CONDITIONS SLOW CAMMISH IN NEW SPONSOR'S COLOURS.

THE fenland 'mistral' didn't do riders in Sunday's Ely and District CC 50 km series of Spoco East events any favours.

Even that most famous of men from the flatlands, professional Ian Cammish, riding for his new sponsors Cyman/Maxim on a 'home' circuit around Ely, Littleport, March and Chatteris, was not looking his usual silk-smooth self on the more exposed sections of the BS8a course, his winning time 1.13.38 representing, for him, more of a 31.1-mile training time.

Cammish put almost 1.3/4 minutes between himself and runner up Geoff Frost, Loughborough Students CC, these two proving in a class of their own in the solo event, run off after the two-up and tandem categories.

They were also the only riders to keep in touch with the winnings times in the two-up and tandem events, although it must be said the 'technical' mid section, with a succession of tight bends, would have done no favours to the tandems and teams. The only good thing that can be said about the conditions is that it stayed dry!

Fastest of all, were the first and second placed tandems, roadman Bryan Long who was based in France last year, and Alan Lovegrove, North Road RT, having the closest struggle for top honours of the day in beating the mixed pairing of Andy Everett, Polytechnic CC and veteran Jeff Empson, Aero BC, by 17 secs., in 1.11.47.

A duo of Daves, Creese (fastest-ever veteran 25 miler) and Smith kept up the VC Slough's 'win-a-week' strike-rate since comeback man Steve Hunt and Phil Silver started March with a 52-min ride in the Norland two-up '25'. And their record would have been intact even if they had had trouble, because Hunt and Adrian Briers got together with some effect to take a clear second place for VC Slough, ahead of Paul Shuttleworth and Simon Layfield, riding for the new Team Welwyn, an initiative of Welwyn Wheelers.

Phil Smith, Norwich ABC, at 69 showed no respect for the 'wilderness' stretch, the seven-mile, dead (literally) straight, B1098 '16-Foot Drain' to take another standard award with his actual 1.30.17.

Paul Bailey, East Anglian CC, gave himself the additional handicap of riding fixed gear and deserved a special award for speedy pedalling on the wind assisted stretches, to take an eventual seventh place.

There were other stories of fortitude in the Fens on Sunday, but surely the most unfortunate(?) was West Suffolk Wheelers fastman Ron Back -ex Edgware RC and just back from a trip to Australia. Ron's puncture on the 15-minute ride to the start prevented his participation.

McKenna wins Stuart Whaley Memorial Hilly 25.

Middridge's Tony McKenna was a runaway winner of the Stuart Whaley Memorial hilly '25' in East Yorkshire. His 58 minute 27 second ride being more than 2 minutes faster than runner-up Vince Macklam (Leeds St. Christopher).

Organised by Team Mirage around a circuit embracing Market Weighton, Bishop Burton and Middleton-on-the Wolds, the race perpetuates the memory of Irish born Stuart Whaley who before his death in a cycling accident was a top Humberside rider of the 70's and early 80's. Dry, but cold and windy conditions made for a hard ride with only a wind assisted 7 mile stretch at mid-distance.

Notable non-starters, with apologies, were Dinningtons Julian Ramsbottom and Martin Pitchford. Both enjoying the sunnier climes of a Majorca training camp. Ramsbottom has won the race for the last three years, and holds the course and event record with 56.55.

McKenna's winning 58.27 gave him a 2 minute 5 second advantage over Macklam with Steve Foster (North Notts Olympic) third in 1.01.59. Just out of the placings were the top

Hull riders separated by the narrowest of margins. Kevin Eckersall (Hull Coureurs) clocking 1.02.30 for 4th, one second ahead of Joel Wainman (Hull Thursday).

Wainman, however, had the consolation of leading the winning Hull Thursday team, supported by new member John Lockwood (1.04.43) and Richard Bielby. (1.06.55)

Leading lady was Lyn Hanson (Seacroft Wheelers), whilst the veterans award went to 6th placed Rob Stone (City RC.Hull) who clocked 1.04.00.

Following his double win last week in the Scarborough Paragon "10" and the Nunbrook Wheelers "25", Laurie Holmes (Leeds St Christophers CC) continued his winning form to take first place in the Huddersfield Road Club "25". His time of 54.26 was a few seconds slower than he achieved on the same course last week but was an excellent ride on a cold raw day.

All riders found it tough going out to the turn and not all that easy in places coming back! Only eleven competitors beat the hour compared with over 40 in the same event last year - most riders being slower by between 2 and 3 minutes (and not because they were a year older)!

Robby Krygsman(Goole Vermuyden CC) took second place with a fine 56.11 and supported by **S.R.Lancaster**, 59.58, and **P.A.Read**, 1.00.12, led his club to a narrow team victory over the Leeds St Christophers with an aggregate time of 2.56.21.

