Adkins has two and half minute win

Always a popular event, the West Vets Autumn 25 is usually the last opportunity for a ride on the fast A34-based H25/14/ Consequently, the event is always well subscribed, and being on an earlier date than usual, with a field limit of 120 riders, ninety-one aspirants had their entries returned.

The seven o'clock start saw early riders groping their way up to the start in half-light conditions, but by the off, visibility had improved.

It soon became apparent that the conditions could favour some fast times, with a light southerly drift helping riders to the Botley turn. The final result proved this, with Eddie Adkins 51.03. being within seconds of the course record, and only 1.24. short of his PB. Shay Giles, Leo RC finished well for second place with 53.37. Dave Barnes "up from Somerset" riding to within 3 seconds of his PB, took third spot. The first ten riders beat 56 minutes.

On standard, Pete Smith, Norwich ABC, looking about 55 but claiming a 69 year standard, netted a massive plus of 23.16. beating the 80-year old pocket rocket Jim Sibun, Willesden CC by 3.12. and there aren't many who can do that!

There was such discussion around the board, largely centred on the speculation that had this been the H25/13b a "48" would have won it. Well, that's as maybe, and there is a growing body of opinion that the "13b" represents a course that was "engineered" to create ultra-fast times.

Two miles downhill to start and traffic counts that would not be out of place on the LA freeway. Still, that's Time Trialling, 90s-style.

There were at least 20 riders who went away with line 2 improvements, and the fact that 52 riders beat the hour speaks volumes for the very high standard of veterans racing.

Lastly, with 91 entries returned, it saddened the organiser to see that 12 riders did not start, with so far only four apologies. Do I hear that old refrain "what about reserve lists in time trials"??

Ray Hughes probably clinched the Team BAR for the Clarence Wheelers with an excellent winning ride of 274.71 miles in the ECCA 12 hour promoted by Bill Thorncroft (Essex Roads CC) on behalf of the association. The conditions were chilly but calm and misty early on, turning into a warm day. Len Benton won the veterans award with a plus of 62.2 miles.

The course used on Sunday, with some minor adjustments, will be used by the ECCA for the 1993 championship event which they will be promoting.

Ray Smith led the Essex Roads CC team to triumph, Ray who was 5th overall with 240.60. miles led the way, supported by Steve De-Cruz and Dave Griffiths who recorded 225 miles and 215.20 miles respectively. The result is subject to confirmation.

Almost still conditions "looked" ideal for the flat but open course which was first used for the National Championship 50 last year. However, most riders found it difficult to generate speed, finding the going "sluggish." A rising light South Westerly breeze did not help, as it made the last leg into the wind a bit of a drag.

From a field of 78 only 15 beat 2.10.00 and only 2 riders were inside 2 hours. There were, however, four 2.00's which might have been "inside" rides had it not been for the hardish finishing leg.

C.Simpson (Yorkshire Road Club), off at number 20, was the first man back inside 2.5.00 with a time of 2.3.30.

A good ride by M.Bragan (Calder Clarion) saw him cross the line in 2.00.18 which was to earn him 3rd fastest in the event and 1st on handicap.

It wasn't until Julian Read (Goole Vermuyden), number 70, returned in 1.59.18 that the 2 hour barrier was broken.

The Event was won by "in form" Gareth Metcalfe (Otley CC). His 1.55.35 was over 3 minutes slower than his 2nd place ride last week in the Clifton CC 50.

Mickie Salter (Clifton CC) also slowed from the previous week but only by 2 minutes. Her time of 2.26.54 won her the fastest lady award.

D.W.Robinson (Rockingham CC), who was 6th overall in the Event, led his Club to Team victory with a 2.00.36 supported by J.Laxton (2.8.58) and N.Day (2.11.44).

Dangerfield again

Stuart Dangerfield's impressive run of form continued with a convincing win in the Doncaster Wheelers 25.

It was a debut appearance for the Leo RC flyer on the Blythe course, but his unfamiliarity wasn't apparent as he not only broke course and event record, but handed out a sound thrashing to the likes of Geoff Platts, Mark Grantham and Chris Myhill.

It was a remarkable ride on the day, which although appeared to be conducive to fast times, turned out to be tough going. Many riders agreed that it was a "heavy" day with no easy sections on the course.

