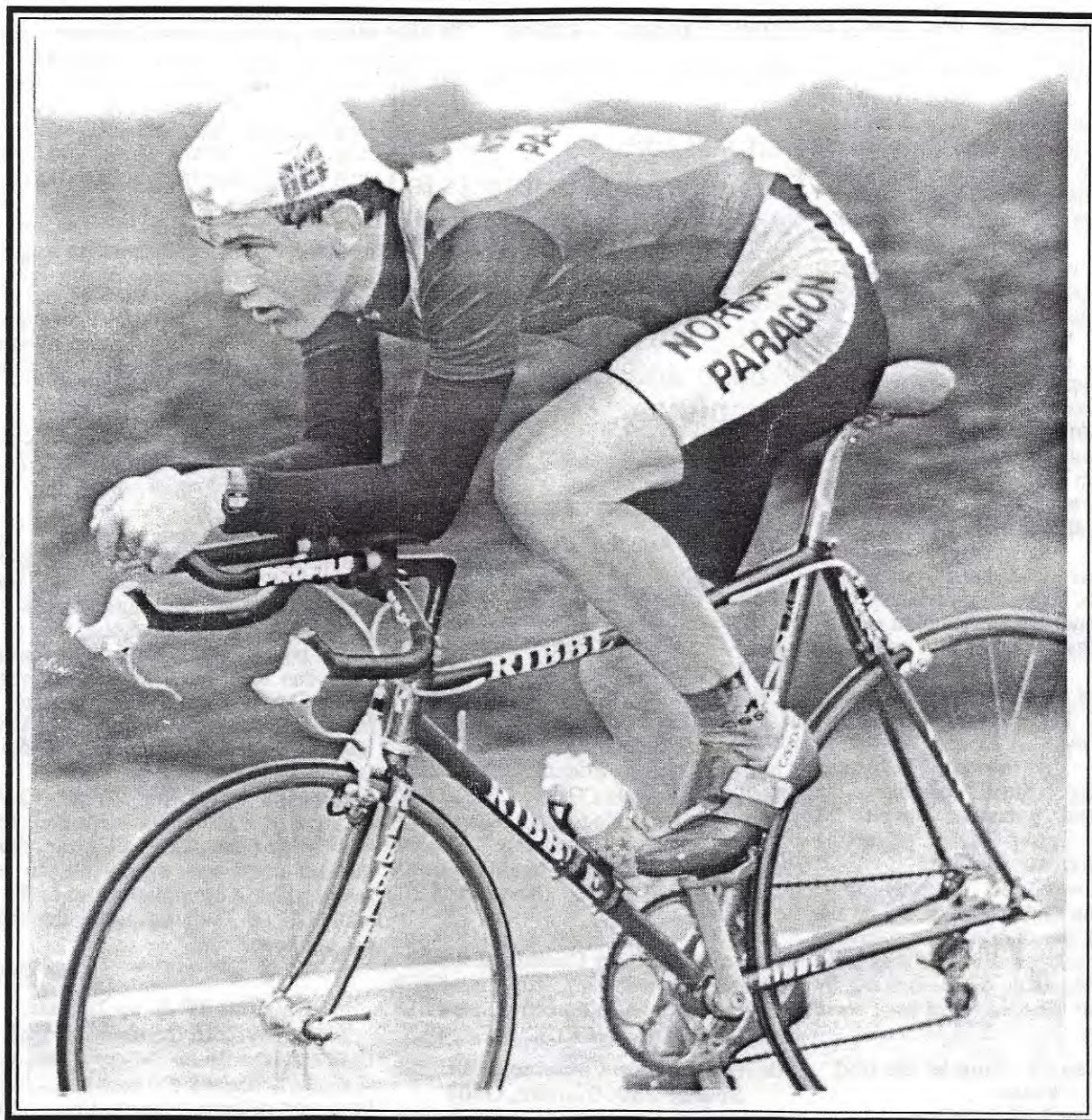

Rother Valley CC Tour of the Lod Valley.

When Rother Valley CC. introduced the 24 mile Tour of the Lod Valley to the time trial calendar four years ago the club's organiser, David Collard-Berry of Fernhurst, described it as the Sussex version of the race on fallen leaves, but added hazards to the circular course lay partly hidden for this year's event.

Strong winds and overnight rain brought dozens of acorns and conkers down with the leaves, and they made a detour introduced at short notice to avoid road works in Petworth particularly hazardous but failed to stop Clarence Wheeler, Stewart House, from racing to his third consecutive win in this event.

