Chris Ball has 1min 40sec's to spare over Lee Paxton, in Andover 25 mile event.

Despite what the forecasters said, weather conditions cleared up for the Andover Wheelers 25 mile time trial, after the start had been delayed for half an hour.

The event was run after the veterans 25, and looking at the rain in the previous race 15 competitors decided to DNS, which they must have regretted when they saw the improved times.

Triple junior champion and BAR Chris Ball was the expected winner just two seconds off Clive Brooks course record, claiming he "could not get settled in." Going down to the 14 sprocket instead of his usual 15. Putting this down to having ridden (and won) a few road races recently.

Second placed Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) was pleased with a personal best, in spite of losing his chain, and having to get off to free it. He thought he lost about a minute, not enough to threaten Ball.

Third placed Richard Simmonds (Somer Valley CC) was another who put in a personal best. Riding a disc wheel for the first time, and having a few problems working an eight speed mechanism on a six speed wheel. Age 19 and the training companion of Chris Ball, "when

they manage to meet up" He has no plans to compete in longer distances time trials this season. Although he might try a 50 later in the year.

His distance limitation does not apply to road racing, and he was planning to ride in the Carmarthen two day next week end for a £1,300 prize list..

Mid-Devon CC 25 mile TT Saturday 15th May. S4R/25

Andrew Lyons, Plymouth Corinthians CC., continued with his winning ways in the latest South West time trial though his winning margin was somewhat less than in recent weeks though his chief challengers were the same riders with the exception of Ian Wallace, VC Camelot, - a non starter-and Dave Barnes, Team Zoyland, who failed to reach the turn.

In 1992 riders suffered from dehydration as the event was run on one of the hottest afternoons of the year. There was no danger of that this year. The weather was cool with a strong south west wind and the occasional blustery shower sweeping across the exposed A38.

Notwithstanding the adverse conditions Lyons was fastest to the 12.3 mile turn in 32 mins 15 seconds. His team mate and runner-up Paul Roberts was lying in third spot 1/2 minute down. Ahead of him by 7 seconds was Pete Shelley. The next places were held by Keith Rees 54 seconds down on Lyons and Mick Potter a further 24 seconds slower. No other rider got to Lower Dean inside 34 minutes.

The ride back was down to pedalling speed and here Rees came good. He was riding a new

frame to replace one that cracked on a mid-week training ride. He pulled back his deficit on Shelley and Potter and almost overhauled Roberts.

The speed back was epitomised by Harvey Alford, winner of the Vet's Standard award. He found himself travelling down from Bickington at 49 plus MPH and his legs unable to go faster so he stopped pedalling and still maintained his speed down the slight gradient.

One rider who had to keep pedalling was John Macnamara, Duchy Team Racing. He rode 93 inch fixed the thought of which made most bystanders eyes water for the effort required to keep it going uphill on the way out and the revving on the way back.

Kirkby CC 10 mile TT

Paul Jennings, the Olympic team pursuiter from North Wirral Velo-Kodak, set a new event record in winning the Kirkby CC open 10 on the Rainford By-Pass, Merseyside on Saturday afternoon (15.5.93) with a time of 20.56.

Twenty four hour champion Andy Wilkinson, Port Sunlight Wheelers, produced the leading time of 22.08 after starting number 30 and it held for 80 minutes until Jennings (No 110) came in to win by 72 seconds.

Conditions were not good with the time trialists biggest enemy the wind-slowing all but the very fittest. It was the first time Jennings had ridden at Bickerstaffe and he thought the course was O.K. but his win probably helped him to make that decision. He normally rides at Tarleton which is handier to his Preston home and locals know that is at least one minute faster. His personal best was done there in 20.02.

Alf Hilton, a former winner of the Kirkby CC 10 two years earlier, was third this time in 22.14. to lead Leigh Premier RC. to the team award with good support from clubmates Lee Feeney (22.51) and Peter Turton (22.52)

New girl Lynn Robertson, Port Sunlight Whs., continues to do well and she took the first lady prize with 26.23. to pip Lisa Boardman (Birkenhead NE) by 35 seconds. It was left to father Keith Boardman to maintain the family name when he took fastest veteran prize with 23.54.

