

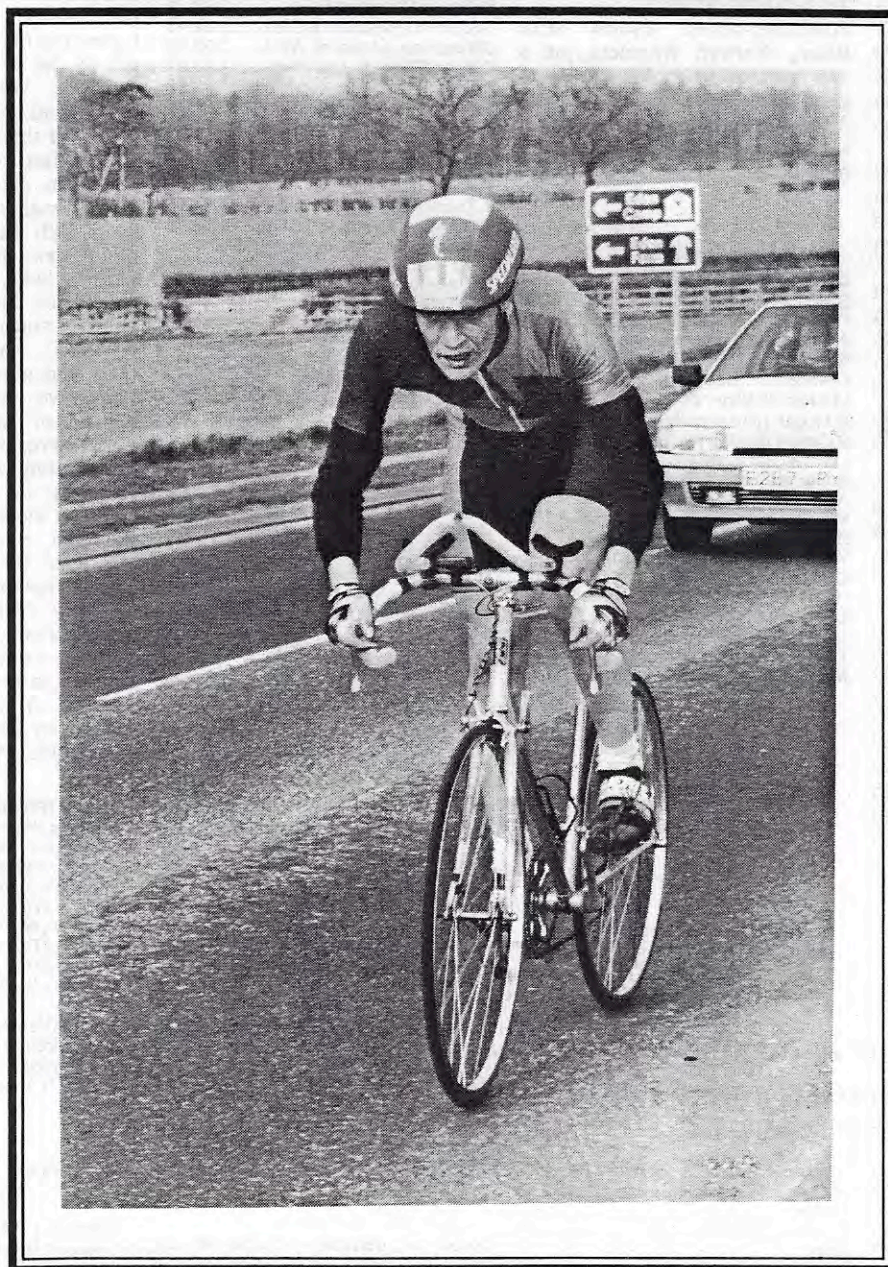

## Creese and VC Slough Dominant in North Midds & Herts 50.

The F1 course on the Great North Road may be one of the best in the country when the clerk of the weather is kind, but as riders found at the weekend, the going really gets tough over the Bedfordshire plain when the reverse is true.

