Williams.

Bobby Mac, has raised the question about the future of the Liverpool and West Cheshire 12 and may be suggesting to the Liverpool Association, as their chairman, they run their BAR on the best 25,50 and 100.

He says if they do continue with the 12 next season they will be looking for an organiser. Any volunteers??

Jubilee MM 50 for Moss

Steve Moss (Bournemouth Arrow CC) winner of the Bournemouth Jubilee middlemarkers 50 mile time trial at Ringwood, at 33 he was not making a come back to time trialling. In spite of his many wins on the road, and his international experience he had never finished in a fifty before.

The handicapper not taken in by his novice credentials, made allowance for his two road race wins and four seconds, and winning the Poole track league championship by giving him plus 7 minutes on scratch.

The only fifty that he had started was last year, he thought that he "would get a time against his name" as earlier in the season, he had not been able to get a ride in his own club's open.

On schedule for a 1.58. He blew up in the last 20 miles losing two minutes. With only one prize per rider, the novice award went to R.Ruta (Rufus Wheelers) one of seven who entered without a previous time, and only included because of a last minute withdrawal.

WELSH CHAMPIONSHIP VICTORY AND WELSH COMPETITION RECORD FOR MATTHEW POSTLE.

Matthew Postle (Delta RT) regained his Welsh record after losing it to Alun Owen (CC Abergavenny) recently.

The riders experienced rain and a rising westerly wind during the event.

At 20 miles Postle was delayed with mechanical problems, however, at 25.76 mile point led the field with 53.58. followed by Ben Edwards (Clarence Whs) at 56.31. and Clive Brooks (Polytechnic CC) close behind at 56.39.

Over the second half Postle maintained his superiority to finish with 1.46.50. with Edwards at 1.51.52. and Brooks 1.52.09.

Mrs. J.M.Owens (VC Sevale) won the ladies event with 2.12.10. M.S.M.Howells (CC Abergavenny) was the fastest junior with an outstanding time of 2.01.04. and the fastest veteran of the day was 40 year old P.Cannon (Ogmore Valley Whs) with 1.54.02.

Fast times washed away in North Notts event

A vastly oversubscribed event and a fast course-ingredients for a superfaster competition; Unfortunately the weather decided not to rise to the occasion and riders in the North Notts 25 were faced with high winds and lashing rain.

It was Chris Myhill (Dinnington RC) who weathered the storm best-but it was nearly a ride which didn't happen. "With two minutes to go I nearly didn't start", he revealed. However, having "warmed up" he was so wet he decided to give it a go. Finding that he was able to turn gears of 100 and 108 into the wind, he knew his form was good and he pressed on to record a super time.

The victory margin, however, was the narrowest possible. Just a single second separated Myhill from Steve Vaughan (Morley CC) a rider currently enjoying a purple patch.

Once Vaughan had finished, victory for Myhill was assured. The wind performed a dramatic turn around and late finishing riders, to their surprise, faced a final five miles of headwind. Riders expecting a "12 sprocket return" found themselves floundering in the 17 sprocket. Geoff Platts (Coalville Whs) therefore, must surely earn the honour of "ride of the day". Despite his start from No. 100, Platts scythed through the wind to record a tremendous 54.51.

Such were the conditions that many DNF's appeared on the board-most notable being Ian Cammish who called it a day with only half a mile to go, unofficially timed, on for a 57 minute ride.

The field was packed with ladies looking to improve their BBAR speeds, these ambitions were literally washed away, but mention must be made of Margaret Allen (Askern CC) who recorded 1.00.59. to win the ladies prize, despite the stiff competition.

Surprisingly not many DNS's appeared on the board, riders no doubt feeling obliged to start as 160 entries had to be returned.

"If this is summer, roll on winter," was a remark heard at the finish. Indeed, with high expectations for a crop of PB's, it really was a case of there's always next year!

A cool Westerly breeze with a distinct Autumnal feel to it made for tough conditions on this "sporting" course North of York.

There were no easy bits. Riders had to fight a side wind for most of the way.

The "friendly" rivalry between Brian Haskell (Huddersfield RC) and Geoff Hick (Otley CC) resumed, with Brian being triumphant on the day. He returned a credible 2.12.18 giving him a "plus" of 30.19 to take "fastest on standard". Geoff's 2.10.37 put him in 5th fastest position but he was unable to account for the age advantage of his rival and finished second on standard with +27.16.