Not surprisingly, he could not match the speed which set the race record of 57m.42s. a year ago, but though he took sixty-one seconds longer to complete the course before puncturing just after crossing the finishing line he extended his winning margin to over two minutes this time.

Not so lucky was Mark Sinnott (Festival RC) who stopped for a wheel change by race headquarters a mile short of the finish-a delay without which he might have snatched second place from Peter Pickers (Antelope RT) Third of four who beat the hour last year, Pickers was nearly two minutes slower but one place better, by four seconds from clubmate, Alan Dawson, who achieved a season's ambition to beat fellow veteran, John Woodburn (Manchester Wheelers) at the final attempt.

"That should have been decided on standard times- I would have beaten him then," the former multi-champion said as the two chatted happily together afterwards.

At the other end of the age range, Farnham RC junior, Barry Robinson, completed a most successful season in this category, by starting fifth and finishing first after passing the first "man" and youngest entrant, 15 year-old Dean Corney of the promoting club, four miles from the finish.

The latter was one of only three members of the Rother Valley CC on the start sheet; all the club's other members were on marshalling duties, and they hope that by bringing their event forward by two weeks next year they will have more than 49 entries.

Adkins-French End Wheelers connection with victory.

It was a pity that the weather spoiled the end-of-term atmosphere at Sunday's Hainault RC 2-up '28'. Spectators (and not just a few starters) were treated to the spectacle of Manchester Wheelers' pairing Eddie Adkins and John French producing a performance of great class in claiming victory in their last outing in red, white and blue jerseys-the club losing its sponsor at the end of the year-and many of its top riders, to boot.

Their 1.06.07 was the only 25 mph effort of the day, and it opened up a 3.1/2 minute gap on nearest challengers, Martin Meades and John Whitehead, (CC Romford). But the real winner was the weather, with gale-force winds and flooded roads, fallen branches and a gritty ride through narrow lanes, which make up a third of this sporting E84 course.

Consolation for the promoting club, at the end of a memorable year of race organiser including the women's national 10-mile title race, came in the form of veteran pairing Mick Burrow and Terry Anderson, both 52, who set the standard from numbers 29 and 30 in a 100-strong field, with 1.10.42. and hung on to third at the end.

Former 25-mile competition record holder Burrow seems physically incapable of going slow, while Anderson, now a full-time bikie, was winding up a memorable year.

With fancied teams like Glen Taylor and Mick St Ledger (Leo RC), and Nick Gritton (Sydenham Whs) and Renny Stirling (Leo RC), puncture victims, some lesser-knowns got near the top of the finish board. Father and son Magnasport CRT duo Rod and Nick Hewes were in the top half dozen, and veterans Ken Minting (from the '60s Crescent CC team line-up) and Alan Siggers (Maldon & District CC), finishing 11th.

Women's BBAR Sue Wright (Chelmer CC) really was on home ground, riding with Mick Gray (Crest CC), but showed that her mind was already on the social season, after a triumphal return to the top, with 1.21.08., still salvaging the mixed-pairing prize.

KNARESBOROUGH CC PRO-AM HILLY '29'

The ever-green Pete Longbottom, GS Strada, continued his winning ways on a hilly course to the West of Ripon in North Yorkshire, by claiming top spot for the second time in Knaresborough CC's Dunlopillo Classic.

With two wins and two second places behind Chris Boardman in the last four years, he's become a popular sight at this invitation event, although he had to be really on his mettle this time to stay clear of the pack.

Heavy overnight rain and muddy country lanes threatened to make conditions treacherous, but fortunately the sun came out to dry the roads by the time the event began. 41 riders had accepted invitations to ride this popular event, with its generous prize list from Dunlopillo, yet in the end only 28 started, and three of those were destined not to complete the course.

The early leader was new BBAR Kevin Dawson, off number 10 and second man to finish. Not normally a 'hilly' devotee, he warmed to the task to set a good standard in the cold and breezy conditions.

10 minutes later, Welsh '50' champion Matt Postle, who'd been 39 seconds up on Dawson going through the finish point to begin the last 5-mile loop, came back again to pip Dawson by 41 seconds.

But just before he finished, Stuart Dangerfield had gone through to start his last five miles with an even faster intermediate time.....58-29 to Postle's 59-42, and sure enough, less than quarter-of-an-hour later he was back to record 1.13.16.....a clear 1.42 faster than Postle.

