Harwood's GHS surprize

Brett Harwood a relative "unknown" from the Peterborough CC. became the new G.H.S. Juvenile "10" champion on Saturday, when he pulverised a field of 113 with victory margin of 48 seconds.

Brett, who attends the Deeping Comprehensive School in Market Deeping, near Peterborough, came to Leicestershires newly designed A10/10 course on the A46 with a modest 23.07. in a club event as his "personal", having won his South-East Midlands District Event with a 25.59., so it was not surprising that he wasn't one of the favourites.

But from a start position of number 105, when 14-year-old Welshman Neil Jones appeared to be home and dry, his time of 21.51. an improvement of 1.16., brought gasps from the large crowd assembled beneath the giant result board outside the Thrissington Village Hall.

It was a reasonably pleasant Saturday afternoon for the final with only a light cross-wind to contend with, and most riders seemed happy enough with this fairly new course with its safe left-hand turns throughout.

The early leader was Steven Jackson, Queensbury Upper School, still in his first year of racing, his 22.56. was only 2 seconds away from his "personal" done in the Yorkshire DC event, and when this East Bradford CC. youngster stops smiling and even waving at people as he races, he might become a force to be reckoned with. His lead lasted until Neil Jones arrived at number 40, straight from winning two national track titles just down the road from here, this Abergavenny RC rider took over from Jackson, and, although only 14, and still eligible next year., looked a winner all the way. He also threw down the gauntlet on behalf of his school King Henry V111, who were challenging the holders South Hunsley.

Soon afterwards, Shaftsbury CC's Georgina Pechar, who attends Ingatestone Anglo-Euro School in Essex, streaked over the line for a sparkling "personal" of 24.48. to claim the girl's prize.

But then it was the turn of several riders to be disappointed. London West winner Matthew Barker could only manage 23.37. although he'll be back next year, and South Hunsley's two Adams, Jordan and Hardy, who were in the winning team last year, could only clock 23.17. and 22.55. respectively.

In between, London East winner Jamie Burrow was another who failed to rise to the occasion with 23.14. and then it was John Pritchard's son Ceri's turn. Another of the favourites, he could only equal Jackson's time done 90 minutes earlier. Then, suddenly, came that 21.51. from Harwood, and the result had been turned on its head. Still more damage to the

reputation of the favourites was to follow, as Adam Dallison, a member of the East Surrey RC. produced an improvement of 1.58. to snatch a place on the podium, whilst last-man-but-three Luke Sollit, from St. Bedes RC. High School improved 38 places on last year to claim 4th place.

Neil Jones's late disappointment was soon forgotten when the team calculations were done. Backed by his club-mate James Hayhurst and CC Abergavenny "rival" Robbie Powell, his school took the title from last year's champions by a margin of 1.53. and all three are eligible to defend it next year!

But the day belonged to the modest Brett Harwood, who admitted he hadn't expected to win. In fact this was his first time trial since the end of June, when he became 16. "I've been road racing since I was able to take out a junior licence, so I wasn't too sure how I'd go today. I expected the course to be a bit flatter than it was but it wasn't really too bad. I used gears up to 52 x 15, but no higher-I prefer to pedal. I must thank two people for this though, "he added". Firstly John French of the Manchester Wheelers who lent me a special pair of wheels for the occasion (Disc rear, but normal spoked front, incidentally) and secondly RTTC official Stan Turner, who's always told me to eat lots of beans on toast!

Fastest girl Georgina Pechar had, strangely enough, followed a similarly successful strategy, at least so far as equipment was concerned. "My front wheel was borrowed from Southend & County fast man, Keith Andrewartha, and my rear wheel came from my club-mate Geoff Prince. I'm coached by Jackie Harris, so my thanks go to all of them.

On the subject of equipment, it was amazing to see so many youngsters boasting the latest in modern technology. Almost all used tri-bars, several had rear discs, quite a few sported tri-spokes or similar, and not a few even went to either Campag or Shimano S.T.I-type levers!

The turn out of supporters, including many doting parent was splendid, and the Central District Ladies Cycling Association, who promoted the event on behalf of the Central District Council, were splendid. Jo Hubbard's team were everywhere around the course, which I believe will provide scintillating times on the right day, and they pulled off a nice "coup" in getting Raleigh's local multi-champion Gary Colman to delay his departure for a trip to America, just long enough for him to present the prizes.

Well done Central District Ladies, well done Brett and Georgina, and well done King Henry V111 School of Abergavenny. It was a pleasure to be there and see the stars of the future. Just remember- 8 years ago this event was won by Chris Boardman!

Gethins Brave Challenge

Gethin Butler (Norwood Paragon) is a battler, at his best in tough conditions. Winning the Poole Wheelers' 12 hour race for the second time he needed nine miles more than his winning total in the 12 hour championship to lead the BAR, and he did his best to get them. In spite of a blustery wind that changed direction during the day, and rain that did not let up until the finishing circuits, he got within six miles of the total he wanted. Never letting up all the way round, so low on his bike that he looked like part of the machine.

Conditions were no better for the other 87 entries, hoping that some of the magic of Glenn Longland's 300 miles last year in this event would have rubbed off on them. Most were well below their capabilities.

Afterwards, Gethin said that "he was satisfied with the ride on the day, far better than expected with the weather" adding that "it would have been nice to get in a few more miles."

He has not given up yet, there is still one more hundred and he is going to "give it a real try."

Now finished his university course at Lancaster, he starts teacher training in the Autumn. Comparing the cycling scene with in the North with the South, he says that there are not as many races in the North, but the riders are fitter "because it is so windy."

Second placed Ben Edwards (Clarence Wheelers) aiming for 260 to 270 miles, in the first twelve that he has finished was content with 264, and putting himself in the BAR tables. He found it very hard, but got going over the final miles.

The Clarence boys are after the BAR team race, and Ray Hughes had told them before the event that they all had to finish, but he had to pack after a series of problems, starting with a broken spoke, then a puncture, and finally falling off. He left promising to ride the Eastern Counties 12.

Third placed Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) partly made up for the disappointment of going off course while lying third in the national championship 12. His 260 miles should have moved him up to fourth in the BAR table this week.

He might have gone better on the day in spite of the weather, but fell off in the rain after 15 miles, carrying on with grazes and bruises.

The entry of 88 was good for a 12, with nine none starters, and understandable on the day 23 none finishers. The popularity gives the South DC a problem.. The event is run in September

because of holiday traffic, but the 6.00am. starts means that some competitors start with lights. A later start could mean some finishers getting back to event HQ in the dark.

Restricting the field is one answer, but 30 miles along the coast on the day a mountain bike race had 800 entries before the closing date. Fields of 200 in a triathlon can be seen cycle racing along the same roads as an open time trial, both events oblivious of the other. The interest is there for cycling and returning entire is not catering for it.

There was a keen battle in the Tricycle Association (East) event preceding the Vets '25', CC Breckland's Don Saunders getting home by just over a minute from on-form Eric Marsh.