Chris Barry, New Brighton CC., was fastest junior in 23.36. The event incorporates the Liverpool DC. final of the GHS competition with Antony Aspell of Ballakermeen High in the Isle of Man adding that title to his BCF Merseyside Division circuit race championship he won at Southport a week earlier. His time of 23.41. beat last year's GHS final winner Matthew Pryce of Shropshire by three seconds.

"There is always one with a 58, probably a road racer or a triathlete" said a disappointed competitor looking at the result board at the finish of the Sotonia Middle Markers (1.02 limit) 25 at Ringwood.

Winner 46 year old Dave Froy (Farnborough and Camberley) is a road racer, regularly riding in Peter Fryer events, and not ridden in a 25 for three years.

"You have to get in a time to get in an open" he said afterwards. "I would have been happy with a 1.01.00. I knew I was going OK when I did 24.15. for 10 miles." He has just bought a second hand bike for time trials, and is gradually getting the bits together.

Second placed Eddy Martin (New Forest CC) at 15 had not got in time for 25 miles, but has been giving some of his more established team mates a fright in 10 miles club events.

He has been booked for a schoolboy international trip to Holland in July with Southampton coach Geoff Greenfield, when he will be free of his studying for GCSE exams, which are taking up his time at the moment.

His club evening event should have been a 25 the previous

Thursday, but because of road works, the course had been reduced to 24.3 miles. His 1.01.27 was an indication that he would be among the prize winners, and as well as second place he led his team to victory.

B.A.R. TALK

This week Chris Ball, current holder of the RTTC Junior Best All Rounder title, talks to Time Trial Weekly.

Aschool! Sorry! Please excuse me if I keep sneezing, but I've gone down with cold after riding in the wet yesterday. Mind you it was worth it: it was a 25 mile time trial on the P612 and my time of 52.07 was the fastest.

While I was hoping to win, I didn't expect to win, if you understand, because I've not done a 25 mile time trial since mid-March, and Lee Paxton (Salisbury RC) always pushes me close.

As it was I took 1 min 40 secs. out of him, and there were further celebrations when Rich Simmonds (Somer Valley CC, Bath) who is my two-up partner, crossed the line for third place.

That 52.07 figure shows I'm still getting quicker. The course record of 52.05 was only two seconds away and it was set last year on what riders say was a float day, whereas yesterday was windy.

Early in the year I told you it would be a case of one time trial and three road races each month. Well, in practice the ratio has been further in favour of road racing, and I've won my last three which isn't bad.

I ride the same bike for both road racing and time trails, the only difference being that for time trials I put lighter wheels on, opting for 24-spoke wheels, Wolber Profile rims and 18ml Record Piste tubs.

The tubs cost £35 each and barring punctures, I'd expect to get through 3-4 in a season, though punctures can take the tally up to 6-7.

The Antelopes club's sponsorship deal with Michael Radford Accountants means club members get money for wins-the greater the importance of the win the more the loot we collect.

It's £10 for a win (road race or time trial) £100 for a national championship and £100 for setting a competition record. I find the money on offer is a big carrot.

Last year, when I was going for the junior BAR, I was able to stretch my hand towards some of those £100's whereas this year, riding as a young senior I don't really expect to collect any £100 incentives, though to come within two seconds of a course record is pretty close.

Radford's purse is open to all of us, and several club members are regularly to be found in the queue marked 'collect here'- like Jeremy Short, Glenn Longland, Neville Stroud and Ralph Dadswell.

Between us, we aim to clean Radford's out.

This year I've touched the £10 window five times.

My aim for May and June is to notch personal bests at both 10 miles and 25 miles, My current figures standing at 19.47, and 51.15. I'd be happy to shave two seconds off my 19.47 figure for a 10 mile, while I want 1min-1.30 off my 25 mile figure (I dream of clocking a 49 minute reading).

I'm pinning my hopes on a fast 25 mile result on the H25/13b on Saturday (May 29), the course being two minutes faster than the P612 and is the one where Chris Boardman set the 25 mile record. I've a road race the following day that I aim to win, and on the Monday, I'd call it a three-day hat trick if I went under 20 minutes in the 10 mile time trial at Poole.

There's no point in me entering for BBAR: I'm not doing 50's and that until I'm over 20 years old as it blunts your speed and right now I'm flying up hills. It feels great.

Those exam results? They're still not through, though I am working in the gym, coaching both boys and girls, and really enjoying it. See you on Saturday. Apologies if I shoot past without saying 'hello'.

