Woodburn Wins

The Wessex VTTA Group's Challenge Trophy for its annual 25 is one of the few awards which John Woodburn has failed to win until now, but the 55 year-old Manchester Wheeler made certain of putting his name on it for the first time with a devastating performance on a morning when storm cones were being hoisted along the nearby English Channel and seagulls blown inland were seen flying backwards as they fought in vain to return to their natural habitat.

The headwind finish was especially cruel, with the computer of one rider recording a speed of 5 mph. as he passed the timekeeper's car, visibly rocked by the strength of the wind. Even Woodburn dropped below "evens" at this point, making his time of 58m.53s. a remarkable effort, especially when compared with the runner-up, Alan Dawson (Antelope RT)-he needed another 3m.33s. to complete a revised course being used for the first time to avoid the possibility of disruption on the more familiar A.259 road between Chichester and Bognor Regis, now having a second carriageway added to it.

Fastest time and first on handicap were not Woodburn's only successes in this race. Lady's winner, Betty Kemp (Alton CC) has given a new cup in memory of her late husband, Bob, a former Hampshire RC. chairman and loyal supporter of Wessex veterans events until his sudden death early this year, and Woodburn is the first recipient, as best local group member on standard; he qualifies by virtue of living in the region, at Twyford in Berkshire.

The other notable feature of this event was the record number of non-starters, 54 from an entry of 102.

"I've never known anything like it," exclaimed the organiser, Ken Blowe, whose handicapping separated the top two in this category by only two seconds, with a similar margin splitting the next two. Fortunately, Farnborough & Camberley CC were the best of only three clubs with a minimum of three starters who formed the winning team, after others returned their numbers prematurely, unable to steer in safety with tri-bars fitted. Not surprisingly in these difficult circumstances there was not a disc wheel to be seen!

The weather certainly did not deter the oldest entrant, 76 year-old Lionel Veck (Hampshire RC) from riding not his ex-Portsmouth contemporary, Tony Hemphill, a resident of Tel Aviv for the past thirty years, from taking part either. Now on holiday with his wife, Rose, and about to celebrate 50 years of marriage, this dapper 71 year-old had no intention of ducking out after coming over 2,000 miles from Israel to ride, but he is looking forward to a better morning for his next race, the Border CA 30 near Alton, this Sunday.

"I'm not used to racing in weather like this," he said as he clutched the traditional hot cup of tea in the equally traditional windswept layby chosen for race headquarters-a most inhospitable venue on this occasion.

He also took his team to victory, beating local star Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) by two seconds. Starting five minutes in front of the Salisbury rider, he thought that Paxton would be at a disadvantage on a disc wheel in the gale. After the turn he realised "he might have him on the way back.

Prince who starts at a teacher training college in September claimed to have gone out in 40 minutes, and back in just under 20.

One of the lesser riders was heard to say that on looking at the speed on his computer on the way out, he did not realise you could ride a bike that slow without falling off.

Paxton who only needs to do 257 miles in the Poole Wheelers 12 to move into fourth position on the BAR, a distance well within his grasp, had his problems. A misprint on the start sheet, meant that he arrived late, and had to start without a warm up, or time to put on gloves and arm warmers.

Afterwards he would not concede that it had made any difference, but it must have upset his routine.

from runners up in the Barnstaple Imperial Wheelers promoted Doug Brian Memorial 25 mile 2 up Team Time Trial on the old fashioned S1/25 in the heart of rural Devon.

Peter Shelley combined with team mate Malcolm Steer to beat the strength of Nick Yarworth who rode with Ed Morris. Morris was making a late start to his season and found the pace tough going at times.

Recent surfacing with chippings has made the single carriageway road even more unrelenting, specially for those used to competing on rolled tarmac dual carriageways and many teams finished with times slower than their usual individual efforts.

The day had dawned chilly but near calm with the timber yard's weather vane close to the H.Q. showing a drift from the south west. This was better than expected after the weekend storms and all debris had been cleared from the road. Going out was definitely easier than the return but all finished dry well before the next 'monsoon' struck.

Early leaders on the result board were Colin Lewis and Paul Vincent. They had started number 6 but finished first having battled it out over the closing three miles with the Heron RC. pair of Bob Leach and John Stripp. This was despite Lewis having to contend with his partner's burst of speed as he came through each time.

They held the lead till close to the end when the eventual winners took over and then the last team off took the best composite team prize.