All the more credit to VC Slough duo Dave Creese and Steve Hunt who alone of the riders in the North Middlesex and Herts CA '50' returned respectable F1 rides, continuing the club's average of a win a week this season, on a day when some sixth of the finishers were nearer to three hours than two!

Veteran Creese provided further evidence of his supremacy when the going gets hard. His ability to spin a low gear into the wind on the long grovel out to the 25.7 mile turn elicited much admiration, not least from trackman John McLelland, London St Christopher's, fourth in 2.05.10, whom he caught five minutes and proceeded to drop, on his way to a sterling 1.57.46, the only ride inside two hours.

His first solo victory of the year, proved that he has shaken off a recurring virus that delayed his preparation earlier in the season, and followed a 53-min '25' on the same course a week earlier.

Giving VC Slough an unassailable lead in the team race was runner up Steve Hunt, riding his first event at the distance for 10 years and continuing his impressive comeback, just 55 seconds outside two hours. The day previously, the former GHS '10' winner had won the Sleaford Whs '10' with a short 21. His is a name to watch later in the season.

Paul Bennett showed that his health is improving after an operation and complications last autumn, the Verulam CC rider powering around in 2.02.21. for third place. His clubmate (and boss!) Jim Mepham continued a sequence of good rides, following a personal best 1.00. '25' the previous week with 2.14.51, which put him among the handicap winners.

Footballer-turned cyclist Mike Bean, Welwyn Wheelers, put a new pair of tri-spoke wheels to good use with a seventh-best 2.10.47, getting the better of several fancied riders despite 14-min. handicap allowance.

Class tells, and although Gary Dighton (Leo RC) claims not to be doing very much training this year he knew how to ride in the strong NE wind and cold showers in the Bournemouth and District Womens CA 25 mile T.T. at Ringwood winning by 46 seconds.

Gary says that this year he is just riding to enjoy himself. He is taking exams at work for his job as a transport executive with the Post Office, and this is taking up his time.

He admitted to having done some training the week before, but not as much as one of the race organising team who had put in 200 miles.

This year he is more interested that his fiancée Zena Harris (Crabwood CC) does well, and most of his training has been coaching her.

She comfortably picked up the ladies prize and appears to be progressing well, explaining that Gary had taught her how to ride in the wind, "just get on with it and don't worry. I don't mind the wind now" she said.

Zena a member of the strong Crabwood CC ladies team that is making an attack on the BAR this year, looks likely to be the leader of the team, and is soaking up all the advice she can.

Studying at Southampton University, the pair hope to get married at the end of next year, when Zena hopes to see Gary get down to serious competition again.

## Exeter Wheelers CC 25 mile TT

Sunday 9th May. S4R/25

Andrew Lyons, Plymouth Corinthians Cycling Club, showed considerable strength to win Exeter Wheelers 25 by an impressive 1 minute 21 seconds from his team mate Paul Roberts.

This victory came a week after he set a course record of 56 minutes 9 seconds for the S18/25 to be used next month for the Men's National Championship. By a quirk of the field placing Roberts had started a minute behind Lyons but that was the nearest he got to the South West Best All Rounder. With a strong North East wind blowing behind the riders for the first 12 miles Lyons started fast and opened an ever increasing gap on his team mate.

The Corries also were the fastest team with Paul Williams taking ninth spot. If first and second places had been a foregone conclusion then the next places were much more closely contested. Promoting club's GB road racing representative, Hugh Fairgrieve was third by the closest of margins from Mick Potter, Weston Wheelers who is now finding some form.

Rain fell for an hour before the start but cleared away just before the first rider was despatched. However its presence, coupled with temperatures more suitable to early March, caused several seeded riders from starting. The veterans award on standard went, as most in the South West do, to Harvey Alford. His plus was enough by 22 seconds to edge out Brian Jude, Plymouth Corinthians CC.

