## Double Success for Kevin Dawson

**Kevin Dawson** (G.S.Strada) won the **Seacroft Wheelers Open 10** on Saturday and then followed it up by winning the **Clifton CC York Open 50** the next day to complete his week-end double in Yorkshire.

The "Seacroft" 10 using the A168 at Dishforth enjoyed quite good conditions, especially for the second half of the field when the South Westerly breeze, which was fresh for the early riders, abated.

Even early on some good times were achieved. **Wayne Thorpe**(Selby CC), off at number 40, recorded a PB of 22 minutes dead. Number 50, **Malcolm Davidson**(Morley CC) with a time of 22.03 took the 1st Vet on Standard Award with a +5.43.

The fastest Junior was **P.A.Waddington**(Bradford Wheelers) who started mid-field and recorded a fine 22.02.

First inside "22" was the Fastest Juvenile (off at Number 106) **R.Newman**(Askern CC), who returned in 21.55 - which was 5th fastest overall. Then **Steve Vaughan**(Morley CC) stormed over the line in 20.52 to give him the lead - but not for long. **Rob Krygsman**(Goole Vermuyden) was 8 seconds faster in 20.44 and then we waited for last man off Kevin who put the issue beyond doubt with his winning time of 20.17.

**Sally Boyden**(Askern CC) was fastest Lady with a time of 23.17.

The Tandems had the strongest winds to contend with as they preceded the Solo Event.

The Scratch pairing of **S.Plester and M.Hepton** (Mapperley CC) were fastest with 21.33 - just 8 seconds quicker than the Sheffield Phoenix crew of **A.S.Payne and E.Stephenson**(21.41).

A good ride by "mixed" pair **Steve Brown**(East Bradford CC) and **Cheryl Trueman**(Calder Clarion) put them into 3rd place with a time of 22.55.

Heavy overnight rain accompanied by strong blustery winds just cleared in time for the **Clifton CC "50"** to enjoy relatively quiet and dry weather - although many riders complained of feeling cold. Wet roads also caused a fair number of punctures.

Based at Wetherby the Course had a first leg to York and back before joining the A1 to turn North of Boroughbridge.

There were hopes of a "float" day early on but the air was too cold for that and also a breeze developed from the South West which mostly affected the middle of the field riders on the final return leg.

A significant number of competitors failed to start, the most notable being **Gethin Butler** - so we never witnessed the battle of the giants but there was much speculation as to what **Kevin Dawson** would do on the day.

Altogether there were 16 riders inside 2 hours - first back was

**N.A.Cleminshaw**(Hull Thursday) who set the standard by recording 1.59.53. **R.Wilson**(Huddersfield RC) soon lowered the mark with a 1.56.27 which was not bettered until number 50, **M.J.Bowes**(Cleveleys RC), put in a time of 1.55.45 earning him 4th position.

We had to wait until the return of **Kevin Dawson**(G.S.Strada) for any further improvement and as per expectations Kevin did it in style with a fine 1.48.43.

Third place was taken by Number 116 **P.J.Dentith** (Stockport Clarion) with 1.54.03 but a strong ride by **Gareth Metcalfe** (Otley CC), off at number 120, put him into the second slot.

**Christine Roberts**(Crewe Clarion) was fastest lady with a time of 2.3.07 with **Sally Boyden**(Askern CC) just 2 minutes adrift in 2.5.08. **Elaine Ward**(Scarborough Paragon) and **Margaret Allen**(Askern CC) did not finish.

The Team Award was won by the promoting club led by **Paul Musgrave** whose time of 1.58.52 was a "personal". He was backed up by **Tim Rose**(2.1.43) and **Ray Johnson**(2.6.19)

## Longlands Good Win

This long established event which has often provided BBAR. contenders with late season improvements in the past had a new trophy for the winner this year, to perpetuate the memory of one of the promoting club's two former national 100 mile champions, **Ken Whitmarsh**, who died a year ago, and it was appropriate that the other ex-champion, **Jon Baylis**, was there, as a marshal, to see another former champion, **Glenn Longland** (Antelope RT) win the award.