VC Norwich

1st Team Junior 10 mile

Since winning the 10 mile team championship last year, the fortunes of the three team members are far from consistent. Shaun Aldous is now a first year senior, but has yet to start his 1993 season due to severe problems with tendonitis. Once fit however, he will soon make his mark.

James Trenchard, in his final year as a junior has only just started racing after extensive treatment for a prolonged and persistent back injury.

Zak Carr however is fit and well with several good performances to his credit. On the road, he has already scored 38 points and is leading the Peter Buckley 531 series, having won the first round at Eastway. As far as time trialling goes, he has ridden two open 10's, the first was on the B10/4 sporting course near Thetford on March 6th (His 18th birthday) which he won in 23.01. The second was on a windy night on the potentially quick B10/3C near Norwich on May 5th, when he dead heated with Martin Pyne with a time of 21.42.

At the time of writing, he is preparing for the second round of the 531 series in Lincoln on May 16th, with the Oakdene two day in Bourne mouth the following weekend.

On the 29th, he will ride the Oxford University '25' on the H25/13B, with his close friend and rival Richard Montgomery also in the field, if the weather is good then the junior competition record must be in danger.

Andy Wilkinson

I am now in the middle of an intensive training programme designed to bring me to peak of fitness for the national championship '25' on the 6th June-yes that's 25 miles! I have decided to face a new challenge and train for a short race and aim-optimistically -for a place in the top 5. The last five days have seen my form improve encouragingly and I hope to improve right up to the morning of the race.

Dave Lloyd has lent me one of his radical new machine-for 1993-Rotator cycles for the race-I have nicknamed it the Rotovator after my favourite streamlined model at the market garden where I work, although I have yet to rip up any tarmac with it!

The riding position is more extreme than I have used before and is taking some adjustment but I feel it will offer much speed in time.

My last two races were to have been the Kirkby '10' on Saturday and the Stoke ACC'25' on Sunday. I managed the '10' OK recording 22.08 on a windy afternoon but was beaten by an amazing long '20' by Paul Jennings. On Sunday my car ground to a halt minus oil and water and on attempting to get to the race rotovator mounted, I punctured, so I gave in and sulked home to train on the rollers as by now it was raining heavily. After another week of short intensive rotovating I shall ride a 10 and 50 and then maybe a 100-sounds odd, well it is but I will explain later.



World Cup Time Trial

Sunshine-Hail-Strong winds were added to the tough terrain of North Derbyshire in the 34 km, 3rd World Cup Time Trial based at Parwich last Saturday.

Category 'L' Women, along with the oldest mens categories, faced the worst of the weather, and the performance of Clare Greenwood was the performance of the day, from the 285 riders taking part in the 9 categories ; Well 10 categories if you include the Parwich residents category! This tiny village managed to raise seven riders- as well as providing all the marshal, and again making this time trial an exceptional sporting event in North Derbyshire. The Parwich head master, from the local school (Ray Williams) won this classemment for the second time, and it was noted he received excellent support from the local school children.

The weather had improved somewhat when category 'A' (35/39 years) took to the road, almost five hours after the start of the event. Nevertheless, Geoff Platts recorded the best time of the day (48-28), and would have been very close indeed to his event record of last year (47-10) but for a broken spoke in the rear wheel which meant stopping to adjust the wheel to miss the frame chain stay. Brother Ken(Platts), the current BCF veteran champion, duly won category 'B' (40/44) again with an excellent time (49-21), and it was noted that their club, Coalville Wheelers were prominent in the various age categories, with more good performances on this strong mans day. It was good to see father and son (both veterans) taking part, with ex pro Bob Addy and dad George. Ken Russell, the 1952 Tour of Britain winner, along with wife Renee, both took part, but there were so many other 'good old' 'uns' from the past. It should be remembered that this world Cup Time Trial series has been designated as the BLRC (British League of Racing Cyclists) annual reunion.

a nice touch at the presentation was the special plaques awarded to the race officials, the Parwich Secretary (Clare Kendal), and the Belgian ICF (International Cycling Federation) official (Remi Gruirey)

the presentation made by the Hon Hugh Gibson the Deputy Lt. of Derbyshir. Bill Gray (79) the Derby Mercury, Burma Star veteran as No1 set the ball rolling at 12.01 (category H). But it was Bob Maitland's friend from Germany Wilhelm Gutyman (a veteran of Stalingrad) who emerged the winner.