S. Frankish (Scunthorpe Poly CC) finished third with a 57.39, with **Chris Giles(Huddersfield Star Wheelers)** taking 4th place in 58.15.

Veteran **Brian Sunter(Condor RC)** took the 5th place award with a 58.20 to beat fellow vet **Malcolm Davidson (Morley CC)** by 21 seconds. (Malcolm took the Fastest Vet award on the 1 rider/1 prize rule)

Once again **Dave Longbottom (VC York)** won the Vet on Standard award with a fine time of 1.02.27 giving him a "plus" of 15.53.

At the other end of the scale, **T.S.Holmes (Huddersfield Star Wheelers)** was fastest Juvenile with a promising 1.04.52 and **D.Arey(Featherstone RC)** was fastest Junior with an equally promising 1.01.32.

Hayley Lowes(Askern CC) was 1st Lady in 1.14.27, which pipped the evergreen **Mary Dawson(Teeside RC)** by 15 seconds (and no, I am not going to mention the Miss Piggy hat)!

This was a new course based on the A48 Cardiff to Bridgend road, it could be classed as a challenging course. Sunday's wind gave assistance going out but made a stiff head wind on the return trip. Ten of the field of 48 were first time riders and it was the first event of 12 years old S.Strange of Cardiff Ajax.

**Southern Counties CU
25 mile TT
Sunday 28th March.**

"This is the way ahead for all time trials," an excited Robin Johnson (Brighton Mitre) predicted after he finished the second of two events held on sporting courses he had designed for the promoting Southern Counties C.U.

Both were almost circular in shape, and good use was made of the many minor roads which straddle the Surrey/Sussex borders and are already well used for Surrey League road races, but apart from residents living in villages in the vicinity they are neither wide nor straight enough for the average motorist to favour.

There are no steep hills on the two courses either, but frequent changes of gradient called for intelligent use of gears. Gary Dodd (Kingston Phoenix) showed on Saturday afternoon that a speed of 25 miles per hour could be maintained when he romped round the 10 course in exactly 24 minutes to win by 32 seconds from Derek Cottingham (Charlotteville CC) who shared second place with the unseeded Andy Murray (South Western RC.)

Next best was Steve Woodbridge (Brighton Excelsior) the fastest junior who was also an easy winner of his age group in the 25 on the following morning, but that produced a much closer finish for the top placings. Sub-four hour 100 miler, Neil McCormick (Belle Vue CC) brought to a halt by mechanical problem in the 10, enjoyed an

uninterrupted ride to gain a winning margin of fifteen seconds on Paul James (Crawley Wheelers) after Mark Silver (Hounslow Wheelers) was first to finish inside "1-3" some ten minutes earlier.

The two events attracted entries of 79 and 70 respectively, and most spoke enthusiastically about the courses at race head quarters afterwards. London South D.C. secretary, Christine Watts, who has seen so many time trials courses terminated by the volume of traffic in this congested part of the country must have been heartened by the success of these two new ones, and was reminded of her racing days when one competitor told her, "I didn't see a car for the last five miles."

B.A.R. TALK

Georgina Pechard, current holder of the RTTC Junior women's BAR title.

If you're wondering who I am, let me explain. I'm in the lower sixth form at Ingatestone Anglo-European comprehensive school at Ingatestone, Essex, doing french, german and art. I've been a member of the local cycling club, Shaftesbury CC, for the past two years. My two qualifying 10-mile times for the women's junior BAR last year were 24-28 and 25-34, while my two 25-miles were done in 1-02-25 and 1-04-something-or-other.

I also won the GHS juvenile 10 last summer, since I was still 15-years-old when I did that 25-34 time on July 11 at Bottisham, Cambridgeshire.

I enjoy the 25-mile time trials as much as the 10's, though I'll have to concentrate more on the 25's this year.

Last year I only found out about BAR in September! So it was a rush to get some good 25's logged-I hadn't put up any particularly fast times until then.

With my birthday falling in July, I'll be able to go for the junior BAR again all this summer and also in the first half of 1994 as well.

I started off as a triathlete, joining Shaftesbury CC in order to improve my cycling times. But once I'd got turning those wheels seriously, I just wanted to concentrate on cycling. The running has gone, though I still do a bit of swimming, getting up at 4.30.am. I've cut back from 11 sessions a week to four since it's swimming for pleasure now, rather than training for triathlon events.

I cycle the five miles to school and back and I go out with the Shaftesbury lads training-there's a group of six or seven of us who are all about the same standard.

My bike has a 531 frame with a Shimano 105 group set and Mavic Open 4CD's. It was new last year and the bike shop fitted it to my size.