But the drama was building still higher, because, just before Dangerfield finished, the gallery had seen Longbottom roar through at 5 to go in a time of 57-44.....45 seconds better than Dangerfield. Soon enough, he was back again to finish with 1-12-40....good enough to win, although he'd lost a little bit of time to Dangerfield on those last five energy-sapping miles.

Had there been a team prize, Dinnington Road Club would have won it by a mile, but all three of their top men were in the prizes anyway, and they were also able to cheer their number one supporter Dave Marsh, who took the veteran's award.

Comments about the course....first used last year....and based on the village of Sawley not far from Fountains Abbey, were favourable. Longbottom said "It's a bit tricky, but I think I'm getting used to it."

Dunlopillo Marketing Manager Simon Williams presented the prizes at Sawley Village Hall, and assured hard-working organiser Keith Thompson that his company would be back again in 1993. I bet Pete Longbottom will be too!

Lawn beats Dodd

1992 saw the Catford CC promote its 97th open hill climb. The venue, as for recent years, was the G302 Yorks Hill course, the weather was fine, dry and still, unlike five years ago when gales resulted in the felling of many trees rendering Yorks Hill totally inaccessible.

The hardy few set about tackling this tough climb with the first two placings being the same as last year with T.J.Lawn (Kingston Wheelers) winning in a time of 1.56.5. and G.L.Dodd (Kingston Phoenix RC) taking second place in 2.00.8. Third place went to the Catford CC's own rider J.D.Watson with a time of 2.11.9.

The winning team was the Catford CC with an aggregate time of 7.15.18 The team was led home by third placed rider J.D.Watson, who was joined by M.A.Cope 2.33.5. and J.F.Green 2.31.4.

There were fewer riders than usual; this year but there was an increase in the number of MTB's and the winning mountain bike rider was P.A.Elliott (Gemini BC) with a time of 2.39.1. Unlike recent years there no lady riders in 1992.

Race organiser Ian Kitt informs us that mountain bike riders are very welcome in his event and there is a separate prize list for them and he hopes to see an increase in their numbers next year.

Bray's record

It's not often the Sussex C.A.Hill Climb has attracted entries from outside the county and until G.S.Stella took over its promotion three years ago the future of the event looked in doubt but this year's race was given an unexpected boost by the presence of Britain's senior road champion, Simon Bray (Invicta RC Uvex) on the start sheet.

One of the ten riders from outside the county, Bray chose this event in preparation for his first tilt at the national hill climb championship, and his appearance in the B.C.F.'s national jersey showed that he meant business. He had returned from France, where he has been racing for most of the year, only two days earlier, and after carrying out a close reconnoitre of the 1,450 metre long course he demolished the old record by over eleven seconds when he soared to the top of Kithurst Hill to cross the finishing line by the South Downs Way in 3m.34.24s.

Last year's winner, Steve Elms (East Grinstead CC) started five minutes after Bray, unaware that his record had been broken, and disappointed his supporters by taking three seconds more than a year ago to reach the top in 3.48.59, but it was still quite good enough for him to retain the Alf Dawes Trophy, awarded to the best Sussex rider. He also led the winning team, with support from Paul Harris and Ken Taylor.

Adkins clear winner

Former national 25 mile champion, Eddie Adkins (Manchester Wheelers Trumanns Steel) reproduced the form of his hat-trick years in the late seventies when he trounced a maximum field of 120 to win the end of season Brighton Mitre 25 for a second year, this time in a most impressive 53m.30s. This was a new record for the dual-carriageway course which links the A.24 at Horsham with the outskirts of Crawley in West Sussex, and it gave the 43 year-old star a victory margin of 1m.49s. over the runner-up, Steve Elms (East Grinstead CC) plus third place on standard in the veterans class.

Another famous 25 miler from the past, 61 year-old Ken Craven (Crescent CC) won this category in a race with a record £876 prize list which ensured that everyone except the 22 non-starters went home with something.

First held in 1969 and organised by the present promoter, Robin Johnson, every year since 1971, this event has expanded to accommodate separate races for tandems, women and juniors, and a further measure of Adkins' time was clear when compared with the tandem winners, Andy Smith and Richard Holkham (Brighton Excelsior). They took four seconds longer than the solo winner, though to be fair to them it should be recorded that a sharp frost glistened on the roadside verges when they came under starter's orders at 8.15 am. There were no signs of that when Adkins was despatched at 10 am. but he and the fourteen women and juniors who followed had a

rising breeze from the south-west to contend with on the return leg of the "L" shaped course.