Since he climbed off in his abortive attempt to add the national 24 hour title in June, Longland has set his sights on becoming the first winner of a cup bearing the name of the man who prepared so many of his record breaking schedules, and though a recent run of second placings suggested he might be beaten again on this occasion there was never any doubt once the race was under way that the South of England's leading time trialist was going to win at the expense of last year's runner-up, **Clive Brooks** (Polytechnic CC) who was second again.

Although neither these two nor the other seeded riders in a disappointing low entry of 55 could match the record times achieved on a better morning and a faster course last year, Longland recalled some of his past glories by finishing in a class of his own, his time of 1.51.54. leaving Brooks over three minutes in arrears.

The South DC's new B.A.R. champion, **Lee Paxton** (Salisbury RC) was even more comprehensively beaten after taking nearly two hours for the distance, but he gained some consolation, moving up two places on a year ago and just getting the better of **Derek Cottington** (Charlottesville CC) another national star from the past showing no signs of losing his enthusiasm for the sport.

Main topic of conversation at race headquarters-a factory canteen made available by Andover Wheelers promoter, **Bob Smith**-was the weather; it was another wet morning which stopped all but one rider from improving his line 3 figures on entry forms, and the benefits of this accommodation enabled the organising club to display the new £600 cup, but members left with one question unanswered.

The Andover course was chosen in preference to the faster roads across the New Forest on which Longland established a race record of 1.43.51., to comply with a new district rule insisting on events on roads around Ringwood to be finished by mid-morning. Earlier starting times enable other clubs to meet this requirement in mid-season, but it's not practicable to call the first man to the line before 7.a.m. at this time of year. A full entry could have been accepted at Andover but because it lacks the speed potential of Ringwood based courses only 55 wanted to ride this year, and that number could have been accommodated on the New Forest course.

## Fodden 1 sec Win

Veteran Mark Fodden (Bournemouth Arrow CC) from Portland, takes some beating on his home ground the Warmwell 10 mile course, but he was driven very close by junior William Grainger (Andover Wheelers) in the Bournemouth Jubilee Saturday afternoon event.

It was Mark's sort of day. Very fast out, with a headwind that had everyone out of their saddle after they negotiated the roundabout at the turn. He is one of those strong riders that just enjoy smashing into a head wind.

With a margin of one second the seventeen year old almost had Mark. The secret of his success was that he was preparing for the national junior 10 mile championship the next day.

He did not think it would harm him racing before an important event saying, "I ride better when I have ridden the day before."

William "Don't call me Willy, my mother does not like it" has just started work in the last three weeks and has been concentrating on speed training, about 100 miles a week.

Mark Fodden who takes a lot of interest in the latest training techniques, particularly the methods used by triathletes listened with approval, giving some words of advice of his own.

This was the first open placing for young William, who has been putting in a few 22s on his home course, but he appeared unaware that he had almost topped the local specialist at 10 miles.

Ivan Prince (Bournemouth Jubilee Wheelers) the expected challenge to Fodden, at nine seconds was not far behind. Happy enough to have shaken a disastrous 12 hour for him the week before, out of his legs.

Fourth rider eighteen year old John Samways (Bournemouth Jubilee Wheelers) second in the national junior mountain bike championship a few weeks before, was still smarting at not having been selected for the world championship in Canada this week, and this may have affected him.

## Woodburn again

The new record of 58m.53s. established on a revised course near Chichester by John Woodburn in the Wessex VTTA 25 two weeks ago was broken three times in this Battle of Britain Memorial Race, but by the end of the event there was no change of identity in the new holder. Another veteran, Alan Dawson (Antelope RT) was the first to improve the old record, clipping five seconds off Woodburn's previous time, before his clubmate Peter Pickers, up dated that effort by well over a minute, but his position at the top of the result board was even more shortlived, with Woodburn pushing him down one place less than ten minutes later.