A fine ride by Geoff Firth (Bridlington CC) placed him third on standard with +25.02 from a third fastest time of 2.09.21

The fastest time, 2.06.45, was achieved by Kevin Long (Condor RC) and gives an indication of how hard it was. Kevin was also fastest on standard in the "40 to 49" age group with a +18.43.

The Team on Standard Award was a close contest. The verdict going to Otley CC who beat Bridlington CC by about half a minute.

A stiff headwind to the turn with continuous rain throughout the event, resulted in only 39 of the 49 entrants finishing. Junior trike rider Ben Elliott (Macclesfield Whs) had a super ride, along with juvenile A.J.Wilcox (Holme Valley Whs), both recorded personal bests.

PAULINE STRONG, Team Raleigh, made a brave attempt to lower her own RRA Land's End to John O'Groats record earlier this month, but was forced to abandon after 420 miles at Carnforth.

At the time, she was around three hours down on her tight schedule which was set at becoming the first women in history to beat two days for the 840 miles. She still had nearly four hours in hand inside her own record, set in 1990 with 2 days 6 hours 49m. 45s., but a strained tendon in her right leg sealed her fate, proving too painful to allow massage.

Add to that the constant overnight rain which she said "chilled her to the bones" and it was a merciful relief when she eventually stopped after a couple of resumptions following pep talks from husband Alan.

It all started so well as she left from the Land's End Hotel and looked good in the early stages as she was about level with the tight schedule or two or three minutes down. By Exeter (120 mile) she was seven minutes up on schedule and looking well with fine conditions and a slightly helpful breeze. She did the first 25 in 1.7., the 50 in 2.16. and the hundred in 4.47.30.

The dreaded traffic jams in Cornwall meant her support cars hardly saw her until more than 100 miles was done, somewhere around 2pm. after she had started at 9 am. She had the first of her rear wheel punctures on the red Zipp 400 wheel at 3.15. with 130 miles done, not far from the spot where she had crashed and broke a couple of ribs in her previous attempt in June.

Bridgewater (164 miles) on the A 38 and she was 6 minutes up. Soon after 6 pm. on the tough Redhill climb at Bristol she had an attack of "the slows" around 190 miles but got going again over the top.

She was two minutes outside ten hours for the 200 miles and as the light was fading she donned night clothing and switched to her other machine, without tri-bars and fitted with powerful halogen lights.

Passing a sign "Good luck Pauline" on a bridge entering Newport, Glos., she went through Cambridge (Glos) seven minutes down on schedule which included the 8 minutes stop in the caravan for night preparation. By 8.35 pm. on Saturday night it was raining heavily and at Gloucester (231 miles) she had pulled back some time and was only two minutes outside that tight schedule. She did the first twelve hours in 236 miles. At Worcester it was 5 minutes down as the rain persisted. A quick halt for a chicken leg at 11.25pm. marked a third of the way and the target now was to go for the 24 hour record of 446.5 miles, still standing to Eileen Sheridan since 1954.

The 300 miles point was passed in 15 hrs.40mins. At Stafford (302 miles) in heavy rain she missed her turn into a

pedestrianised shopping centre but retraced after escaping a gang of youths who threatened to pinch her bike when she asked directions! Her cars had to go round the town and for a while she was missing but they caught her up after a chase, not realising she had gone ahead. In the pitch black at 1.15.am. she stopped for extra clothing as the rain was having its effect on her body heat. An attack of drowsiness around 2am. (320m) made her get into the back seat of one of the cars for a quick ten minutes sleep.

By Newcastle under Lyme town centre she was 33 mins. down on schedule and at 2.30.am. she passed the sign into Cheshire. Another rear wheel puncture at 3 am, three miles from Holmes Chapel, plus report of a pain in the back of her right knee didn't help.

At Knutsford (341m) the deficit was one hour and a decision was made to call in at the house of Precot Eagle's Ian Murray at Grappenhall outside Warrington which is normally reserved for the helpers to gain relief.

The time was around 4.30.am. and Pauline left at 5 am. after a complete change of clothing and a brief lie down.

The pace was noticeably slow now and at Preston (382m) she had a deficit of 2 hrs. 15 mins., on schedule.

She stopped at Broughton, north of Preston, but resumed after an Alan Strong pep talk but there was no speed there yet. He hoped she would ride out of it.

Over 400 miles have been done but it is now looking desperate!

Another stoop-another pep talk from Alan-and it was noted she had only done 403 miles in 24 hours.