# B.A.R.TALK

**Kevin Dawson (GS Strada), current holder of the RTTC Best All Rounder trophy, talks to Time Trial Weekly.**

They say that bad luck comes in threes and it certainly did with me this last weekend: I had a puncture before my first ride, my crank came off during the second, and I punctured during the third!

Unlucky! It sure was. I was competing in a two-day event at Skelton, Humberside. The 1.8 mile time trial, which is a pursuitist's time trial really, kicked off at 10am on Saturday morning. I punctured just before the start and had to borrow a wheel from a rider who'd finished-whoever it was, thank you. I came sixth, Matt Illingworth taking the win.

Then 40 miles into the 65 mile road race in the afternoon, when I was away in the break, my crank fell off. The service people got it back on, and although I chased on my own for 10 miles, the break was by then too far ahead to catch.

On Sunday I had a second puncture some 40 miles into the final 75-mile race. Again I was up in the break.

So on to this coming week. By the time you read this I'll have been (hopefully) riding in the Wednesday night Selby handicap. It's a 40-mile race and the fastest group of 1st cats. have five minutes to make up on those who started first, that's the women and juniors.

The groupings you get in a handicap make an interesting (and different) cycling challenge, as everyone in their own group contributes. With the 1st cats the main focus is catching the groups ahead, so you all come together on the line.

To prepare, I'll do a steadier Tuesday night's training-out on my own for two hours rather than on the chain gang.

I'm keeping a look-out for the other BBAR contenders' progress though there's no real events to judge things by as yet: Gethin is going well, and Colin Roshier has logged a good ride.

I've done the BBAR seriously twice, coming second at my first attempt in 1991 and winning it last year.

In 1991 I'd put in 285 miles in the 12 hour which everyone thought would be enough, but then along came Glenn Longland with his 300 miles in a different event to capture the top spot. Glenn's always capable of pulling out something like that.

Last year my 12 hour figure was higher, at 293 miles.

A windy day can utterly ruin a 12 hour, though there are a reasonable number of events about to enable you to do another.

Punctures, on the other hand, aren't too much of a problem because you can have a follower. For the last two years Alan Robson, a friend from the Askern club, has helped out here.

My policy is to have my own food, since you don't know what they'll give you. I swear by Maxim. I'd expect to get through 20 bottles during a 12 hour, each bottle being close on 1 litre.

I've stuck with this for the past two years. Maxim was the first and it's still the best. I started because everyone else was drinking it and because I know Steve Jennings, a former pro cyclist, who makes it.

It's a glucose-polymer, a carbohydrate drink. You mix it with water and get a clear liquid. I stick to the recommended mixing rate. It's an alternative to solid food-my 12 hour intake is equivalent to 60 bars of chocolate.

When it's hot, I drink more. During a 12 hour the only other things that I have passed across are bananas, nectarines and peaches as they are easy to eat. I don't eat anything solid.

In a 75 mile road race, I'd ride carrying two bottles of Maxim, that's three litres in all. Afterwards, I wash the bottles out ready for use the next time.

**Ian Cammish 9 times winner of the RTTC Best All Rounder Trophy, talks to Time Trial Weekly**

At last a little bit of form, 1.48.29 in the West Suffolk Wheelers '50', and probably my best effort so far this year. I have been beginning to get a bit despondent as I've lost about as many races in the first few months with Cyman as I did in three whole years with Raleigh. As the training has been going so well I could only put it down to the bike.

May Day Bank Holiday Monday was therefore spent in the Far East, Yarmouth with Lawrence Fagg and Jonathan Attenborough of Cyman, I spent all day riding Cyman's back-to-back comparing different strength frames, fork rakes, bottom bracket axle widths, tracking etc., and by the end of the day couldn't recognise the bike I've been riding for the past month. As well as making improvements to that one they also supplied me with another model which had been sprayed bright red. This had been prepared taking into account all the previous feedback I'd given, and it looked and handled so much better than previous prototypes.