Barry Elcome (Festival RC) was the only one in this group to beat the hour, and in the absence of Pauline Strong (Team Raleigh) Gill Reynolds (Willesden CC) finished fastest of the seven in her gender again.

Though not quite the last time trial of the season for a few of the 166 entrants, this was the final one for the majority, including veterans Martin Winter and Bill Hendry (Farnborough & Camberley CC) with combined ages aggregating 133, they only needed 1 hour and 39 seconds to finish fourth in the tandem race.

HARGREAVES' BACK.

When Chris Boardman broke the 25 record on H25/13B at the end of May, many other riders that day had cause for celebration. Not so Mike Hargreaves. The only thing he broke was his saddle, resulting in a horrific "chute", a wrecked bike, and a severe back injury. Months off the bike, and specialist treatment were required, and only in the last couple of weeks has Mike been riding seriously. Today he got really serious, taking first prize in the Swindon RC 23.00. limit 10, on the revised U4.

Not the best of days for the 107 starters, starting very wet and cold, with a fresh WSW wind, the rain held off for the duration of the event, though the temperature did not rise significantly, and the wind eased only marginally towards the end. Such conditions tend to thwart any last gasp attempts at improvements for Vets standards and club competitions, and there were numerous remarks around the board of losing club and group competitions by mere seconds that this event should have guaranteed, given the appropriate conditions.

Not the least of these was Ken Hargreaves, father to the winner, who had hoped for better things on the day, but had to profess himself well satisfied with seventh, albeit missing his Group BAR by a whisker.

There were a few creditable rides under the conditions, notable being N.Armitage, who actually managed to improve 38 seconds, and Jane Scott, who took the ladies award with a time of 25.14. putting her well ahead of many of the men.

The reverse version of the U4 course seems to be a workable proposition, though it is thought to be at least a minutes slower than the old course. What was a gift slope from the old start is now a long drag to the turn. Still, at least this popular stretch of road is still authorised for use, so West DC are no doubt thankful for such mercies.

Full credit to Ken Rischmiller and Swindon RC for a well organised event, with a superb headquarters, courtesy of the Post Office. Shame there was a whole hatfull of non starters, no doubt hoping for float conditions.

Rogers wins again

An order of start which saw last year's winner, Paul Rogers (VC.St.Raphael Waite Contracts) off at no.10 on a freezing cold morning which favoured the later starters failed to alter the result of Bognor Regis CC's. 28 mile Circuit of Goodwood race.

The only rider in a field of sixty to pass the prime point by Trundle Hill in less than twenty minutes for the first seven miles, Rogers stretched a 32 second advantage over Ed.Morris (Gloucester City CC) at that point to more than a minute on last year's runner-up, Stewart House (Clarence Wheelers) at the line.

Both are no strangers to the complex 28 mile course with its many twists and turns, plus a series of testing hills which left the last man over 26 minutes in arrears, and both improved their personal times on last year. Rogers won by nineteen seconds on that occasion; he gained over a minute on House this time.

Winchester junior, Danny Axford (VC Venta) looked poised to fill a top three placing when he raced aggressively past the prime point in 20m.40s. with the steepest hill behind him, but he began to lose time on the longer, less severe climbs which followed and though his grip on the under 18 prize was never threatened he slid down to tenth spot by the end of the race.

Among those who paced themselves better were Mick Marchant (GS Stella) who improved his speed by seventeen seconds and his final position by one, and with clubmate, Mark Jones, also making the top ten this Chichester area club made sure of the team honours-a prize which eluded them in the Sussex CA. hill climb on the previous afternoon.

Recognising the support of veterans for this event-over a third of the field came from this age group-the promoting club had four prizes for them divided equally into over and under 50 years, but these were based on 25 mile standards which resulted in only one finishing with a "plus".

Jeff Wright wins at Otley

After the demise of the East Bradford Hill-Climb in 1990 and subsequently receiving only 28 entries for their event the following year Otley CC decided that the 1992 version would be a 2-stage affair, Norwood Edge in the morning, East Chevin in the afternoon.

With local sponsorship, in particular from Graham Baxter Sporting Tours, resulting in a prize list of over £380 (overall first prize £75) a field of 60 riders was attracted, including 3 ladies. Jeff Wright was the star rider, opposition provided by M.Hall. (Marple Wheelers) Craig Battersby (Leigh Premier) Stuart Green (Oldham Century) and the hill-climb seasons surprises, Steve Tyson (Airedale Olympic) and Steve Calland (Stars & Stripes).