For mechanical problems I turn to George Shakespeare. He's fabulous. He also gives me lifts to races which is great because Dad is often working. He's a chef so we all eat too much. He prepares food at home in the kitchen. Mum loves it. It makes me popular at do's where we have to take food along!

This winter it's been a case of club runs, turbo training, rollers and circuit training.

Since the turn of the year I've been keeping a diary on my training and events. Jackie Harris of Team Haverhill is coaching me and she's excellent.

I've done three early-season road races (finishing in the bunch at Peterborough last week) and will do a few more before switching the focus, mid-season, to time trials.

Winning a national title last year gave me a lot more confidence and enthusiasm with my training this winter. It also means that any goals I set myself this year need to be very high. With that in mind my main goal this year will be the junior 25 with a top 5 finish in the 10 and a top 5 finish in the junior BAR. If I'm going well I would like to have a go at the junior 25 record. If I do not achieve any of these goals I am very fortunate that I have another season to try again.

I have a new Time Trial bike on order, which I should have in early April. That fits in with my main programme starting in April with six time trials and two road races. I am riding some new tri-bars this year that my father made to my specification during the winter.

I find them a lot more comfortable and they give me a much more natural position on the bike.

I am hoping to have a go at some track racing this year, but that will depend on whether I can afford a track bike in time. I am finding that it is getting far more expensive this year with a new bike and I will be using new wheels and tubs. I had not ridden tubs until I borrowed some wheels for the GHS last year.

I have ridden two races so far this year, the Kettering Friendly back in February where I was the fastest junior and 10th overall and the Spalding CC (Hilly) where I punctured and finished well down the field. I believe if I had not punctured I would have finished in the top 5. I will be riding the St.Ives CC 10 this weekend and that should give a good idea of how am going.

Kevin Dawson current holder of the RTTC Best All Rounder trophy, talks to Time Trial Weekly.

Last weekend I did a 3-up on Saturday and a road race on Sunday. It was the first time I'd felt half-decent since that bout of flu some while ago. I must have got a virus afterwards, or suffered from the effects of the antibiotics-whatever the reason, I hadn't been able to train properly. It's a problem after a cold, finding the happy medium. I was still on antibiotics when I rode the Porthole the weekend before and I seemed 80% fit in the road race. Training had been a struggle: I kept feeling dizzy.

But what can you do: you go out training because you're feeling OK. You put in two hours at Level 2 and you discover, afterwards, that it was too much.

Anyway, last weekend two of my old team-mates from Askern RC, Max West and Robin Newman, asked me to do a 3-up with them.

The first disaster was right at the start when Robin pulled his foot out and crashed, busting his handlebars. That left two. Then after five miles Max blew up so I had to tow him to the line.

Even so we got there in 54.27, the winners of the 3-up clocking 53.58, so we weren't too far adrift.

Sunday saw me finishing in the bunch in a road race at Leicester, the spring classic run by CC La Zouch.

The main aim this summer is to do well in the 1993 BAR competition, which means things get serious in about June. Right now the focus is on getting a basic level of fitness.

With BAR, you've got to ride every going on a reasonable course just to be sure that you're there, and fit, on the day when it's blessed with ideal conditions.

In 1991 I missed a few important ones. I picked the wrong 12-hour, for instance, while in 1992 I chose the right 12-hour to ride in. There's not all that much choice with the long events: you've only got five good 100 miles and just three 12's

hour trials events to pick from. My result of 1hour 43min last year for a 50 mile event, held on a good night, was fine. I'll settle for that again.

My 1992 best for 100 miles was 3hours 43 min. It was my downfall, if anything, and is the one I can improve on. I did a two minute quicker time in 1991. My aim for 1993 is a 100 mile time of 3 hours 40mins.

I was happy with last year's 12-hour. I covered the first 100 miles in 3-49 which left me with a buffer of 11 minutes to lose in the next 8 hours-in other words I knew I could log a 3-54 in the middle four hours and a 3-55 in the final four-hour stint.

I don't do any training for the 12-hour. I know it's three times longer than the 100 mile event but my philosophy is simple: I must aim to average 25 mph. I kick off at my 100 mile event pace expecting to lose time off that somewhere along the line, through tiredness or windy conditions.

Monday this week sees me putting 1-11/2 hours in at level 1 to ride Sunday's race out of me. I'll be preparing, during the week, for the Archer Grand Prix on Sunday, a Premier Calendar event. It's a chance for me to link up with two of my GS Strada colleagues, John Charlesworth and Gary Thomas.

Tuesday and Thursday training involves being in Doncaster town centre by 6.15.pm to join the chain-gang. There's about 15 of us set off, from six different clubs, and we put in two hours. It's run at Level 2 with spells of Level 3 and 4. You get a good work-over.

Wednesday and I'm out on my own for 2 hours.

Friday is when I have a treat: I even go to work (five miles away) in the car for a change!