The prizes for almost every conceivable pairing of riders were presented by club Chairman, Norman Patrick who is recovering from a heavy fall in a sponsored charity ride from London to Moscow. The fall over the top of two russians after 750 miles resulted in a broken clavicle, 3 ribs, a punctured lung and a 2 weeks crash course in conversational german in hospital close to the polish border.

Obituary

Trevor Wilkinson died

aged 62 on the 24th of August less than 5 weeks after being told that he had cancer, a diagnosis he accepted with great courage.

He had worked all his life as a surveyor in the mining industry until early retirement in 1986 but most of his spare time was spent cycling.

He joined the Birdwell Wheelers a few months after the Club was formed in 1949 and was soon involved in the administrative side of cycling. Although not "fast" he raced at all distances up to 12 hours, clocking up 216 miles of which he was very proud. Unfortunately the onset of arthritis meant the end of racing but not pleasure cycling.

For his club he served as Racing Secretary, Club Run Captain and Secretary also organising the open 25 and helping in all other club promotions. This dedication was rewarded by life membership in 1970. Local youngsters were also helped by Trevor when he freely gave his time as a National Cycle Proficiency Scheme instructor.

Trevor put countless hours into working for all aspects of cycling both locally and nationally. He gave 31 years dedicated service to the North Midlands Committee of the RTTC, missing just one meeting, the last one when he was in hospital, and always making a valuable contribution to any discussion. He was Vice President of the North Midlands Cycling Federation having run the Pooled Club 50 and then the 25 for more than 30 years and for the last 16 years, the DVCCA 2-up 25 was in his capable hands. A total of nine National Championships including four Hill Climbs and two at 24 hours benefitted from his meticulous attention to detail.

1964 saw the beginning of his timekeeping career, adding handicapping to his repertoire 10 years later. His surveying skills were put to good use ensuring that North Midlands and Yorkshire DC measured miles were accurate.

Initially a member and worker for the Yorkshire Group of the VTTA, he was a founder member of the North Midlands Group in 1980 being Group Recorder until his death.

The BCF North Midlands Division was also part of his life as he was on the Track Committee and officiated at many road races, the annual Track Championships and the City Centre races in Sheffield and Barnsley.

In Yorkshire he served on the C.A.Rhodes Committee for some time as well as timing and handicapping events in that DC.

Further afield he had been part of the Mersey Roads 24 hour event team of helpers for over 20 years, doing sit down feeds, marshalling at all hours of the day and night and latterly by timing on the finishing circuit.

He was also a valued member of the Isle of Man team of officials working quietly and efficiently at both time trials and the BCF events.

As well as all his official duties Trevor still immensely enjoyed riding his bike. He had toured and Youth Hostelled all over Britain, had supported the CTC Birthday Rides for a long time and, until he started to be ill on returning from the Isle of Man at the end of June, was hoping to top his last years total of nearly 7000 miles.

Trevor had only a few distant relatives but was overwhelmed by the number of friends he had in Cycling who gave him such tremendous support with letters, cards and visits in the last few weeks.

He will be very much missed by all of his friends and those who benefitted from his selfless dedication to all things cycling for so many years.

Marshal hurt at Victoria weekend.

Dave Creese, VC Slough's star 40-year-old, has a liking for the old-fashioned, single carriageway, A11-based E1/25A course near Bishop's Stortford.

Paying his third visit on Sunday in as many weeks, he notched another victory in a gale-lashed Victoria CC '25'-part of a week-end of racing well organised by the East London club-when only a third of the filed answered the timekeeper's call.

Experience showed, with Creese and runner up Martin Meades, CC Romford, going back only four minutes or so on recent rides on comparable courses, while the rest of the starters floundered, as much at 10-12 minutes adrift.

Creese's secret was to take things easy on the 13-mile tail-wind run to the first turn, and then to switch on the power into the purgatory of a return trip, using gears as much as 20" lower than lesser mortals-and taking almost a minute a mile out of many.

With the tandem field decimated by torrential rain which added to the difficulties for the early starters in the open '25' as well, it was left to Verulam all-rounder Les Newton to turn in the first respectable time off number 61, his 1.01.40, earning him eventual ninth place.

Yorkshire visitor James Charles, Goole Vermuyden, currently 27th in the BBAR, had the added discomfort of puncturing on the gift-hill start, but persisted to a creditable 1.04.28, while his

sister Rebecca won the ladies award with a fastest 1.15.59.

In the tandem event only CC Breckland's Don Saunders and Geoff Bateman could better Dave Creese's winning solo time, but the long machines had to contend with roads that were awash, making cornering specially difficult.

Whitewebbs CC's consistent Max Williams led vets John Owens and Bill Caton to an unexpected team win with an old-fashioned 3.16.56, winning aggregate.