The weather decided to be kind to the riders and officials, with brilliant sunshine and only a slight breeze greeting them on Norwood Edge. With Hall a non-starter it was left to Tyson to set the first notable time of the day in 5m.28.9s. Battersby then provided the days' first bit of drama. Catching his 2-minute man, veteran rider B.Martin (North Yorks Couriers) he pulled his foot out of the pedal causing his chain to slip off. Swerving over to the right-hand side of the road, luckily traffic free, he coasted over the line in 5.58.5. He didn't start the 2nd stage as, in his own words, his bike had other ideas.

Calland was to take over the lead from Tyson with his smooth deceptive style recording 5.27.2. It was then left to Wright to prove his form, his 4.57.1, a 30 second beating of Calland, belied his role in the continued drama. Still warming-up on the rollers 30 seconds before he was due off he had a desperate rush to the start line and struggled to turn his 63" fixed, finding himself in an awkward starting position. The start marshalls had to put their combined energies into preventing him from falling over. With the previous rider, Sarah Frankton (North Yorks Couriers), also a late starter timekeeper Keith Webb said that it was the best entertainment he'd had all year!

With the 2nd stage now only 2 hours away all gathered at Otley CC's club house for rest and refreshments.

The entertainment continued immediately the second stage started with the first man off, Ian Cullen of the promoting club, travelling only one yard before parting company with his machine. Perhaps it was the wind catching in his mudguards which caused his problems!

The healthy crowd gathered on the Chevin saw a virtual re-run of the first stage apart from J.Jepson (ABC Centreville) who set the pace in 4.09.0, over 10 1/2 minutes faster than his time on Norwood Edge where he reported to the timekeeper 9 minutes late. Tyson then took over the lead in 4.01.9, followed by Calland's 4.00.9. M. Andrew (Clevelys RC) also proved consistent in 4.12.2 despite his time almost being overlooked on the morning stage. The scene was set for Wright to repeat his earlier victory, this he did emphatically with 22 seconds to spare over Calland, his 3.38.0 was only

0.9 of a second outside Chris Boardman's 1989 record of 3.37.1. However, although Wright was disappointed, he can take consolation in knowing that Boardman had the benefit of a substantial tail wind the day he set the record.

Those watching at the finish were quick to voice their appreciation of the impressive way Wright sprinted into view for another well earned victory and the overall prize.

For just over 8 1/2 minutes work Wright earned a total of £91 and proved once again that he was the favourite for the national hill climb championship. Wright had no fear of Calland who said that although he couldn't climb he had good form for the end of the season and had decided to try some hill climbs, but was going to hostelling the weekend of the championship. He lack of climbing ability earned him £54, Tyson netting £42 for his consistency.

The promoting club fared well with Peter Middlebrook 12th overall, former Olympic and Tour of Britain rider Mike Cowley fastest vet and Alyson Winks fastest lady.

Local first cat Joe Phillips was 5th in both stages and overall, leading Bradford Wheelers team mates Paul Waddington and Steve Roberts to the team prize.