He had gained 43 seconds on Pickers for a winning ride of 56m.24s. overtaking his minute man, Graham Childs (Portsmouth CC) the only other sub-hour man, and Ted Reddick (VC St. Raphael) who was sixth, on the day. No stranger to events on southern roads, he was a clear winner of the veterans on standard award too, and is clearly enjoying his racing now that he is no longer enduring the pressures of the BBAR, which has influenced his riding for so many seasons.

After three punctures during the course of the day, Richard Hills and Mike Johnson's bad luck still continued when they were knocked off their machine, by a car just 1.25 miles from the finishing circuit, after receiving on the spot treatment, they pushed their tandem trike to the circuit so they could record a distance.

## Clarence Whs Success

Last week's West London CA event was blessed with perfect conditions and the riders in this event were hoping for a repeat of the same. It was not to be and any chance of ultra fast times disappeared with a strong south westerly wind. Ron Keeble was an early starter, and after reaching the 14 mile turn in 30 mins.22secs., recorded a time of 51mins.53secs., over 2 mins. down on his previous weeks 49mins.20secs. Dave Redding starting off no 15, took the lead with 51mins.28secs. a personal best by some 2mins. His turn time was 29mins.48secs.

Fastest to the 14 mile turn was Peter Main with 28mins. 58secs. Having recorded a '48' the previous week, he too slipped away to finish with 51mins.25secs...., nearly 3 minutes down on his best time.

Most riders who had ridden the West London event fell back, an exception was Keith Reed who improved to 50mins.42secs to take second place ahead of John Pritchard. The Pritchard family had a notable result in that 14-year-old Ceri recorded a personal best time of 53.41. possibly a National Juvenile record.

The winning time of 50.29. was recorded by Ray Hughes who showed that he has plenty of speed in his legs following his previous weeks effort in the Poole Whs 12 hour which ended in retirement at 100 miles with a wrecked front wheel following a blowout.

The Juniors, Juveniles, Dads and Coaches from the City Road Club, Hull travelled down to register an impressive haul of prizes and personal bests. Adam Hardy took the junior award with a personal best 55.36. Dad, Paul Hardy not to be outdone improved 4 minutes to 58.19. to take second handicap. The youngest rider in the field also from City Road Club, 13-year-old Gavin Baker improved over 4 minutes to take first handicap. The unluckiest Hull rider was 15-year-old Adam Jordan who having reached the turn in 32.19. proceeded to circle the large turn roundabout twice losing over 40 seconds in the process. He still recorded a time of 56.47.

Pauline Strong recorded the fastest ladies time with 59.00. to underline she has more than long distance stamina and husband Alan, placed cunningly one minute ahead of Pauline, got the message and recorded a '56'.

Lastly, 80-year-old Jim Sibun proceeded to show that you cannot keep a good man down by clocking 1.05.28. for a new national age standard of +23.26.

### Creese in good form

It took Dave Creese (VC Slough) just under 12 hours to get in his winning Autumn groove, when the stylish 40-year-old aeronautical engineer splashed his way around the L-shaped A45/A10 based F2A course to a 2.30sec. win over all-rounder John French (Manchester Wheelers) with Alan Newark the Ely and Dist CC veteran continuing a late-season purple patch in third place, only a further 13 seconds in arrears.

With last man off Ian Cammish a non-starter (reportedly in Tenerife on a spur-of-the-moment holiday) the spotlight on Creese and French seeded 10 and 20 min ahead on the card respectively.

Both had raced the previous day, Creese following his 48-minute winning ride the previous week, with a short 51 in the Luton Arrow event (won by Stuart Dangerfield) while French, currently sixth in the BBAR table warmed up with a 50-minute two-up with Eddie Adkins in the Rutland CC event.

Fenlander French, returning to racing with a flourish, is on the start card of next week's last gasp Nth. Middx and Herts CA '100' on neighbouring roads.