Someone suggested that every finisher deserves a medal: more to the point it was the members of the promoting club who organise so many events including the Eastway time trial series, and who had been up and about since before dawn on the second day of the week-end in appalling conditions, who really deserve the praise.

It is doubly sad, therefore, to record that one of the marshals in such a well organised Bank Holiday double, suffered a serious injury in carrying out his duties.

Popular Victoria CC clubman Paul Pell was hit by a car when marshalling near the M11 slip road at Stumps Cross roundabout and was taken to Addenbrooke's Hospital near Cambridge.

Paul, aged 34 suffered leg and facial injuries. No bones were broken, but he is likely to remain in hospital for 10 days, and may need skin grafts to his leg injuries. All competitors, especially, will wish him a very speedy recovery.

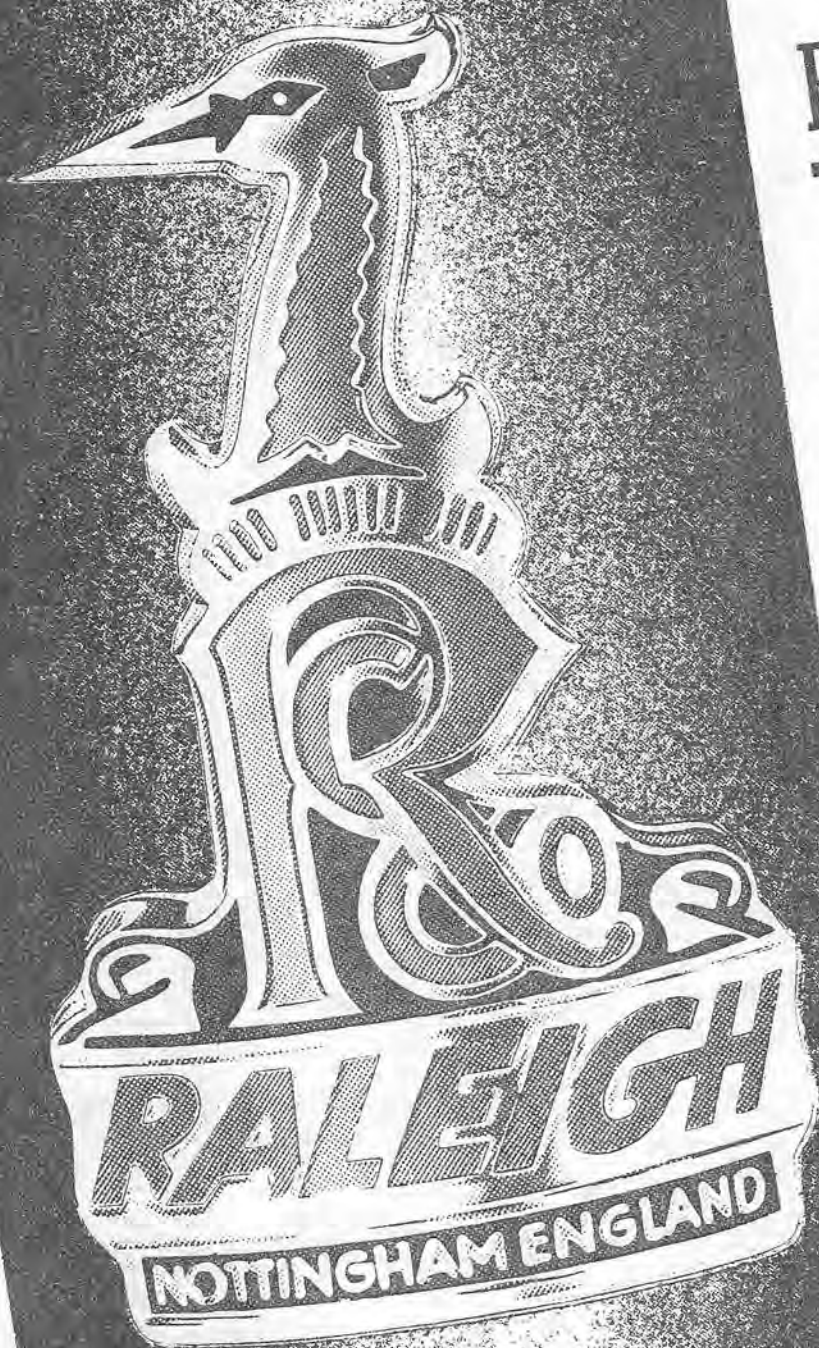