The rest of the week was spent riding to a from work each day (an hour each way on my hack bike 40 x15), a '10' each lunchtime on a Cyman (fastest 21.55 on a 87" gear, Slowest 25.25 at level 2 on the Friday winding down for the weekend), and two club 11.2 mile time trials on the Tuesday and Thursday evenings. I might have done more

but I thought I had better ease up a bit in preparation for the Wolsey '10' and Sundays '50'!

The weekend was blowing stronger than Mick Storey after a Chicken Tikka Mosala. Despite that I thought I'd try the red Cyman 'Evolution' in the 10 and must admit I was very pleased with its performance, I managed to beat Alan Newark and Ben Paton by 20/30 seconds.

Lawrence suggested I use the black 'Fibro' on the Sunday to see if there was any improvement, and there certainly was. Although having been beaten on more than one occasion this year by both John French and Martin Pyne I got a bit nearer to evening the score by winning the event, beating Martin by 33 seconds and John by 5 minutes or so.

I have got a lot of time for Martin-one of the nice quiet guys of cycling who let his legs do the talking rather than his mouth, and I'm pleased for John who has started this year so well I suspect the 50 was a bit of a disappointment for him and would not be surprised if he'd had problems. I am sure on present form it would have been a lot closer.

Also, a good ride by Colin Roshier, third in the 1992 BBAR and looking to give this year competition a serious tilt.

I am looking forward to next weekends, Catford 10 and Scala Wheelers 25...and receipt of a white Cyman Evolution 2