Kings Lynn CC had a field day. They packed four riders in the top 20, winning both first and second team prizes. Maurice Minchin led the way taking fourth place in 57.31, backed by Mark Adams (57.54) and Ian Brown (59.51). The runners-up trio of Messrs S Howlett, 1.00.12. S.May. 1.02.30. and B.Williamson 1.05.13, had a three-minute margin on third placed Verulam CC led by consistent Ian Brazier.

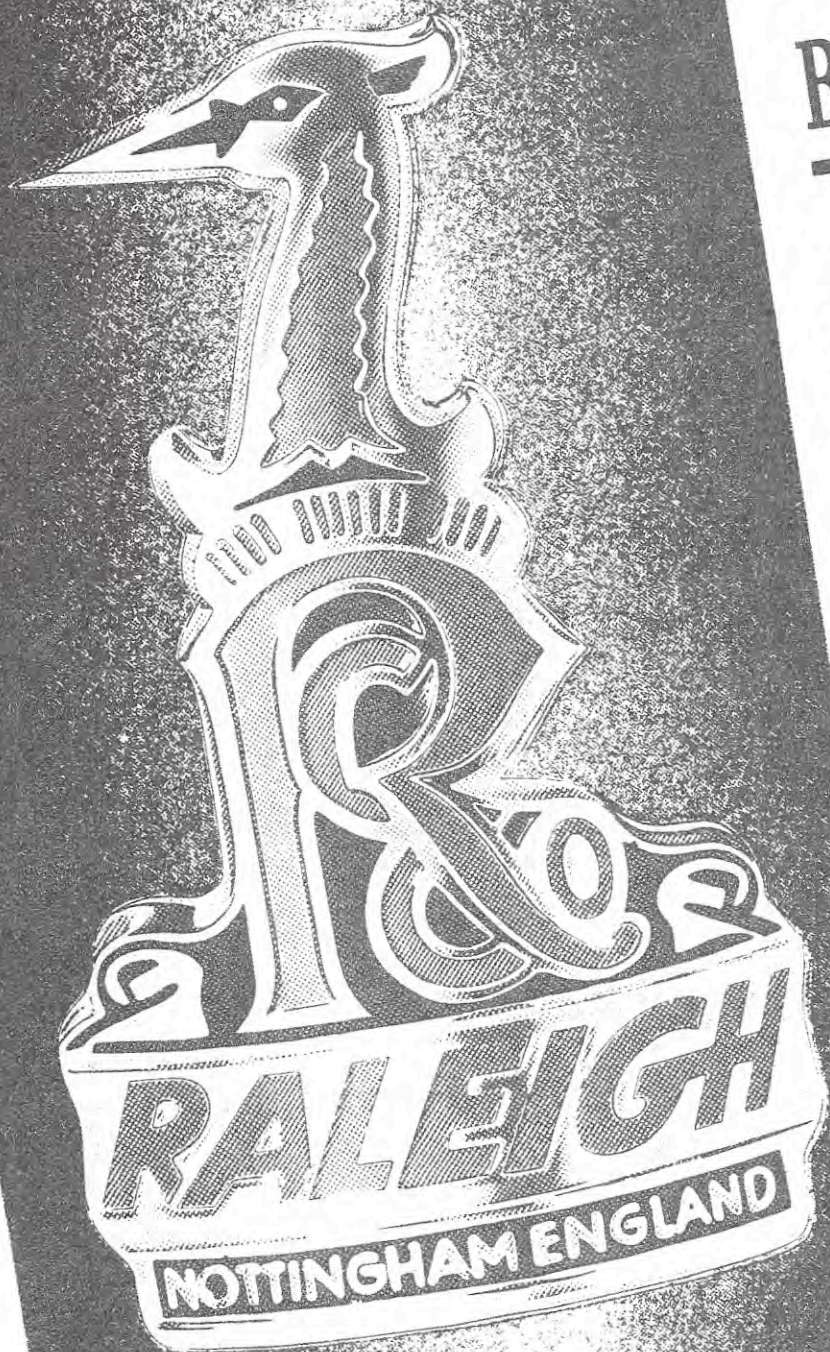