It was Simon Day (Delta RT) who set the early standard with 54.53. This stood the test of time and was beginning to look good until Chris Myhill (Dinnington RC) clipped 5 seconds off, to go top. Myhill complained of "not being able to get going", no doubt attributable to a reduced mileage diet enforced by a new teaching career.

Myhill's reign at the top was much briefer than Days' as eight minutes later Geoff Platts (Coalville Whs) stormed in with a super 52 minutes ride. This was yet another stunning ride from a man whose talent and form simply never wanes. The quality of this latest ride was soon confirmed when Mark Grantham (Morley CC) failed to dislodge Platts from the top spot by a scant 5 seconds.

After a disappointed 1991 season, Grantham is once again a force to be reckoned with, and this latest ride, coming the day after a 53 minute effort on the Coastways course, underlines this mans talent.

Shortly after Granthams appearance, however, all of the previous rides paled into insignificance, Stuart Dangerfield roared up to the Blythe Nornay roundabout and launched himself into a sprint which any international road man would have been proud of.

The young man from the West Midlands was simply in a class of his own-the mind boggles at what he will achieve when he matures a couple more years.

Another course record, another event record, another weekend.

54 year old Tony Page (Rockingham Forest Wheelers) set the standard with a stunning ride of 57.30 on the difficult Towcester to Milton Keynes 25-mile time trial course.

On a morning which promised so much but delivered so little Tony was one of a clutch of veterans that dominated this final time trial of the Northants & District CA programme.

With Steve Brooks (Team Chiltern) only 18 seconds adrift in second place, and Les White (North Bucks Road Club) in fifth place-the race was certainly a gift for the older riders.

The course used was the N5/25a which takes in the Milton Keynes dual carriageway, the A5D, on which the local police are set against cycling, let alone time trialling. Yet this race was run in near traffic free conditions leaving the riders wondering what all the fuss is about when they felt so safe.

Brooks and Pritchard Andover wins

West Country star, Clive Brooks (Polytechnic CC Air Canada) ended a run of second placings in great style at Andover, taking forty seconds off the old course record of 52m.45s. set by John Pritchard when he won the national championship 25 four years ago, to win Andover Wheelers 25 in a startling 52.5.

Pritchard's old record had been beaten forty minutes earlier when Glenn Longland (Antelope RT Radford Accountants)-no.60 on a card of 111 riders-raced out to Popham and back in a most impressive 52.19. Many reckoned that was going to be quite fast enough to win until Brooks' dramatic arrival and that left onlookers wondering if former competition record holder, Gary Dighton (Manchester Wheelers) could go any faster.

He started ten minutes after Brooks, but that gap grew to more than eleven minutes by the time Dighton finished, in 53.32.-a time which gave him third place and earned him the first Weyhill Fair award. This was a new prize underwritten by former London based time trialists, David and Janet Rayner, now the hosts of a local pub who provided the purse for overall classification on this race and a 10 also promoted by Andover Wheelers at Thrupton on the previous afternoon.

In the absence of Longland, winning the tandem race with Neville Stroud, and Brooks, it was a little ironic that this event was won by the old 25 mile course record holder, Pritchard (Express RT) but he did not return for Sunday's encounter. Last of 113 solo entrants to start, Pritchard pushed Dighton into second place by six seconds, with Nick Yarworth (Cwmearn Paragon) a further ten seconds away in third place.

Few of the competitors were aware of the extra prizes for combined times in the two events until the start sheets dropped through their letter boxes, but the sponsors were delighted by the enthusiasm generated by this incentive and plan to repeat the innovation next season, but for the moment the promoting club's junior, William Grainger, has this year's times to savour throughout the winter months, after breaking his own club 25 mile record by nearly two minutes.

THE 'PHONE THAT NEVER STOPPED RINGING'

There was no doubt about it, the voice at the other end of the telephone was elated. It had every reason to be, for it had just told me that Ralph Dadswell had knocked 49 minutes off the R.R.A. Lands End to John O'Groats tricycle record previously held by Eric Tremaine in 2 days 6 hours 18 minutes 35 seconds.