**Paul Manning. Junior 10 mile Champion 1992**

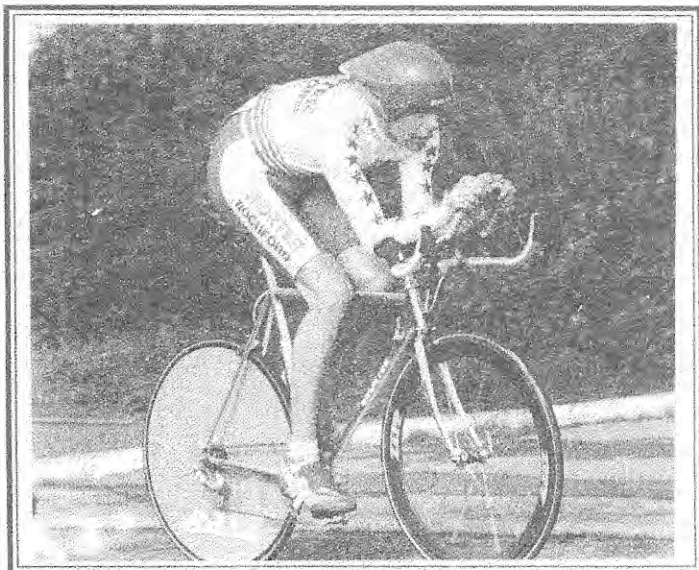

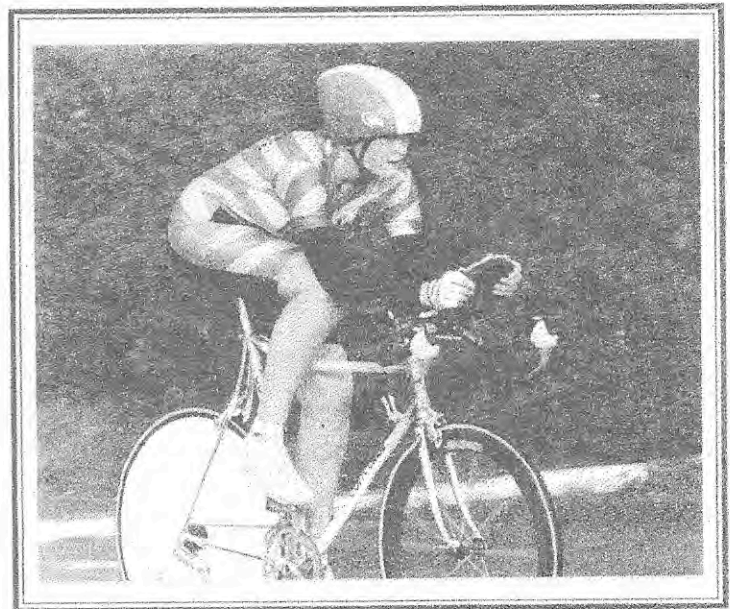

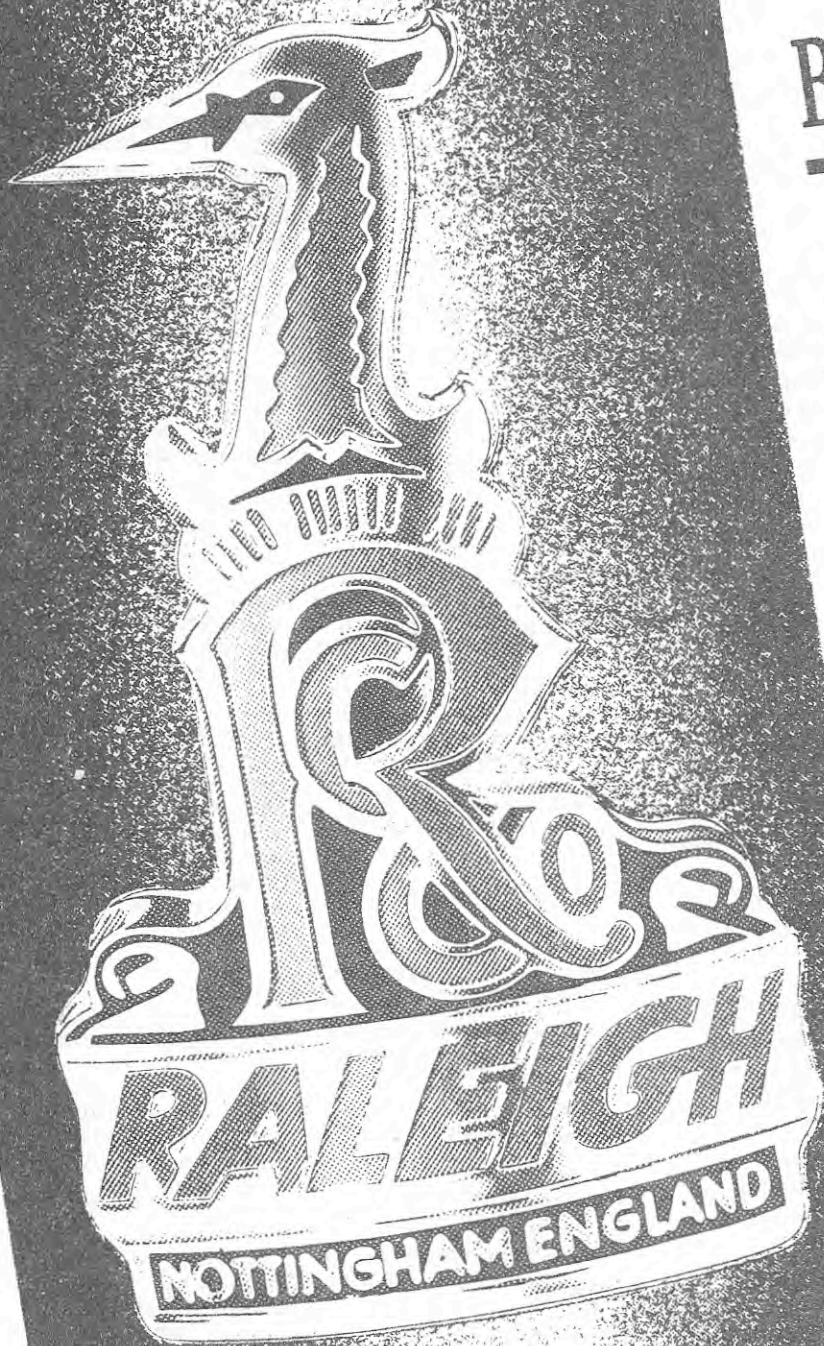