Lancaster bus station at 404 miles and the arrears were approaching three hours. Still, she had another four hours left on the schedule to beat her own record but even Alan Strong had to admit it was all over and at 9.38am., just north of Carnforth at 423 miles he announced over the short wave radio "I am pulling her off."

As long distance cyclists often say at the end of their rides, Pauline issued those immortal words as she lay flat out in a van "Never, NEVER, again" This time I think she means it and she deserves the break after a long and distinguished international career of racing, started when she was 11. Although she is now very much an adopted South Wales resident, Pauline's Merseyside sense of humour has never deserted her and her parting words were "If anyone decides to go for my record I will give them the trophy to save them all that pain I have been through."

DOUGIE IN THE DAY-TIME.

It's three in the morning and I'm awake in bed, worrying. What about, you may ask. Is it because Cynthia is still not back from a night out at Glyndebourne with a 'fellow artist' that toad Magnus? No. It's a deeper problem than that. In fact, it's one that you, dear reader, could well be able to answer. The question is: when, exactly, should I ride my Wolber 18 profile rims? Should they be cherished, as some suggest, hung on the wall for most of the season and merely admired, or can they safely be used for weekly club 10-mile time trials? Verdicts on a postcard, please.

The position is this: you'll remember that I moved up from my trusty-but-heavy Raleigh Flyer recently, coughing up £300 to acquire a second-hand lightweight super job with a hand-built Settle frame, Dura Ace gears, a Rolls saddle and all that malarkey. Well now, this speed-mobile came with two sets of wheels—a pair of Wolber rims and a spare set.

The rear spare is a Mavic GP4 rim on a Campagnolo 'R' motif hub, with six Shimano Dura Ace gears. The front spare is also a 36-spoke job: this time a Mavic OR, also on a Campagnolo 'R' motif hub.

I'm wide awake, restless and unable to sleep. You see half the folk round me advise putting the Mavic rims on for weekly club time trials because they're stronger, getting the Wolbers out only twice a season, to use those rare occasions when I think I might log a personal best. Yet the contrary suggestion thrown at me is to use the Wolber rims every week because they're capable of giving faster times and they'll cope with this rate of use/abuse no bother at all.

So what do you suggest? If Mr

Wolber himself were here right now, the questions I'd like to ask him are: (i) how much faster will I go, over 10 miles, with Wolber Profile rims? (is it two seconds, 12 or 20 seconds? (ii) why are Wolber Profile rims so fragile? Don't think you can now relax because there's more questions to answer. If I was persuaded that the Wolber rims should be cherished, seen in public as frequently as corncrakes in Essex, then what do I do with the two other wheels? The tubs are naf and instead of buying replacements, Max (bless his cotton socks) says I should switch to high pressure tyres right from the start—that would mean writing off my existing Mavic rims and building two wheels round rims made to carry tyres instead of tubs.

It's all very confusing, as I keep telling my lawn-grass is a good confidante, I find. Why are tubs not universal? What is the advantage of high-pressure tyres? Max says it's because they won't puncture if you pick ones with Kevlar skin. Is that right?

Talking about puncture, I've just been made redundant. Even though it's for the third time, it still hurts. Suddenly, the mortgage looms overhead like an ugly giant, as do the other monthly standing

orders—rates, electricity and gas. The worst thing, though is at work. Folk suddenly treat you as if you're invisible. They turn away and walk past without speaking.

into Holme Valley Wheelers. There was Pete Coldwell, Frank Furness, Carl Denver and his two mates from Holmefirth, both hill climbers extraordinaire.

Sunday club runs across to Leek or over to Lancashire saw us settling down to mid-day sandwiches in the back of beyond, over-seen by that knowing soul, (the late) Ronnie Bailey. During the ride, he was always there, easing back to pace newcomers or anyone who ran into trouble and always quick to spot those tearaways who tried to duck their turn at the front on a windy day.

I was naive (still am). I'd been brought up on a diet of country walks and knew about country things: flowers like balsam, milk maid and birdsfoot trefoil. But now the family influence was gone. This was life with the mob. Crusts chewed up, biscuits hurriedly swallowed, out came chalk and the coins.

What followed, I decided, was a boring game. The ha'penny was placed in the middle of the two chalked rings and everyone threw a penny in turn. Anyone with a coin in the inner ring threw for a second time and whoever got the nearest to the ha'penny pocketed the lot.

I wasn't too fussed by it all until Ronnie, stood alongside, whispered the magic words: "You leave it alone, it's illegal." That did it. Next week, I was the first to finish feeding, hands ready with a fistful of pennies.