The news came from the telephone information centre manned by John and Ann Dadswell. Their brief had been one that, over the years, has become vital to long distance record breaking. Not only did it keep up a regular supply of news to the many interested people along the route, but it was more than helpful to the many official observers and checkers. These checkers and observers have a lonely vigil, often in remote places, and the fact that news is available saves many a long wait and sometimes a futile mission. It is also helpful to the supporters with the attempt for they can 'phone back for any requirements of equipment and food; these in turn can be laid on in advance of the rider.

It is a detached experience being at the end of a telephone. It is not so bad to start with for everyone is fresh and news comes back regularly. On an End to End, with a favourable starting wind, if often means advances on schedule and this in itself boosts morale. It is later on when the pressure begins to tell. A reference to the schedule suggests that an update is overdue. Anxieties creep in, Has something gone wrong?

Then the vital call arrives. All is well....and even if it isn't you are not told!

I have, on several occasions, experienced both facets of the End to End scene.

Report of The Eastern Counties Cycling Association AGM.

The past year has resulted in a loss of just over £800, this being mainly due to the racing account. The provision of race headquarters where possible has resulted in a considerable expense. The meeting was told of the increase in entry fees for the 1993 season, in an attempt to contain the losses. The ECCA Festival, held over the May Bank Holiday, also costs a lot of money and its format may need to be revised in the future.

The proposal by the Shaftesbury CC that preference for entries in time trials be given to those clubs whose delegates attend the AGM was defeated.

The motion was an attempt to stimulate more delegates into attending the AGM.

Alan Osborne (Redbridge CC) was elected President and George Shakespeare (Shaftesbury CC) was elected as Chairman. In taking over the presidency, Alan Osborne gave thanks and paid tribute to the many years of service from Bill Thorncroft (Essex Roads CC) who this year has relinquished the posts of General Secretary and President. The new General Secretary is Tim Davis (Victoria CC).

Under any other business proposal was put forward, for the 1993 AGM, that each of the 96 affiliated clubs should provide, in rotation, an event secretary for one of the 26 events promoted by the ECCA each year. This proposal may well stimulate more clubs to send delegates in 1993.

I have manned a telephone information centre and I have been with the support team to the End. As a consequence I can understand the problems that are created. The support team can be involved in a minor crisis, a telephone box is not readily found or, as in some cases does not work, and it is so easy to forget to send back information in the drama of a tense situation. The people on the 'phone get frustrated. Occasionally there is light relief, as I recall on one occasion when a caller rang to insist that I owed him some money. It took a little time and patience to persuade him that he had got a wrong number.

I used to keep a log of all the calls and, in later years, because of the interest the attempts generated (often in excess of 500 calls) it was very interesting to look back on.

The other evening I cast my mind back on how it all began.

In 1949 Bert Parkes of the Mersey Roads Club went for the tricycle End to End. In those days petrol was scarce and motor cars were not so numerous. Thus Bert had to ride on his own for long periods. It was essential to make sure the checks were made in order to prove the record. It was also vital that food and drink was available where it was needed.

I arranged, along the route, a long chain of helpers who were asked to provide checks and hand up specified food and drink. In order that they could be at their posts in time they were asked to ring in for news of progress, and then, when Bert had passed to ring again and tell me. It worked remarkably well....there were no S.T.D. systems in those days, and making a long distance call was a real round the houses job.

In the ensuing years the whole system of the telephone information system has become more sophisticated. There are following cars and overtaking cars to replace the static checker and feeder, telephoning is easier and quicker, and now, of course, there is the mobile telephone. Thus the whole system changed from one whose sole objective was to provide support for the rider's needs to virtually a continuous information service.

None the less it still needs people to man the telephone, and to this day that means over 48 hours of continuous presence at a 'phone.

It is a detached experience away from all the drama and suspense of being with the rider--and those who have experienced the second night of an End to End on the road will know what I mean--But it is a vital job and those who do it can feel with some pride that they have been a crucial part of the organisation.

Although you don't know it at the time, for you are in sublime ignorance of what is happening along the route, the real stories come out when all have returned from John O'Groats. It is then that you realise what could have happened but did not, and what did happen and was covered by many odd and dramatic circumstances.

It all recedes into the past and you are left to recollect the experiences in the aura of sweet success. Some of the tales get better for the telling; there is no harm in that, and the less agreeable ones are quietly consigned to oblivion.

What is more the helpers see imaginary sheep on the road in the dark for weeks afterwards, and the telephonists hear a ringing telephone when it isn't ringing at all.