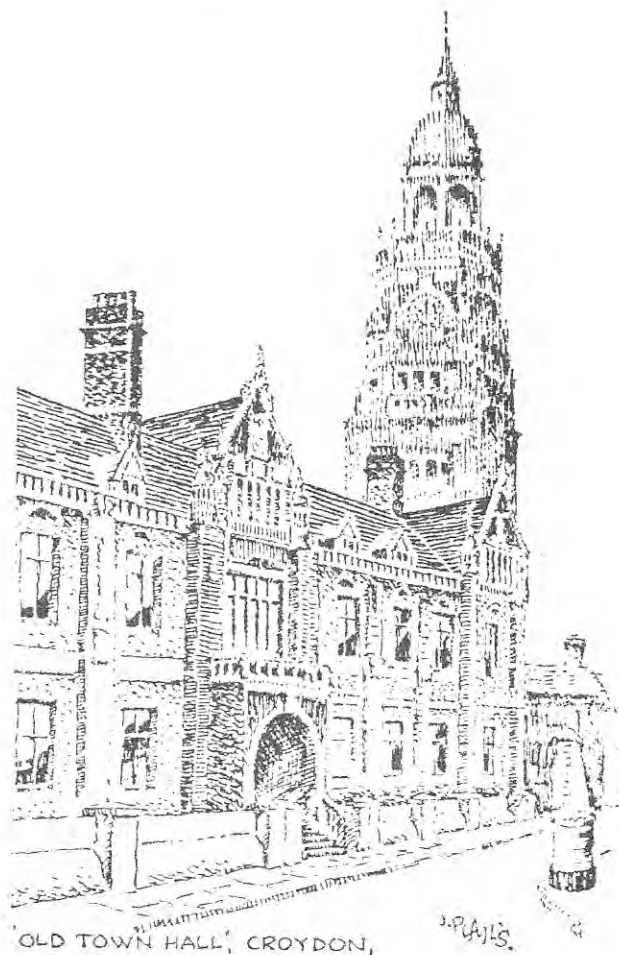

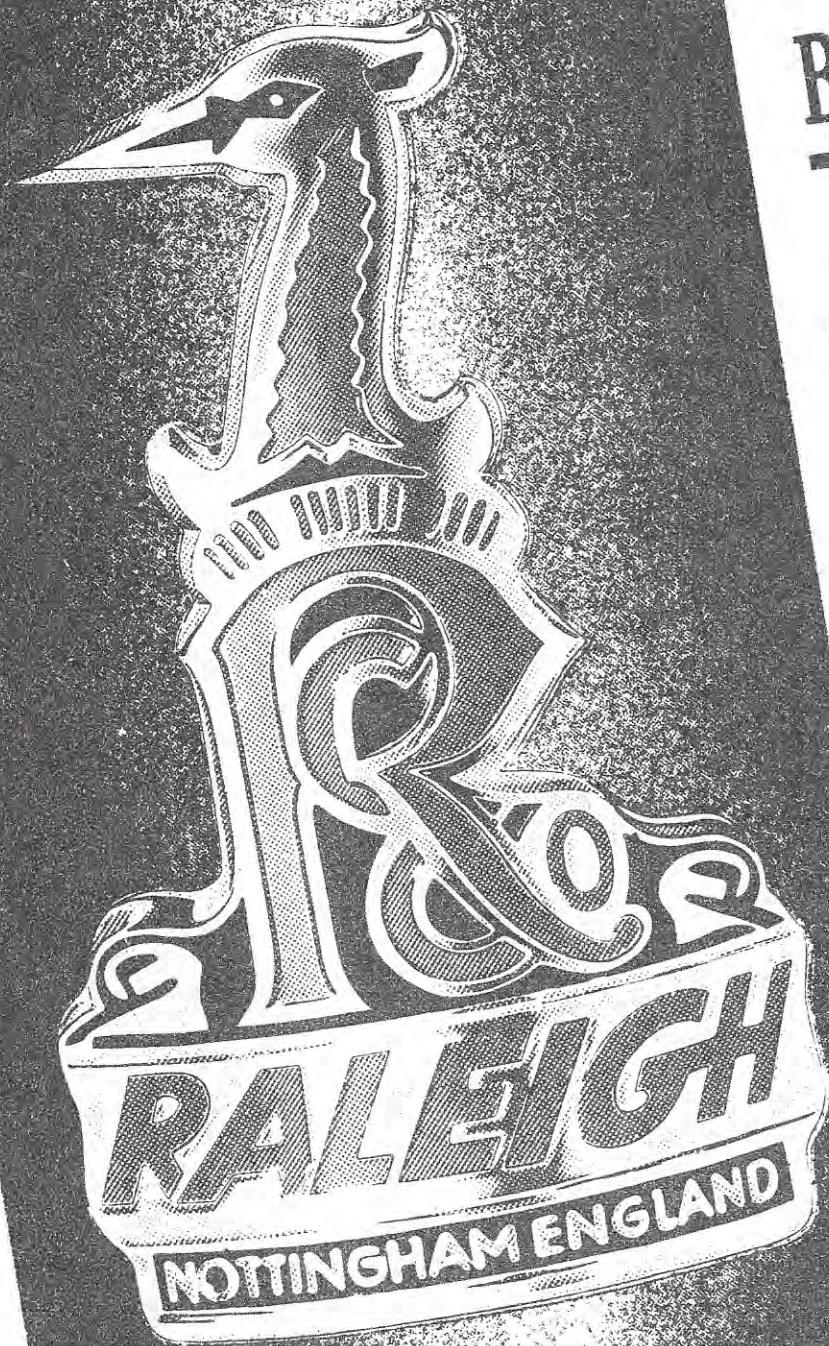
